Auto Accidents

A shocking increase in motor vehicle fatalities is reported by the Metropolitan Insurance Company, which points out that for the first six months of the year the death toll was 24 per cent higher this year than last among the Company's Industrial policyholders.

The rise has been particularly large at ages 20 to 24, where it was 65 per cent among men and even more among women. The use of delapidated cars by young people, the lack of recent driving experience, and the greater desire for motoring following the lifting of driving restrictions, are held by the company as contributing factors to the increasing motor vehicle deaths.

The one bright spot in the report is the reduction in motor vehicle deaths among school children, particularly at ages 10 to 14. At these ages, the decrease from the first half of last year was about one quarter among boys and two thirds among girls.

Endorsing the recommendations of the President's Highway Safety Conference, the Metropolitan says that "nothing but the wholehearted cooperation of the rank and file of citizens in their usual roles as drivers or pedestrians" will stem this rising tide of casualties.

World Health

A constitution for a World Health Organization has been signed by 60 delegates to the United Nations Health Assembly in New York City. Dr. Thomas Parran, presiding officer of the meeting and head of the U. S. Public Health Service, called it "a Magna Carta for health."

Prevention of disease is a first objective of the organization, according to Dr. Parran. It will "help to heal the ancient human plagues, such as malaria and cholera, tuberculosis and syphilis," he said.

The charter has yet to be ratified by the government of the United Nations. It would create the first international public health agency with power to act in the various countries.

Through such an organization the medical achievements of great scientists throughout the world could be interchanged easily and used for the benefit of all the member nations.

Casey Jones

He rode with Casey Jones. This is the title to fame of John Eubanks, who was Casey's fireman on the Illinois Central railroad and has just died. He escaped the fatal ride, being off duty that day. For that matter the fireman, John Luther Jones, who replaced him on April 30, 1900, the day of the famous ride into "the promised land," lived at least 40 years after the crash.

Casey, then, and the other features of the song were historic. A monument to him at Cayce, Ky., records the fact. This is a comfort in the days when historians are all taking the joy out of life by insisting that the most picturesque stories of history are simply not true. It is good to know that there really was a Casey Jones.

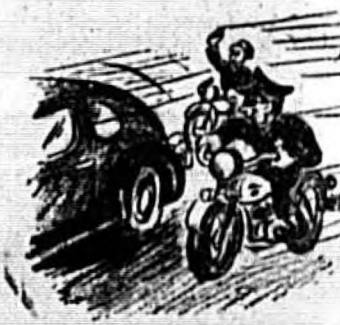
