MILLS GIVES ESTIMATION OF BEER REVENUE

Avers Tax Upon Brew Will Not Balance Budget, Predicting 150 Million Income

WASHINGTON, Dec. 14.—(AP)—Secretary Mills gave the House Ways and Means Committee today an estimate of the revenue a beer bill might bring in but left it to draw its own conclusions as to whether the President would give his signature that would start beer flowing.

He said legalization of beer would not produce enough revenue by itself to balance the budget. He estimated it would bring in between \$125,000,000 and \$150,000,000 yearly.

The beer provisions of the Miller bill were described as practicable of administration, the wine section "impracticable." Mills urged a non-partisan program to balance the budget by adoption of a general manufacturers sales tax.

Mills declined to answer directly questions by Representative Rainey, committee chairman, as to whether the Pres. will sign the beer bill or whether the administration favors it.

Confronted by powerful movement to modify the prohibition laws, chairman of the committee smashed them full for a moment the other day before the Senate, before the House Ways and Means Committee.

They were led by Bishop Jospeh Cannon, Jr., of the Methodist Episcopal Church in South, who asserted Congress is without authority to fix the absolute content of beverages, and they enthusiastically ratified their argument at the committee despite close questioning from its members.

Drawing the largest crowd that had jammed the big chamber since hearings began last Wednesday with the wets testifying, the drys put toward Deets Eblette, research secretary of the board of temperance, prohibition and public morals of the Methodist Episcopal Church.
