U. S. Accused Of Art Distortion

MOSCOW, Feb. 8.—(AP)—The Russian paper Soviet Art has protested violently against "unbridled distortions" of Russian classics on the stages of Broadway and Paris.

The Soviet paper the organ of the committee on art affairs, quoted the New York Times in telling its readers recently that Joshua Logan was reported engaged in adaptation of a folk play, "The Cherry Orchard," to the tastes of the American audience by transferring the action to Louisiana where it is set in a de-integrating plantation owner's family.

Soviet art protested strongly against this.

Further, the paper reported that in the Paris Ballet Sergei Lifar had transferred a variation from the third act of "Swan Lake" by Tchaikovsky into the ballet "Sleeping Beauty". In another version of "Sleeping Beauty," said the paper, Lifar had acted parts of "The Nutcracker."

Soviet Art said this can only be described as "direct distortion" of the classics, but that this is a necessary part of the decay and disintegration of the West that Broadway is the seat of.

(Recipe for Starred Dish Follows)

PEANUT BUTTER BREAD

Ingredients: 2 cups sifted all-purpose flour, 3 teaspoons baking powder, 1 1/4 teaspoons salt, 1 1/2 cup sugar, 1 cup chunk-style peanut butter, 2 eggs, 1 1/4 cups milk.

Method: Mix and sift into a medium-size mixing bowl the flour, baking powder, salt and sugar. Cut in the peanut butter with pastry blender or two knives, or rub in with fingertips. Beat the eggs until foamy with a rotary beater; add the milk and beat again to combine. Make a well in the center of the dry ingredients and add egg milk; stir only enough
