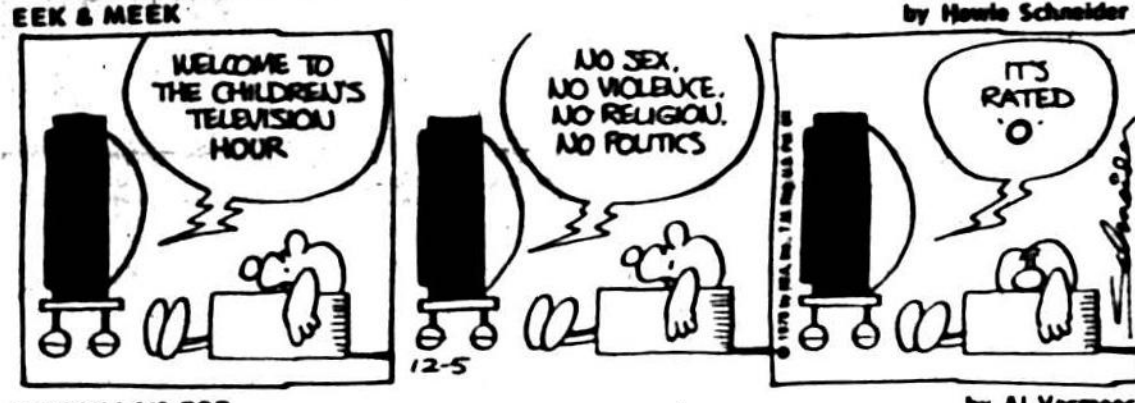

Vitamin C Doesn't Help Anyone's Cold

DEAR DR. LAMB — I've read about the cold and the flu, and I would like to know what ever happened to the idea that vitamin C prevents colds? Should I take lots of vitamin C to prevent me or is it just a waste of money?

DEAR READER — Unfortunately, a number of carefully planned research studies have failed to show that vitamin C does any good in either preventing or curing a cold. Originally one study suggested it might decrease the symptoms or shorten the duration of the cold but subsequent studies by the same group of investigators proved this to be a false lead.

DEAR DR. LAMB — You may think that is a small question but it is important to me. What are the symptoms of tapeworms in humans? How does one get a tapeworm from fish, or you can have a tapeworm in your head? The fish tapeworm is the largest tapeworm in man and it may be 30 meters long and have over 4,000 segments. In all of these the adult worm attaches itself to the wall of the intestine and the ribbons-like segment may break off and be passed in the stool. The loss of the segmented, ribbon-like structure of the body that are passed does not eliminate the worm from the intestine. As long as the head remains attached firmly in the intestinal wall, it can continue to grow more segments.

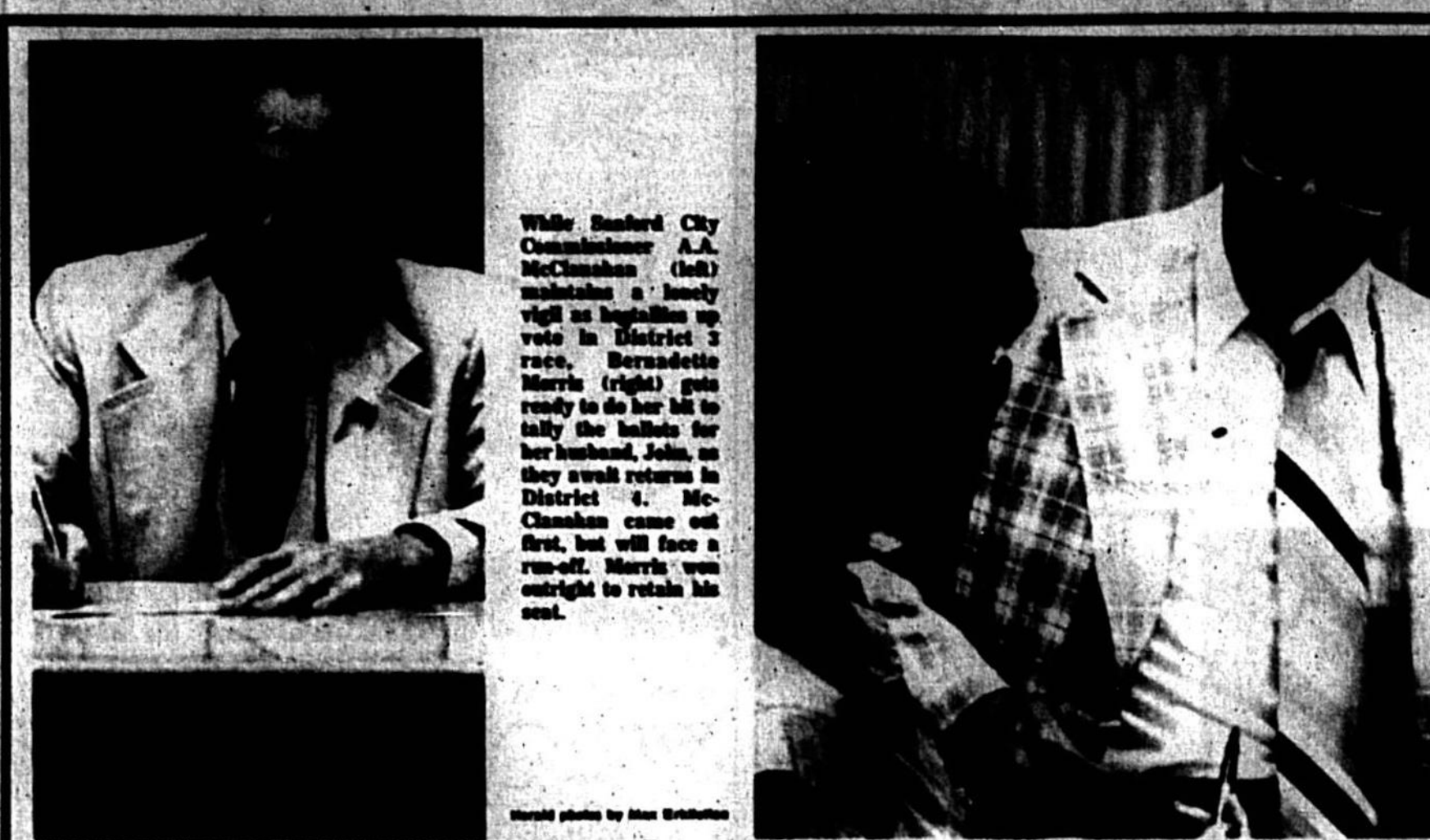

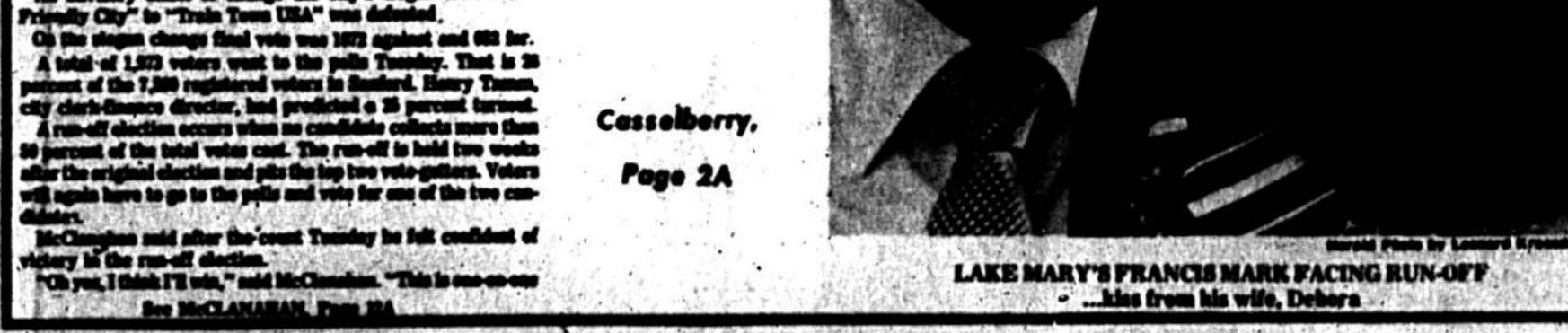

Casselberry: 2 Keep Seats On Council

Thirty-six percent of Casselberry's voters Tuesday gave votes of confidence to incumbent councilman and elected a woman to the city council for the first time in five years.

Barbara Christensen, wife of ex-Mayor Gerald Christensen, in her first try for elective office, pulled 667 votes to win, after an intensive lobbying campaign through the city. She came in second in a 23-person field.

At the same time, Councilman Frank Schutte, completed his first two-year term in office, and with the announced goal of reaching the highest number of votes cast in the election, reached his goal with 735 votes.

In addition, Schutte had campaigned hard for alternate ballots and had 47 of the 60 ballots counted.

Councilman Carl Robertson Jr. was also elected to a second two-year term with 667 votes, edging out the third incumbent, Don Wilcox, by a vote of 15 votes.

While City Clerk Mary Hershman had predicted a 24-to-26 percent turnout, 1,893 percent actually voted for a turnout of 26 percent.

The three held separate victory parties. Schutte and Robertson at their respective homes, and Mrs. Christensen at the home of Mrs. Virginia Polverio, a member of the city's civil service board.

Schutte exchanged congratulatory telephone calls with Robertson. County Commissioner Sandra Glenn called congratulatory letters to Schutte and Robertson, both of whom actively supported her during her recent campaign for county office.

It was 8:30 p.m. before the alternate ballots had been counted and official results announced.

County Commissioner Robert Shera, who had Charles Casselberry as a major supporter in his recent campaign, stated with Casselberry's city hall staff it was known that Casselberry had been elected to the city council.

Israeli Settlements Planned On West Bank?

Israel is planning to build four new settlements in the occupied West Bank in two weeks, an Israeli newspaper said today, only one day after Washington announced it was sending Secretary of State Cyrus Vance to the Middle East to salvage the peace talks with Egypt.

President Carter has repeatedly called settlements in occupied Arab land "illegal" and obstacles to peace, and the report of the new settlement activity is certainly in sharp contrast with the Israeli-Egyptian peace talks.

The Israeli newspaper, reading a "major source," said the settlements will be built "at the end of the freeze on settlement" Dec. 17. Israel agreed to the freeze at the Camp David talks at which President Carter announced the two historic accords for peace.

Israel agreed at Camp David to freeze creation of new settlements in occupied Arab territory for the duration of the peace talks with Egypt. The framework called for a truce in three months, or by Dec. 17. The Israeli report appeared to indicate Israel would proceed with the settlement drive regardless of whether the talks are concluded by then.

Before leaving for Washington on a two-day official visit today, Israeli Foreign Minister Moshe Dayan said in Tel Aviv the Dec. 17 deadline outlined at Camp David or concluding a treaty with Egypt was not absolute.

The date "has no particular significance," Dayan said. "That was a hard day for us."

"If the negotiations are not concluded and there is room for them to continue, they will continue even beyond the three-month deadline."

Dayan said one of the settlements will be built south of Hebron and another along the Jerusalem-Tel Aviv highway. In addition, the report said, the government will build up existing settlements set up by the settler-led Gush Etzion movement by providing hundreds of additional housing units.

The State Department announced Tuesday that President Carter decided Monday night to dispatch Vance to the Middle East to break a three-month deadlock in the talks, now in their third month.

Mayor Tivy Piland said today he will recommend to the city council that Wally Stalhaber be named city attorney and that the same law firm be kept as the representative.

Dizziness Different For The Young, Old

DEAR DR. LAMB— I've been having dizziness since I was a child. It's not just after having a glass of wine. It's just there. I've had it for 30 years. I'd like to know what you think I should do about it.



My dizziness is not the kind that comes on and goes off. It's just there. I've had it for 30 years. I'd like to know what you think I should do about it.

I have a thyroid deficiency associated with an enlarged gland determined by scan. I take a thyroid tablet daily and a vitamin tablet daily. I also take Valium when extremely nervous, but I have found that I am more nervous when I take it.

I'm concerned about your story of taking thyroid. If you have a true form of hypothyroidism, it is called myxedema. It is usually associated with the balance canal system in the ear or circulation in the brain or eyes. A lot of other people have dizziness which is really an onset of fainting.

The respiratory infection you had may have caused inflammation of the balance canal in your ears. In this case, the condition is usually self-healing and self-correcting in time. We call it labyrinthitis. Antiviral and other anti-infection sickness type medicines are

usually used in the treatment of such disorders. If you are continuing to have dizziness, ask your doctor to refer you to a neurologist. If you were under 20 years of age, then I might suggest that you see an ear, nose and throat specialist first. There is no real cure for dizziness, but other people more often have dizziness from problems related to circulation in the brain or ear.

Younger people are more likely to have a problem in the ear itself. At any age certain medicines can be a factor.

Dec. 7, 1941 78 —County VA Boss On Arizona

Sundays were always special days to Clint Westbrook at the beginning of the 1960s. He was in the navy then and Sundays were the only days you got to sleep late.

That one Sunday Westbrook will never erase from his mind did not seem special at the time. In fact, it was a disappointment. He was supposed to have been off for the day.

It was just Westbrook's luck to be called on to dump the garbage on the day he was supposed to have been off. What rotten luck. It probably saved his life. Had he not been on the garbage boat that Sunday he might have been sleeping late on his ship.

You see, this was not just any Sunday. This was Dec. 7, 1941.

This was not just any navy base. This was Pearl Harbor.

He was not just any ship. It was the USS Arizona. The Arizona lies now beneath the still waters of the channel that runs Ford's Island, the permanent tomb for 1,182 of Westbrook's shipmates.

The quiet man with the New York accent who serves as director of Seminole County Veterans Affairs, was a witness to history.

Thirty-seven years ago today he saw the beginning of global war and the end of many young lives.

Over the remains of the Arizona and the men entombed within, is a shining white monument accessible by four boats that visit the site hourly. The structure was assembled after the U.S. Department of Interior designated the spot a national landmark in 1954.

Visitors will come in greater numbers to the monument today — the anniversary of the attack.

It is said one can look at the water beneath the monument and see an emerging air bubble or some of the one million gallons of oil leaked on board Dec. 6, 1941.

Of all those who have seen the site, few have viewed it as Westbrook remembers it on that day so long ago.

As the 49-foot launch carrying Westbrook and a handful of fellow crewmen approached the USS Nevada, down the line from the Arizona in "Battleship Row," he heard

Legionnaire Clinic Started In Sanford

In what may be a first for an American Legion Post in the United States, Sanford Post 33 has opened an out-patient clinic on its premises.

Initially the post, at 3306 Orlando Drive, (U.S. 17-81) is offering out-patient care two days a week, Mondays and Thursdays.

The man behind the clinic, Post Commander Octavio "George" Cintron of Sanford said he hopes to expand the program and include 24-hour

emergency ambulance service for anyone who needs the services.

"We have to do this," Cintron said. "There is so much red tape with the veterans administration (V.A.) Now we just do it and send them the paperwork."

Cintron said the red tape has prompted many local doctors to ask for cash from veterans and Medicare patients.

"Twenty to thirty-five percent of the doctors in town won't take it," he said. "They want you to pay cash and then you can apply to the veterans ad-

ministration for a refund and wait 90 days.

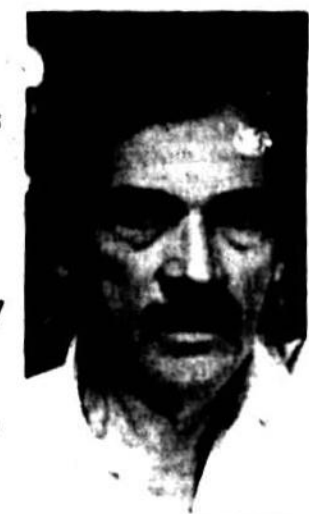
"But, a lot of people can't afford to lay out that kind of cash. How are they supposed to live in the meantime?"

"This is everybody's problem," Cintron said. "It's not my problem. My God, somebody has to help them. They helped us."

He said many local veterans have been forced to travel to Orlando's V.A. clinic for medical treatment.

In addition to the convenience the new clinic offers veterans, Cintron, who is retired, is an

head to help patients fill out the often complicated V.A. forms for payment of benefits.

Two Orlando doctors traveled to the Sanford post to provide treatment. On Mondays, a heart specialist complete with cardiograph machine works at the clinic.

On Thursdays, a general practitioner complete with a portable X-ray machine works at the clinic. There is also a social worker on hand Thurs-

days to handle personal problems.

The clinic's hours vary, but generally they are open from 9 a.m. until 1 p.m. or until the doctors are done with their work.

Cintron said the clinic is open to anyone and the fee is about the same as one would pay at any doctor's office. However, he said if someone was unable

School Board, Clerks Approve Pact For 400

School district clerical workers and the Seminole County School Board have reached agreement on a new contract, bringing to an end six months of negotiations marred by the clerical association's internal strife.

The agreement which affects about 400 workers is retroactive to Aug. 1 and was greeted with applause by the approximately 30 workers who had gathered Wednesday at Lyman High School's library.

The contract still has to be approved by the general membership of Seminole Educational Clerical Association (SECA) as well as the school board.

If ratified, it would be the last of the four employee associations to successfully bargain a contract.

SECA employees fall into three categories depending upon the number of months they work—10, 11 or 12.

In the 10-month category, a first year, 10-month aide will be increased from \$4,735 to \$4,874. An aide with four years' experience will be increased from \$5,283 to \$5,397. An aide with nine years' experience will receive an increase from \$5,925 to \$6,123.

In the 11-month category, a first year, 11-month secretary will receive an increase from \$5,775 to \$5,941. A secretary with four years' experience will get an increase from \$6,488 to \$6,676 while a secretary with nine years' experience will go from \$7,373 to \$7,587.

In the 12-month category, a new, 12-month secretary will get a salary increase from \$6,388 to \$6,588. A secretary

with four-years' experience will receive an increase from \$7,083 to \$7,413 while a secretary with nine years' experience will go from \$8,583 to \$8,928.

In the current school budget, \$1,028,000 has been allocated for clerical workers' salaries compared to \$1,530,000 last year, according to Roger Harris, assistant superintendent for budget and finance.

The last negotiations on Oct. 24 stalled when both sides could not agree and the school board declared an impasse while the SECA side said it would ask for

a federal mediator. School Board negotiator Ernest Crowley had planned to meet with SECA in early November, but on the advice of the board attorney the decision was changed because there were two groups claiming to represent SECA.

However, this week representatives from the two SECA factions got together and asked the school board for another negotiating session and the board agreed. Throughout the six months of See SECA PACT, Page 2A

Petitions Circulated In Longwood Over Trash Pickup

City trash collection, scheduled to be dropped after Dec. 28, is far from a dead issue in Longwood, according to interim City Administrator David Cheary.

"I have already received a couple of petitions asking that it be continued and the petitions have asked to be on the agenda at Mayor's meeting," he said. "I'm prepared to go either way."

Action taken Nov. 13 by the city commission to discontinue the city trash collection after more than 50 years, became an issue in Cheary's recent election.

The first petitions returned to office — E. Russell Grant and Stephen Barton — credited their opposition to stopping the service the important factor in their victory.

"Every place I went in the city the people said the same thing,"

said Barton after Tuesday's win. "The people told me trash collection is one service where they can see what their taxes are being used for."

Notions were mailed out with the December water bills informing the residents that city crews would no longer collect

trash as of Jan. 1. The city has been investigating the option of granting a single garbage collection franchise in the city to a company that would also provide trash pickup. There are several private firms operating in the city at present, some of which provide trash

pickup to customers.

"I found that one of the concerns when I went around campaigning was that they have their own garbage companies and they want to keep it that way," said Grant. "I don't see any way we can franchise it. I don't think the people would put up with it."

According to former councilman Perry White, there are five petitions circulating in different sections of the city stating "We don't want to discontinue free trash collection at the city after 60 years and don't want franchise garbage service."

"But a one has returned to sign," he added. "This election came out the way it did because of the trash issue. We've got to change some minds. We'll find out Monday at John Crystal of Highland Hills has asked to be put on the agenda to present the petitions."

"The whole city is disturbed. This is a service we pay for with our taxes. They had \$5,000 in the contingency fund for trash collection and I see no reason to discontinue it," said White. "The city is well off."

During the years it has operated in the city, the trash collection was halted for one six-month period as an economy move by a former city council, but was restored after numerous complaints by residents.

"I'm sure it will be coming up at the next meeting," Grant said, "and I look for 600 to 800 names on the petitions. The residents deserve the best service we can give them for the money they pay. There is no way we can get rid of the trash truck as we have got to have something to keep our streets clean anyway."

Councilman Ray Lottensberger, who along with Councilman Larry Goldberg and Jim Laramoni voted to halt the trash collection, has called the next to the city "representative." At the next meeting Lottensberger said, "The trash is short, it's a long proposition." Grant, however, insisted, "The truck can be fixed."

At the Oct. 5, meeting the commission voted to spend \$500 to replace the engine in the trash truck and it was repaired.
