Flames Trap, Burn 265 To Death On Arabian Jet

JEDDAH, Saudi Arabia (UPI) — A Saudi Arabian Airways passenger jet that caught fire and was forced back to Riyadh for an emergency landing ended in flames on the ground, trapping and killing all 265 people on board...

"But the fire had engulfed most of the aircraft," a joint statement by the Saudi Civilian Aviation authorities and the Saudi airline said, explaining the rescuers could not get near the burning craft.

On the ground, the plane went to the end of a runway as rescue workers dashed out and the pilot radioed the crew was trying to remove the passengers through the emergency exits.

Feds Sue Auto-Train

By DIANE PETRYK, Herald Staff Writer The U.S. Justice Department and the Interstate Commerce Commission filed suit Tuesday in U.S. District Court in Washington to force Auto-Train Corp. to put \$500,000 into a special bank account to cover advance bookings should the company go bankrupt.

Daniel Linhardt, senior trial attorney with the ICC Office of Consumer Protection, said the suit is a result of Auto-Train's failure to comply with a Dec. 7, 1979 order requiring the money to be deposited by March 15, 1980.

Linhardt explained that the firm maintains running advance ticket sales of \$3 million to \$4 million. If the corporation goes into bankruptcy the ticket purchasers would have to compete with large creditors for refunds, he said.
