Nazi Tank Troops Lunge Deeper Into Volga Metropolis

Army Newspaper Says Defenders Reach "Hour Of Supreme Peril" In Battle

(By Associated Press) The defenders of siegework Stalingrad are facing the "most decisive moment." In the 38 days of struggle, it was announced officially today, an fresh German tanks lunged deeper into the Volga metropolis at a terrible cost of men and machines.

The Russian newspaper Red Star said this was an hour of supreme peril and declared there is no plan to retreat. Present Stalin personally telephones an order to Soviet troops to continue to stand firm and put down Nazi tanks.

Thousands of civilians are reported aiding in Red army troops in street battles, and latest reports said the defenders are counter attacking Hitler in response to Stalin's message.

Volga River sailors and dock workers continued at their jobs despite incessant attacks by 1,000 Nazi bombers.

The new German thrust was engineered in a less Field Marshal Rundstedt. The successor to Von Bock was reported to be writing into Stalingrad's industrial northwest suburbs. In the central Caucasus the approaches to the Grozny oil fields were declared to be "raking all enemy attacks and inflicting heavy losses."

An early report today stated, "The Russian offensive against the Nazi flank above Stalingrad was gaining ground. The communists said Russian troops captured another hilltop after a savage all-day fight in fog weather, and repelled Nazi counterattacks in another area of the front."

The main attack in the Caucasus was southeast of Novorossiisk where the Russians said the third German mountain division, in addition to 8,000 dead and wounded, lost 25 guns, 10 tanks, 12 machine guns, 50 motor vehicles and two ammunition dumps.

"One platoon of Romanian soldiers came over to the side of the Red Army," the communists said.

In the middle Caucasus the Russians said they destroyed 55 Nazi tanks and 10 planes, and annihilated about 1,500 enemy officers and men." All the Axis attempts to advance were repelled, the communists added.

Boat transports operating in the Baltic were said to have sunk a 10,000-ton enemy transport.

In the vicious fight for Stalingrad the Germans were reported using fleets of armored cars packed with Tommy-guns and covered by tanks.

Army Begins Mailing Dependents' Checks

WASHINGTON, Oct. 1. (AP)—Distribution of \$19,250,000 in family allowances to dependents of enlisted men will be made in 275,000 checks which the War Department announced yesterday.

Of the total, 135,561 checks represent first payments, and the others will receive their initial allowances in two monthly checks right.

The checks will be sent to the dependents of all men serving in the armed forces.
