Inmate's death is 4th at jail in a year

SANFORD — The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is investigating the Thursday death of an inmate being held in the Seminole County Jail.

The death is the fourth at the jail in the past year and the sixth in the last 40 months, according to Sheriff's Office spokesmen.

The inmate who died Thursday is identified as Joy Marie McClain, 57, of Plant City. She was booked into the Seminole County Jail on March 29 for violation of probation on a grand theft charge.

McClain had health issues, according to a Sheriff's Office news release, and she was being cared for by the jail's medical section. Spokesman Lt. Barry Smith said she had previous heart conditions.

McClain apparently collapsed in her cell late Wednesday night. Medical staff at the jail rendered assistance. Emergency Medical Services was contacted and McClain was rushed to Central Florida Regional Hospital in Sanford. She was pronounced dead at 12:03 a.m. Thursday.

Even though it's believed the death is due to medical issues, the Seminole County Sheriff's Office, Major Crimes Unit is investigating, due to the inmate being in the county's charge at the time, the news release said.

Smith said the jail averages nearly 1,000 inmates, and deaths will occur occasionally. He said the prison population includes young and old people.

"We have cancer patients and heart patients," he added.

Legal Aid Society moves to Longwood office

LONGWOOD — Now in its 30th year of providing legal assistance to economically disadvantaged residents of Seminole County, the Seminole County Bar Association Legal Aid Society will host an open house and groundbreaking ceremony May 3 at its new location at 1015 Palmtoe Ave., in Longwood's Historic District.

The new location was chosen because of its proximity to the geographical center of Seminole County, which in turn provides more convenient access to county courthouses. The old home that now houses the Legal Aid Society was purchased with funds donated by members of the Seminole County Bar Association.

Formerly located in Altamonte Springs, the Legal Aid Society was formed in 1975 by attorneys Thomas A. Speer, Ned N. Judson Jr., William H. Wack III, S. Kirby

Moncrief, Terrence W. Ackert, and Alan A. Dickey.

Dickey now serves as a circuit court judge. Julian, the organization's first president, is an attorney for Seminole County Public Schools. He will speak at the groundbreaking.

"I think it's a very exciting and monumental event for the Legal Aid Society," Julian said Friday. "It's come a long way from its humble beginning in a very small office at the Sanford Armory, with a staff that consisted of one part-time secretary. The association is one of the oldest legal societies in Florida."

Pastor Ricky Scott, from the New Mount Calvary Baptist Church in Sanford will dedicate the Society's new home.

Current Executive Director Sylvia McLain joined the Society in 1985.

McLain, a former real estate attorney who moved from Cuba to Miami when

she was 2 years old, said: "I love providing assistance to individuals and families who need legal help."

The Legal Aid Society handles a variety of civil cases, ranging from family law, housing, guardianship, and consumer law. Cases involving physical abuse are a top priority for the organization, as are divorce cases, custody cases and child support cases involving minor children.

The Legal Aid Society also assists in legal guardianship cases for elderly residents who can no longer manage their personal affairs due to physical or mental disabilities.

The Legal Aid Society helps resolve landlord/tenant legal disputes, as long as the case doesn't involve public or subsidized housing. Representation for the poor and the elderly who are susceptible to exploitation is also available.

Persons in need of legal assistance are required to fill out an application and are submitted to a screening process that

includes proof of income.

Free legal services are provided for those persons whose income does not exceed 125 percent of the poverty level. For a family of four, that means an annual income of about \$24,000. The cut off level for an individual is based on an annual income of about \$11,000 per year.

In addition to three full-time staff attorneys, the Legal Aid Society benefits from the pro bono services of about 100 Seminole County attorneys who provide their legal expertise at no charge — legal advice that would normally cost around \$350 per hour.

Operational expenses are also covered through donations given by attorneys, law firms and legal associations affiliated with the Florida Bar Association. Additional funding comes from the Edward C. Smith Foundation and the Sheila Ryan Foundation.

Cat up a tree — Who you gonna call?

SANFORD — You've seen it in the movies and you've seen it on television, but you won't see it in Sanford. The fire department doesn't rescue cats from trees.

"We never have. And I'm starting my 17th year here," Fire Chief Gerard Ransom said.

Karen Tubb of Sanford wasn't sure what to do after two boys from her neighborhood noticed a cat menewing from her 100-year-old oak tree near Meltonville Avenue and 21th Street Monday.

After calling the Sanford Fire Department, where she was told they stopped rescuing cats from trees for insurance reasons, she called animal control.

Ransom said that it wasn't for insurance reasons, but for operational reasons that the fire department doesn't

rescue cats from trees. "We're committing real equipment," the chief said. That equipment takes

time and manpower to leave the station, and the fire department can't take the chance of rescuing a cat, in the case of someone having a fire or a heart-attack, Ransom said.

Tubb said after calling animal control and being told they don't rescue cats from trees either, she didn't know what to do. She said that one of those two entities should have directed her to someone who could assist her.

"They were no help whatsoever," Tubb said.

The cat, who was featured in Wednesday's issue of The Herald, was about 20-feet high in the tree at the beginning of the week. And Tubb said, the cat had been up

Another arrest in drug ring

SANFORD — Agents have arrested another suspect Friday morning in an ongoing drug investigation that involves the alleged distribution of prescription narcotics and cocaine, according to a Friday news release.

The investigation, involving numerous agencies, began in January.

The suspect is identified as Meghna Padalia, 28. She was arrested at her place of employment this morning at the Publix at 242 N. Orlando Drive in the

A GLANCE AROUND OUR COUNTY

Credit criteria: After decades of inactivity, developers are beginning to see the potential of downtown Sanford. Suncor Properties is building a \$100 million mixed-use condominium project west of City Hall; John Giuliani has torn down the old Quonset hut village that housed Ron's Tires and plans to build townhomes; and Phil Rampy, who made a name for himself revitalizing Thornton Park in downtown Orlando, recently purchased property at 3rd Street and Magnolia.

More development is on the way, and city officials must decide now how they want this new development to shape downtown. We've

all heard city officials promise to develop master plans for development. Those plans are rarely implemented. However, the city possesses a unique tool to that can force developers to adhere to a consistent downtown plan - stormwater credits.

New development in Central Florida must incorporate a plan to handle stormwater. Usually this involves digging a retention pond. In downtown, retention ponds are problematic. Ponds don't generate revenue, and they take up space that could be used to build revenue-generating structures. Developers can construct underground vaults to store stormwater, but in some cases they are cost prohibitive.

In Sanford, there is another option. The city over-engineered the Mills Creek retention pond and because of that, the St. Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD) has granted the city 43 acres of credit. That means the city and SJRWMD can waive stormwater retention requirements for up to 43 acres of development. That's a much sought after commodity, and Sanford is one of the few cities in the state to hold such credits.

City staff and the Downtown Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) are currently developing a formula to determine what each credit is worth and how much to charge developers for them.

They are wasting their time. The value of the stormwater credits is not what the city can charge for them. The true value is the city can determine which projects are granted credits. If we only put a dollar value on each credit, any developer who ponies up the cash will receive them and downtown will develop in a mismatched manner. Instead, the city should grant the credits to those developers whose projects meet standards for design (how tall, what will it look like), land use (office, residential or retail), and economic impact (taxes, jobs, consumer base).

The price of the credits is insignificant from the city's perspective, though I do think developers should pay something. What the city gets is high-quality development that fits the character of downtown. You know what else the city gets? More money. An upscale townhouse or retail facility generates more property tax than a vacant lot or an empty building. In addition, that revenue is generated annually. Any money collected from stormwater credits would be a one-time fee.

City officials can't drag their feet on this issue. Already, former Mayor Brady Lessard is lobbying hard for Giuliani's project to receive stormwater credits. Giuliani may have a great project, but until the appropriate criteria are established, he should not be granted a credit.

Other communities are trying desperately to recreate what Sanford's already got - a classic American downtown. By tying stormwater credits to a set of development criteria, Sanford will ensure that its downtown remains the envy of Central Florida.

Sympathy card: It's not been a good week for some of Sanford's leading citizens. If you've stopped by Knight's Shoe Store in the last few weeks, you've noticed something missing - Mr. Knight. Don had to go to the hospital with congestive heart failure. He's at home now, but he hasn't been able to make it into the store this week.

Max Buffkin, the B-Shift Battalion Chief with the Sanford Fire Department, suffered a heart attack last Saturday. Paramedics were able to revive him, however he remains in critical condition at Florida South. The outlook is not good. Firefighters and paramedics deal with these situations every day, but this one hits close to home. Max is an 18-year veteran with the fire department, and he has helped train or mentor many of the guys (and gals) in the department.

"It's tough," said Lt. Mike Turner. "This is a small department and everyone is pretty close."

Martha Yancey's sister, Dorothy McReynolds, died this week. Dorothy was the former owner of Dorothy's Health Studio. She was also married to Doc McReynolds, who long-time Sanford residents remember as the proprietor of McReynolds Drugstore on the corner of 25th Street and Sanford Avenue. (Coincidentally, Don Knight worked at McReynolds before getting into the shoe business).

Many come from a lifestyle where they did not take care of their health, the don't get treatment, but then enter the stressful environment of prison.

"A death in the jail is not unusual," Smith said. The number of deaths at the jail is nothing the Sheriff's Office is concerned about. He said he knows of one judge who sentenced a man with terminal lung cancer to jail. The man lived a life of crime, so the judge had little mercy.

"The only deaths we don't investigate are attended deaths with a physician or hospice," Smith said. "We investigate all unattended deaths."

The John E. Polk Correctional Facility has a contract with the U.S. Marshall to hold federal prisoners, so the population is not just Seminole County convicts.

Another example would be Jason Wheeler. Wheeler is a felon accused of killing a Lake County sheriff's deputy and wounding two others in February. Wheeler, 29, is being held in Seminole County and is not in the best of health either, Smith said.

Four of the deaths in the last 40 months have been by natural causes, Smith said. One died of an overdose and another died of suicide by hanging.

Since June 2004, four deaths have occurred, including one in June, August and October 2004 and McClain's death this week.

A death in a jail is not unusual.

there at least since Monday, and was not rescued until Thursday morning.

A woman, who saw the picture of the cat in the paper, called Tubb, and told her she should call a tree service. Chief Ransom said that is one of the suggestions animal control usually makes to people in this situation.

Tubb called several tree service businesses in Sanford. She said it took several phone calls to different services until she called one that had a live person on the line, instead of a recording.

"I didn't want to just leave a message," Tubb said.

James Miller, owner and operator of Best Tree Service, came out to Tubb's house on Thursday morning to rescue the cat, who had climbed up another 20-feet so that it was about 40-feet high in the oak.

Tubb said the cat appeared okay and healthy and it wandered off into the neighborhood toward a nearby park.

"I'm not a cat person," Tubb said. "But I just felt so sorry for this kitty."

Miller, who rescued the cat, said he's rescued many animals in his 16 years of service to Sanford.

"I get [calls] about five times a year for cats, toy airplanes, stuff like that," Miller said.

At the Tubb residence he also cleared away some of the loose branches from the oak tree before he rescued the cat.

The cat was in a bad position, Miller said, and was scared because of the Tubb's dog.

"I just cradled it and came down on my rope, so everything was safe," Miller said.

Best Tree Service does all phases of tree work, but Miller said he doesn't charge for this kind of work.

"I just do it to help people out," he said.

city of Maitland, where she is a pharmacist.

She was transported to the Seminole County Jail and is being held under no bond. Her first appearance in court was scheduled for Saturday morning. She is accused of conspiracy to traffic hydrocodone.

Her arrest comes after 13 other male suspects were picked up on arrest warrants beginning April 19 and continuing through this week.

The operation involved the Seminole County Sheriff's Office and the City-County Investigative Bureau, with the assistance of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, the Central Florida High Intensity Drug

Trafficking Area Task Force Support Center and the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration Diversion Unit.

It appears most of the male suspects, who were arrested earlier, either knew each other through work, or grew up together in the area. It appears the individuals sold drugs to each other.

In most of the cases it appears the suspects were abusing prescription drugs. Among only a handful of individuals in the group, was cocaine being distributed and used, Sheriff's Office officials said.

As for Padalia's alleged involvement, it's believed she filled fake prescriptions for painkillers as a favor for some of the individuals, who were arrested earlier. It does not appear that she was using prescription medications for personal use.

Release of additional information is limited due to the ongoing nature of this investigation.

The Way We Were: A look back at Sanford's caretakers

This is a continuation of items found in the 1952 Sanford City Directory.

Physicians and Surgeons

In a previous column, I listed the doctors practicing in Sanford in 1952 and made some personal comments about a few. I also knew several others.

I was one of Dr. Orville Barks' last patients before he left for World War II. I remember his coming to our house when I had a severe case of chicken pox. I was five or six years old. He told us then that he was leaving the next day. You probably recall that he was a German POW. I later taught his son, Jim, now a local attorney.

Dr. Charles Park's son, Billy, and Dr. Wade Garner's daughter Rosemary have been good friends of mine from Southside School. We share lots of good memories. I taught Dr. Park's grandson, Bubba.

I taught Dr. Edwin Epstein's daughter, Rheda. Betty Ann Monson, daughter of Dr. Leonard Munson was a couple of years behind me in school. Most recently, I served with Dr. John Morgan on the Sanford Museum Advisory Board and in the Sanford Historical Society. During the 1960's, I taught both his daughter and son-in-law, Beth and Frank Whigham.

Dentists

Those dentists listed in the 1952 directory are Wayde Rucker, Harry Woodruff, LeRoy Brown, A.W. Epps, Sr. and Jr., Herbert McCaslin and Julius Ringling.

My first dental was Dr. McCaslin whose office was located on the first floor of the Masonic Building. I then had a long association with Dr. Epps, Sr., whose office was on the sixth floor of the Sanford Atlantic National Bank Building. He had a large collection of SHS Salmagundis in his waiting room which were enjoyable to look at before facing his drill.

Hotels

There were four hotels in Sanford in 1952. Florida at 119 South Park, Montezuma at 300 Magnolia, Mayfair at 1000 E. First Street and Valdez on North Park.

I went to Ann Haily's sixth birthday party at the Montezuma in 1942. Her dad was employed there, probably as manager. As a census enumerator in 1990, I was assigned this hotel and visited the owner/manager in her bedroom, as she was sick. If I recall correctly, there were no residents at that time.

In the summer of 1946, I took a dance class in the ballroom of the Mayfair Hotel taught by Marjorie Cogburn Tepsic. When in high school during the early 1950's, that ballroom was the scene of the majority of our May Day Balls and Junior Senior Proms.

The closest I came to the Valdez Hotel was eating in Eddie's and later Mrs. Appleby's restaurant occasionally. And I don't believe I ever set foot in the Florida Hotel which was named the Seminole in 1917. I did not realize until recently that when the Florida Hotel closed, that name was given to the former Fernald Lawton memorial Hospital at 500 Oak.

Florists

Florists listed in 1952 were McNeill Florist and A.F. Ramsey, both on Sipes Avenue, James R. Stewart at 845 Myrtle Avenue and Pippins on West First Street. Both families were members of First Baptist Church so I knew them. All of their children were older than I, but I did go to a few birthday parties with Peggy Pippin. I also remember visiting the Pippins in their home. They had the only swimming pool I knew of during the 1940's.

Mrs. Pippin was a pianist who accompanied my dad often when he sang. She had a beautiful touch on the piano and can't be duplicated. Her daughter, Gladys, gave me a tape of her playing, soon after Mrs. Pippin's funeral. She was over 100. Mrs. Pippin also wrote several songs and I have the sheet music for a few: "O Beautiful America", "My Irish Cullen", "He's Calling" and several I can't put my hands on at present. She and my dad recorded some songs on a 78 rpm, which I also have somewhere.

Stetson's Corner Hello from Hong Kong to Faht loh leih daah

This week in Stetson's Corner we take a peek at Hong Kong, as viewed by Geneva resident (and organizer of the Greater Geneva Grande Award Marching Band each July 4) Richard Simonton, who is there on assignment helping to get Hong Kong Disneyland off the ground. The theme park is scheduled to open Sept. 12, 2005. For Simonton, the real magic is in the city itself and the people who live there. Writes Simonton in part one of a two part series:

Dear Geneva, Fla., in the Cantonese Language is Faht loh leih daah (say the four syllables together quickly). Florida is 239,000 miles away, or so it seems to me as my eight-month stay in Hong Kong winds down and I try to remember the peaceful country lanes of Geneva or the bustling crossroads of downtown Oviedo.

One thing that reminds me of Florida is the Government's Tear-Up-The-Roads program for snarling traffic. The doormen here in Hong Kong will salute with their right hands as a sign of respect, so the road construction signs take it a step further and show a man in a hard hat saluting with both hands at the same time and apologizing for any inconvenience. They are very polite here. A sorry-for-the-delay message plays if commuter trains slow down for even a few seconds. People mean no disrespect when they cut in front of you on the sidewalk as if you were invisible. It's only because there isn't room enough for everyone in this crowded city. And yet, the birth rate in Hong Kong is said to be the lowest in the World and there is concern that the population is not replenishing itself. The Government may even offer cash incentives for couples to have more than one child.

Part of the problem is that 80 percent of the population must live in just 10% of the area. Hong Kong is also 80 p rural and 40% parkland. (That's 210% so far.) During my daily journey to the Hong Kong Disneyland site, I pass through many miles of undeveloped land that might make choice 5-acre horse ranches, if only it were flatter. Instead, it would more likely hold a dozen 60-story apartment buildings with countless 400-square-foot units. Much of the level land was "reclaimed" and sometimes the sea tries to take it back. I was passing the main Post Office recently when three men in old-fashioned diving suits emerged through a hole in the pavement. I was headed for Hong Kong Station on the opposite side of the street to take the train through

the tunnel under the harbor, but then considered going by ferry instead. The International Finance Center rises above the station to a height greater than the Empire State Building, but doesn't seem that tall. Maybe it's because the surrounding short buildings are also way up there.

That area was once called Victoria, but is now known simply as Central, and I like being there. It should feel overpowering and oppressive, but it is comfortable in a cluttered sort of way and there's a vitality—a spirit—that everyone shares. The nightlife districts of Lan Kwai Fong, Soho, and the Mid-Levels are close by, with countless bars and restaurants of every description as far as the eye can see and teeth can chew. A long succession of escalators—dozens of them—runs up to the Mid-Levels until 2 AM, then down until mid-morning. I sometimes get off at Hollywood Road to browse through antique and junk shops, which become more affordable the farther I get from the escalators. I glanced in the window of a tea shop one day and the owner pulled me in before I had time to refuse. I was seated at a table that was set for a doll's tea party, where she brewed various blends of tea from across Southeast Asia and India. The smallest cups are not used for drinking tea. I soon found out. She explained that you brew the tea in the pot for half a minute, pour it into the tiny cups for a few seconds, and then empty those into somewhat larger cups for drinking. But first, you sniff the fragrance from the empty tiny cups. She was so nice and her daughter was so beautiful that I bought some oolong tea and a little yellow tea set to take back to Geneva, in case some nice woman and her beautiful daughter would care to serve me some tea when I get back. 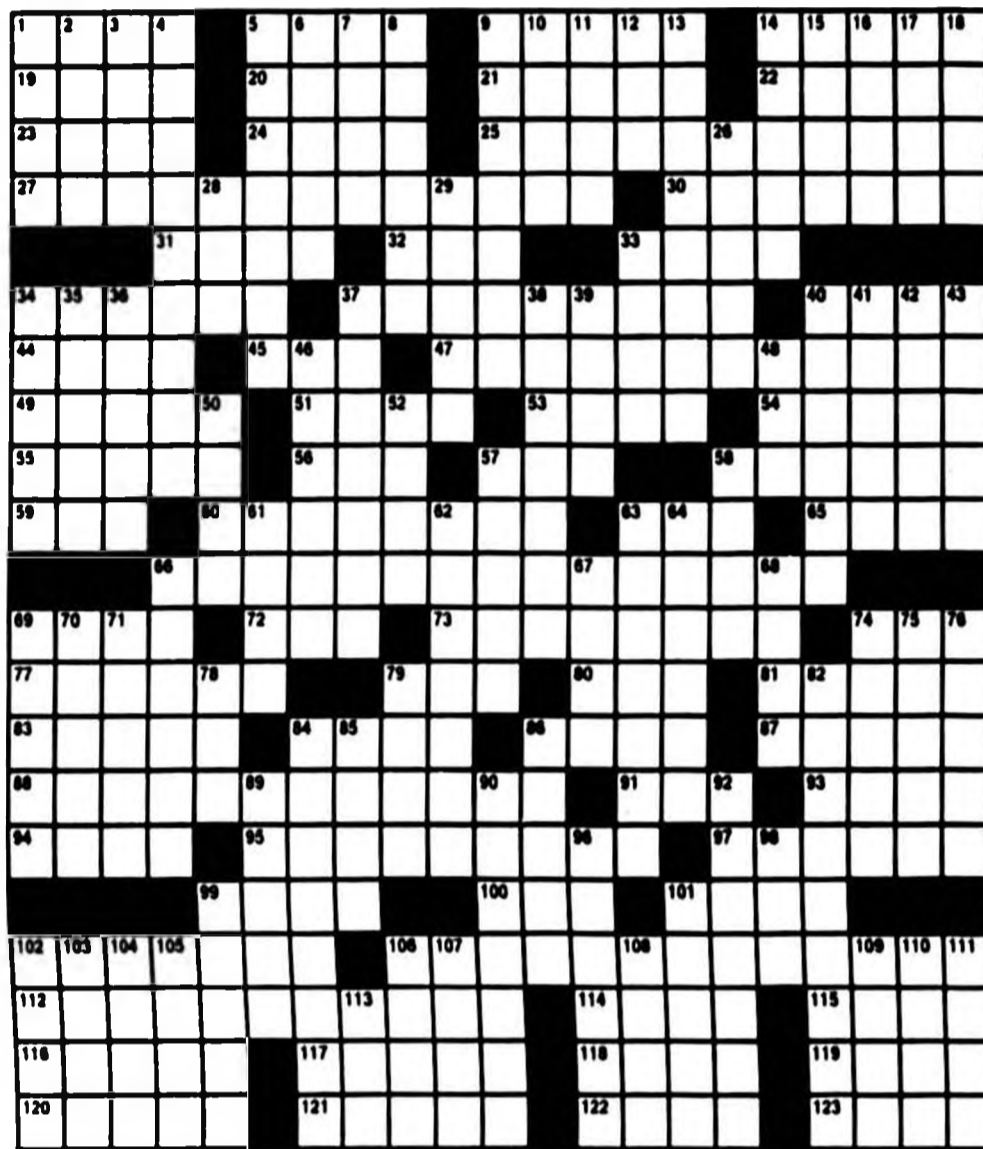

Front Porch Council breaks ground

Saturday, April 23 at 10 a.m., Goldsboro Front Porch Council, Inc., and various officials gathered for the groundbreaking ceremony. They included Sanford Mayor Linda Kuhn, Vice Mayor Velma Williams of District 2; County Commissioner Brenda Carey of District 5; Melvin Philpot, Housing Chairman of the Goldsboro Front Porch Council, Inc.; Eloise Dilligard, community liaison. Partners to help this project become a successful housing project are Homes in partnership, Bonnie McCoy; John Klinger; Toby Best; Lewis Kelton and staff; Seminole County's Colleen Rotella and staff; Sharon Hughes of Washington Mutual Bank; Russ Gibson; V. Eugene Miller, Interim City Manager; Charles Rowe, Florida Community Partners; Patricia West, State of Florida Front Porch Executive Director; office of Urban Opportunity; Stacie L. Anderson, Department of Community Affairs; Ken Reecy, Housing and Community Program Manager; Ean Smith,

Florida Housing Finance Corporation; and Dr. Subrato Chandra of the University of Central Florida.

The vision, says Melvin Philpot, was not to just build homes, but to build energy star homes. The families who will occupy these homes will have more money in their pockets each month to buy more groceries or pay bills. Mr. Philpot presented this concept to Charles Row and Commissioner Williams some five years earlier. The plan is workable, even though it appeared that Philpot was off the wall with his idea, because it was being done in South Apopka by Homes In Partnership, with Lewis Kellon, a nationally recognized non-profit community development organization, in the top 100 builders in Central Florida.

Pat Braaf of Washington Mutual Bank became the representative at the table. Executive Director of Florida Community partners Charles Row, Allison Hewitt the then-director of the Governor's Front Porch were able to secure the purchase of the property on which the homes will be built. Down pay-

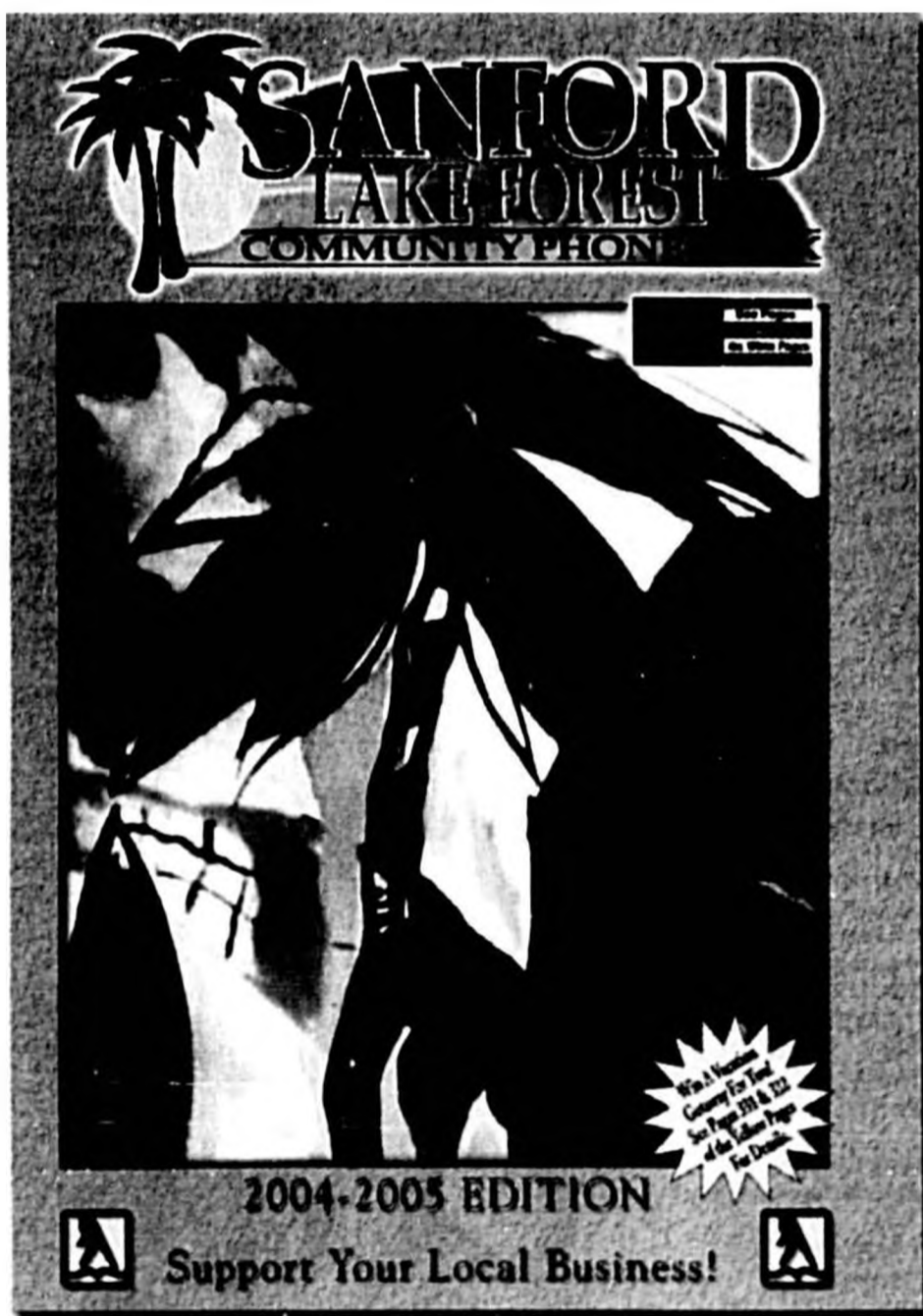
ments will be provided by the City of Sanford and Seminole County government, working together. Colleen Rotella and her staff of the county provided the necessary down payment to install the infrastructure and other helpful things which may be needed.

Families will be able to get financing through Washington Mutual and additional funding to market the property. Kellon and construction director John Klinger determined that there would be eight homes built.

Dr. Subrato Chandra of the Build America Project of the Florida Solar Energy Center recommends that the homes will be even better than Energy Star. The homes will range from 1150 to 1200 sq. and cost \$123,000 with subsidies provided and the county and Florida Housing Corporation providing the home owner with a desire to purchase these homes at the reduced price.

This project will provide an extreme makeover of the Goldsboro community and an attractive subdivision called Pine Level, located on the corner of West 18th Street and Roosevelt Avenue in Sanford.

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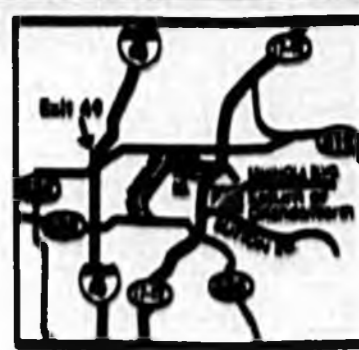

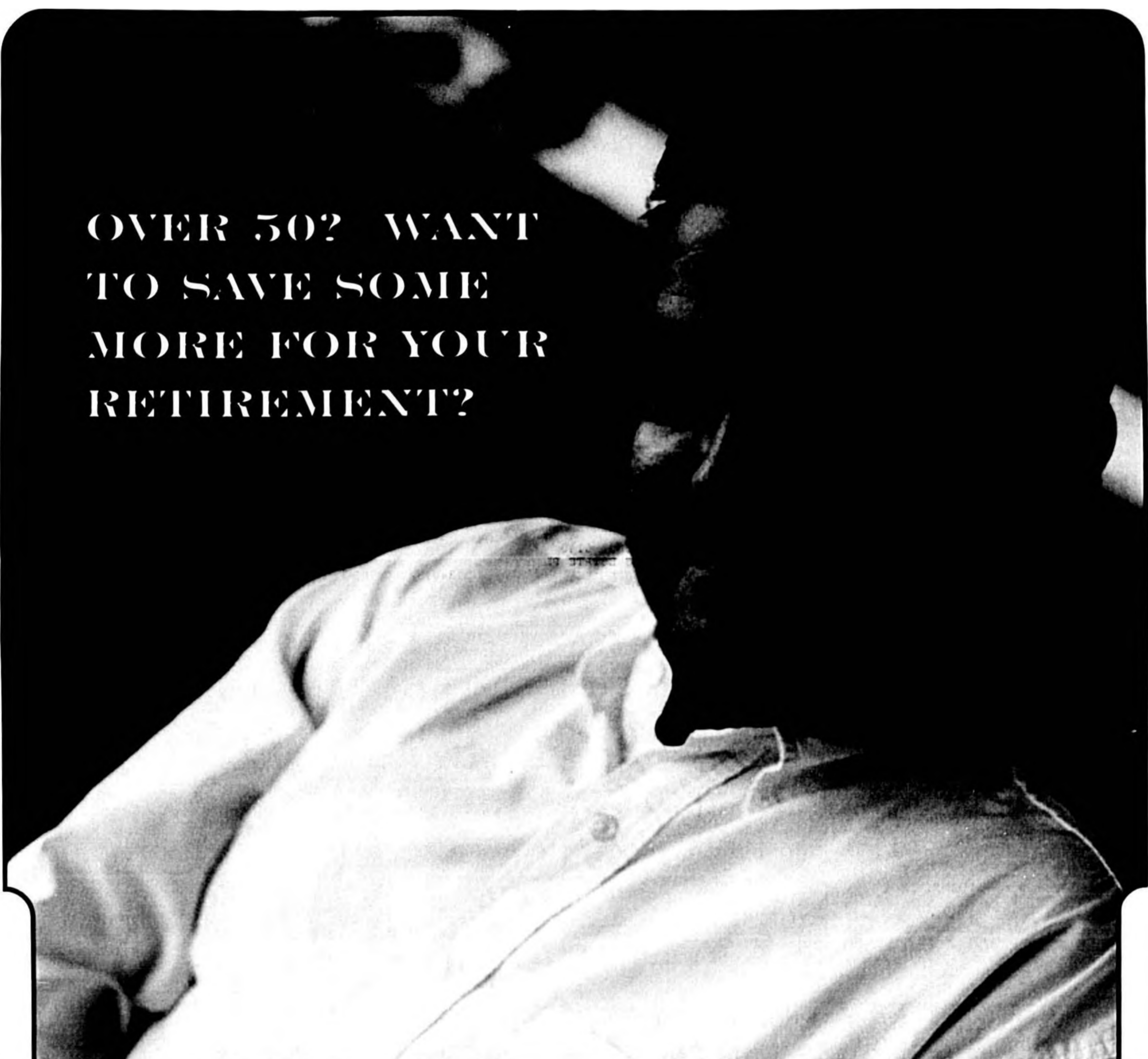
