Supplant Walker And Risko If Risko Is Taken By Ratzloff

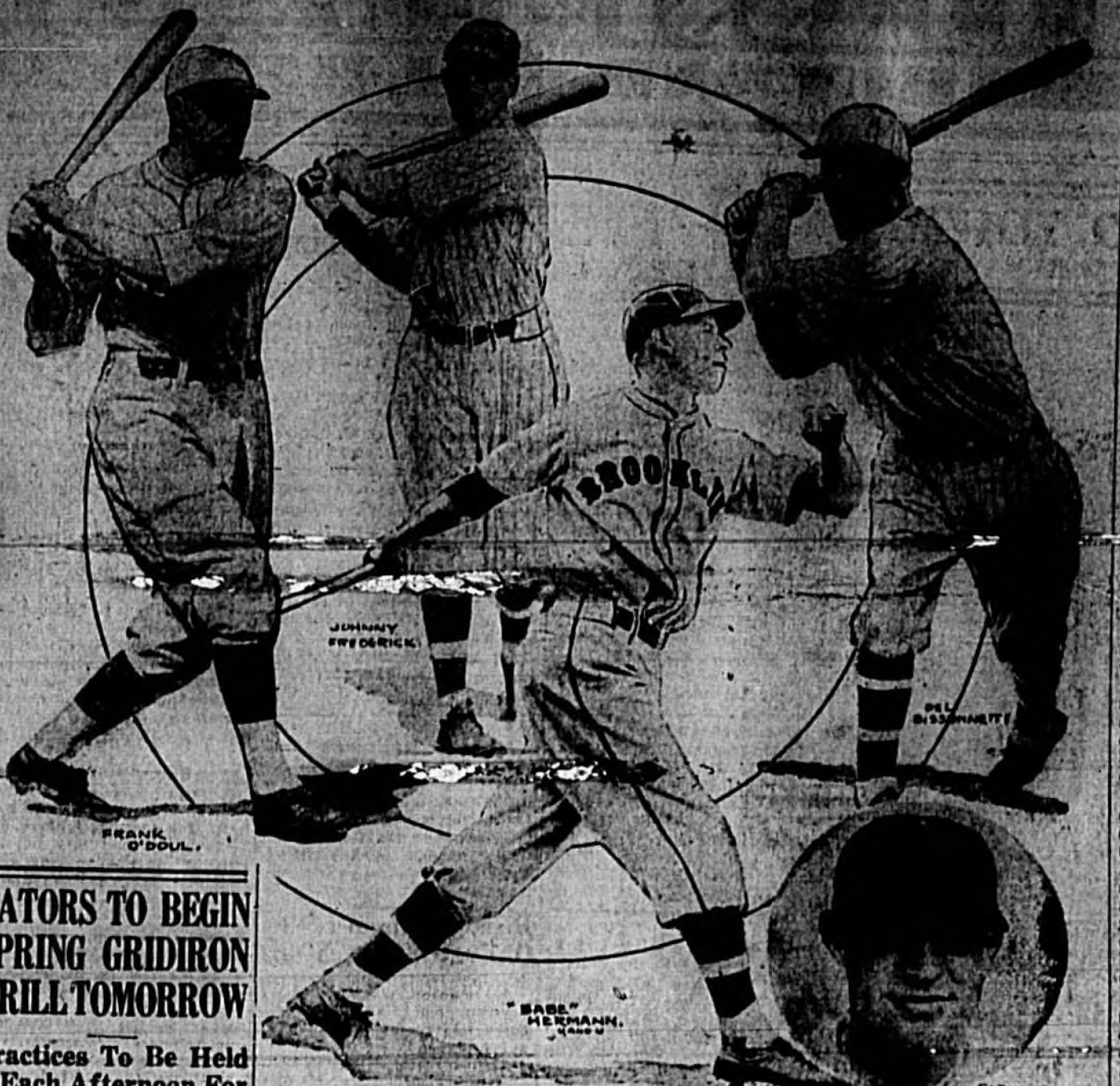
ATLANTA, Feb. 3.—(AP)—The Atlanta Journal yesterday said Jimmy Stribling and Tom Heenev may be the main attraction of the fight card at Miami, Fla., Feb. 24, supplanting Johnny Risko and Mickey Walker, if Risko does not make an impressive showing against a fighter named Ratzloff at Detroit Friday.

Walker is recognized in some circles as the middleweight champion.

Arkansas Governor Attacked In Both Legislative Halls

LITTLE ROCK, Ark., Feb. 3.—(AP)—Impeachment of Governor Parnell and Highway Commissioner Justin Matthews was introduced in violent debates in the State Legislature Monday, the senate quickly queleching a resolution aimed at the governor while the house listened throughout its sessions to repeated attacks upon him and the highway commissioner.

Senator Quarles resolution asking proceedings against Governor Parnell was met with cries of "table it" and the author was the only one of 83 senators to vote for it.

PENN. WIDE CHANGES IN ATHLETIC POLICY

Steps Are Designed To Eliminate Over-Emphasis - Complaints

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 3.—(AP)—Sweeping and sensational changes in the entire athletic system of the University of Pennsylvania, designed to eliminate so-called over-emphasis from competitive sports, were announced last night by Thomas S. Gates, university president, as the result of an exhaustive survey of conditions here and elsewhere.

Effective at once, the president's statement of policy reveals the decision to eliminate athletic training tables and spring football practice by resident intercollegiate athletes and to discontinue competition, to install all coaches as faculty members and abolish the present council on athletic control.

Under the shake-up the trustees and president of the university will exercise full responsibility. Mr. Gates announced, through a newly-created department of physical education, which will have control of student health, physical instruction and the activities of intercollegiate athletics.

To fill the important post as dean of the department of physical education, Mr. Gates announced the appointment of Dr. E. Leroy Mercer, a famous Pennsylvania all-around athlete in 1910-12 and for the last 17 years connected with Swarthmore College in the capacity of athletic director and head of the department of physical education.

There will be three divisions of the new department of physical education—student health, physical instruction and intercollegiate athletics, each in charge of a director.

Although the present council on athletics, composed of alumni, students and faculty, will be abolished, a sub-committee of it may be included in a board of athletics, serving merely in an advisory capacity.

The change in Senator Quarles' resolution against Governor Parnell were: That the governor had dominated the State banking and insurance departments, and had not enforced those laws; that he did not take proper steps to protect public funds on deposit in banks; that he sponsored a program of heavy expenditures which eventually would lead to bankruptcy; that he spent excessive sums in his last primary campaign; that he had misrepresented true conditions in Arkansas by telegram to Eastern newspapers on the subject of the drought and banking situations. 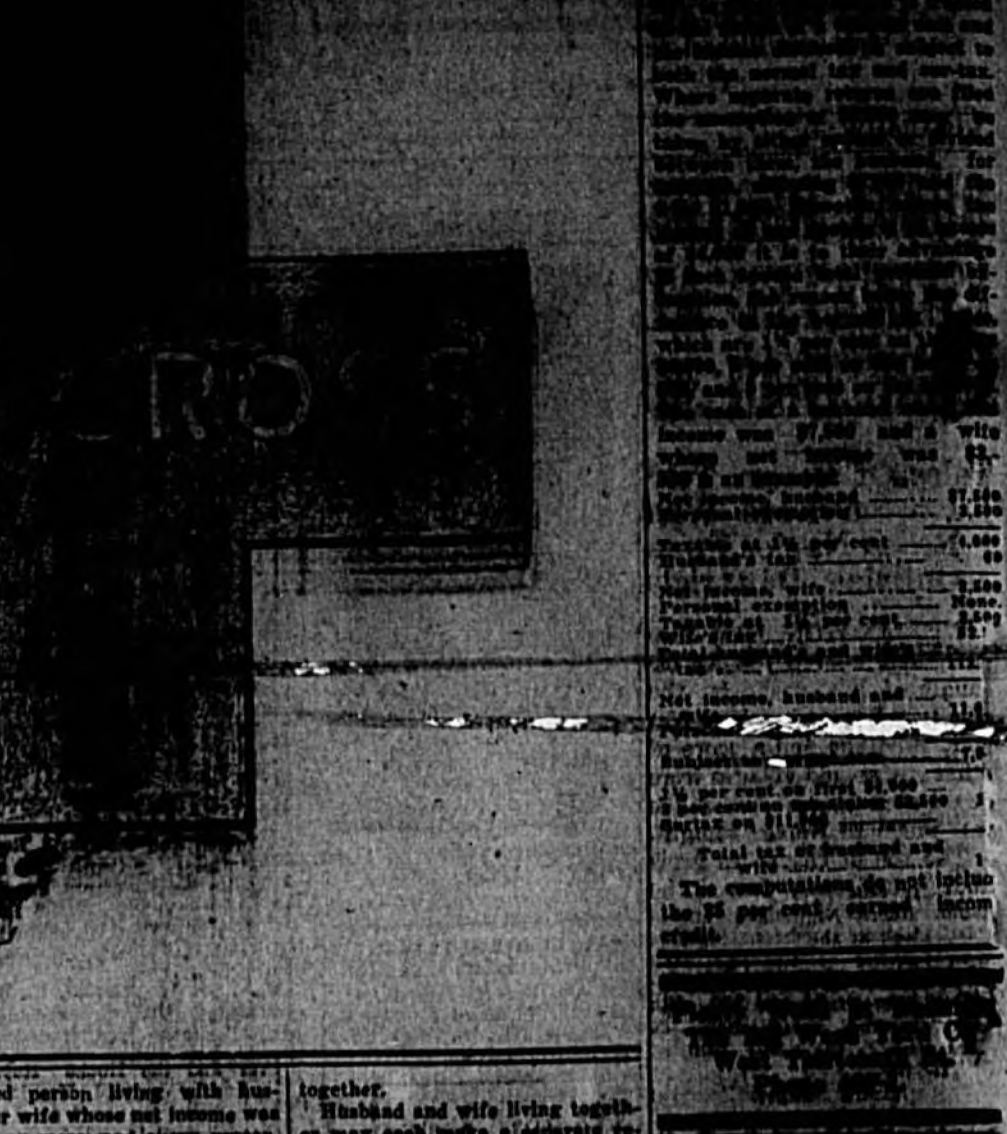
