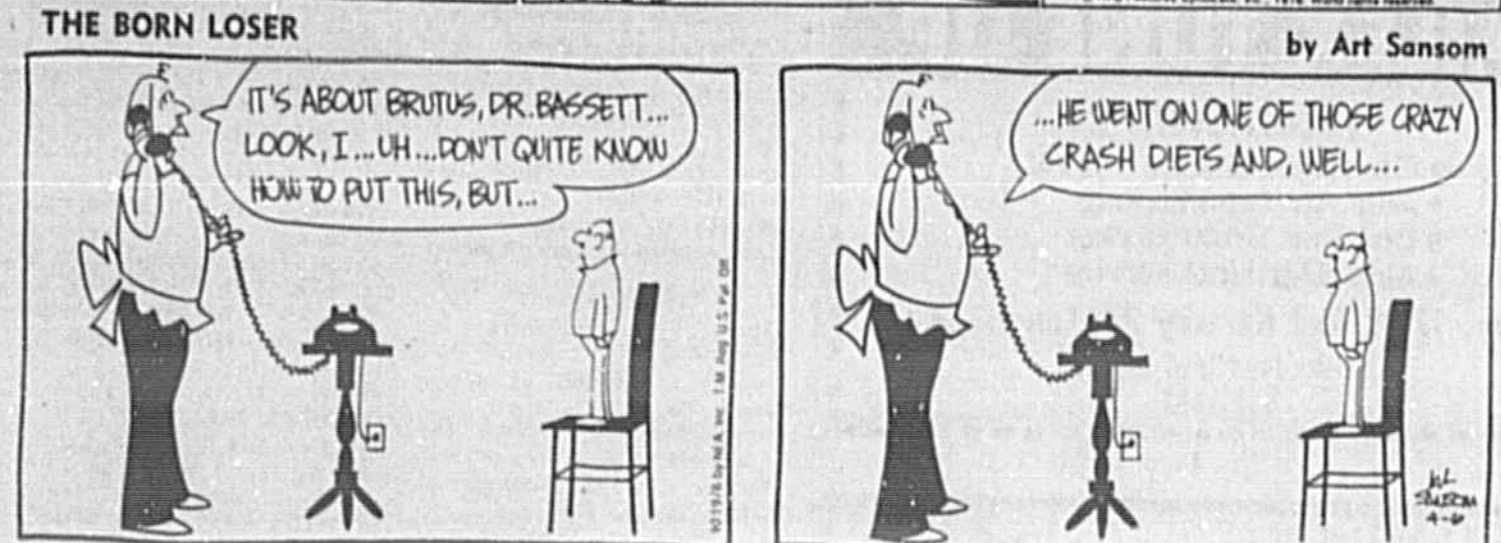

State Attorney Abbott Herring said Tuesday he is forwarding his investigation file to the Pinellas County state attorney's office for further investigation after he announced that charges against a Seminole County commissioner of using county postage and mailing supplies in a congressional campaign are "unfounded."

Herring's office spent four days investigating a complaint filed by George Saunders, campaign manager-husband of JoAnn Saunders, unannounced Democratic candidate for Florida's fifth congressional district, against an opponent in the party race for the nomination, Sid Vihlen Jr. Saunders said Vihlen had used a county envelope, the county postage meter and a county-paid secretary for campaign purposes.
