





## Japs Complete Occupation Of Bases In Java Against Nazis

Nip Cruiser Shells? Port Of Cebuon In Middle Philippines; Fighting Is Quiet

The Japanese completed the occupation of Bandoeng, former Allied military headquarters on Java, and pre-sumably Socrabaja, the na-val base. The Dutch in London announced plans for continued resistance from

Meanwhile, a Japanese light cruiser shelled the port of Cebu on the island of the same name in the central Philippines today, the War Department reported, but only slight damage was inflicted.
