there"a a catch: The RAF wants its imprisoned colleagues relocated in a singte prison ill; moreover, it promices to renew violent attacks If, in its vew the Cerman state oppresses the undercis.
That may be face-gaving rhetoric: Omcials say that only about 20 hard-core RAF
members remaln. More to the point, the group's chief sponsor and mefo haven communist East Germany - hae dieappeared into a unified, democrittc Germany. And although the Cerman juatice minieter spoke encouraged RAF leadern to wue for peace. he also hae natly rejected nejotlations or conceatons.
