Advertising is not a form of perpetual motion that goes on forever without human assistance. The biggest problem any man has to settle after he has determined to advertise, and de. cided HOW to advertise, is this: How can I use my advertising sc as to get the most out of it? Without close-linked co-operation it dissipates its force intr
