Sheriff Polk Named In Class Action Suit

Inmates Seek Restraining Order

Some inmates of the Seminole County Jail yesterday filed a class action in Circuit Court seeking an injunction restraining Sheriff John Polk from returning them to the county lock-up.

The suit was filed by Joseph Robert Hart, one of 23 inmates who are currently being housed elsewhere while the Seminole County Jail is repaired.

Hart's action was handled by attorneys for Public Defender Frank Kelley, who requested a hearing in Circuit Court on the injunction before July 15.

The suit cites "cruel and unusual punishment" as chief reason for the injunction request, saying that the return of the inmates to the jail is mentally "agitating them beyond their capacity to fully help defend themselves."

All of the inmates involved in the suit were in the county jail when fire swept through the

facility on June 9, killing 16 other prisoners and one jailer.

Polk, when notified of the suit, was in conference with County Commission Chairman Sid Vallen Jr., but broke up the meeting long enough to speak with The Herald.

"So be it," the sheriff said. "Let them sue. Other than that, I have no comment."

When would make no comment at all, for the record, concerning the latest legal action stemming from the tragic fire.

The suit further contends that the prospect of being returned to the jail prevents the 23 inmates from assisting and cooperating with their various attorneys in preparing their defenses.

The jail fire is currently under investigation by the Seminole County Grand Jury.

Polk has not yet appeared before the jury, but is expected to offer testimony early next week — probably Tuesday when the investigation resumes.

The class action is the fourth civil suit filed as a result of the jail fire. The other three actions are civil cases brought by relatives of inmates killed in the fire. Polk is the only defendant named in any of the suits.

Kelley and members of the public defender's staff have appeared before the grand jury, apparently to provide information about meeting between the public defenders and clients confined in the jail.

The inmates named in the suit against Polk include: Daniel Williams, Isaac F. Jones, Otis Lee Jackson, Donnie Yates, J. D. Splies, Paul F. Gregor, Donnie F. Clanton and Hart.

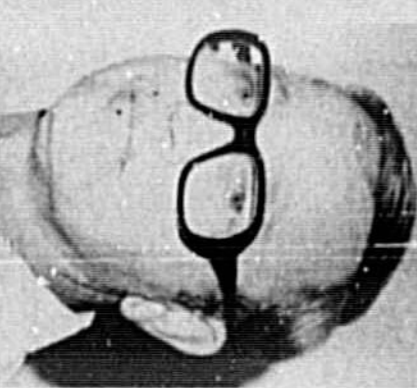
