### New Oviedo School Planning Underway

 Preliminary planning for the new junior-senior high school complex for Oviedo is under way. Tentative dates for construction is set for October of 1967 with completion date for the first phase in August, 1968.  
 Facilities are planned for eventually becoming a complete senior high school with an enrollment of 1,500. The high school will be fed with a system consisting of two junior high schools, with an enrollment of 1,250 each, and six elementary schools with enrollment of 500 each.  
 Bids for the \$450,000 first phase will be asked in September. The first phase, which will be used by the present junior-senior high school in '68, will consist of 16 general classrooms, two science labs, a band suite, and a home economics suite. Because the entire project will have not been completed by the fall of '68, some of the general classrooms will be used for administrative purposes and as a library.  
 The entire high school complex, which will cost approximately 1.8 million dollars, will be air-conditioned and have wall to wall carpeting inside.  
 In addition to classroom facilities included in the completed high school, there will be a gymnasium, cafeteria, auditorium, administration offices, and a driving range.  
 To help with the preliminary Oviedo school facility, the various departments to draw up preliminary specifications for Architect Neil Switzer, Chairman for the facility committee will be Mrs. Neil DeShazo, mathematics; Mrs. Donna Neely, language arts; and Mrs. Virginia Miller, library.
