



OAKLAND, Calif. (UPI) - The three wealthy young men who admitted kidnapping 26 schoolchildren and their bus driver must spend the rest of their lives in prison without hope of parole - on their conviction of kidnaping with bodily injury.

Alameda County Superior Court Leo Deegan, in a surprisingly quick decision Thursday, said a review of the testimony in the 16-day trial convinced him that the defendants forced the victims to experience an "ordeal by terror."

Frederick Woods, 26; Richard Schoenfeld, 26, and his brother, James, 23 - all from wealthy San Francisco Peninsula families pleaded guilty to simple kidnap charges and innocent to charges of kidnapping with bodily

Manson Murder Victim Found

LOS ANGELES (UPI) - The missing body of a ranch hand stabbed to death and beheaded by the Charles Manson "family" eight years ago has been found, the sheriff's office reported Thursday.

Deputies dug up the bones of Donald Shea after the location of his grave, long a secret within the Manson clan, was revealed by an informant, a sheriff's spokesman said.

Mix Plan Shelved

DAYTON, Ohio (UPI) - A federal judge has paved the way for the dismantling of a sweeping school desegregation plan in Dayton, dismissing a long-standing NAACP suit that charged the city's schools were racially imbalanced.

The ruling late Thursday by U.S. District Court Judge Carl Rubin stemmed from a U.S. Supreme Court decision last summer that substantially narrowed the scope of judicial power to remedy racial segregation in



Defense: That's **NATO Priority**

From Brussels comes word that European members of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization are leaning toward an affirmative decision on deployment of the so-called neutron

The problem, however, is to get past political and diplomatic hurdles that may arise if they propose to arm tactical missiles with a warhead being denounced as "inhumane."

Decisions dictated by military considerations are not always in harmony with the prevailing political mood within NATO countries or with the drift in relations among the 15 members of the alliance. That problem has plagued NATO throughout its history, and it was evident at the semi-annual

meeting of defense ministers in Brussels. President Carter has sensed resistance to proceeding with manufacture of the "enhanced radiation weapon" dubbed the neutron bomb, which would be more deadly to an advancing enemy force but less destructive to the surrounding countryside than tactical nuclear weapons already deployed by NATO.

He has left the decision on deployment to the Europeans. The only foreseeable use for the weapon would be to stall an invasion of Western Europe by the Soviet Union and its Warsaw Pact

Gen: H. F. Zeiner-Gunderson, the Norweigian who currently heads the NATO military committee, said the case for the neutron bomb is hardly arguable so long as the Warsaw Pact maintains its present superiority of ground forces vis-a-vis NATO. From the standpoint of the generals, the, the issue is closed.

But it is not closed from the diplomatic standpoint, because the Russians are pressuring the United States to abandon the new weapon on grounds it amounts to an escalation of the arms

By the same token, Europen military commanders are fearful that diplomacy will rob their defenses of a cruise missile with range enough to be effective as a deterrent against attack from the

U. S. Defense Secretary Harold Brown has confirmed that a cruise missile range limitation will be feature of the strategic arms limitation agreement now being negotiated by the United States and the Soviet Union.

The strength of NATO defenses also is in danger of falling victim to rivalries and political pressures within the alliance. President Carter is having trouble getting European members to increase their defense budgets by three percent per year, as he urged last spring, unless the United States ageeds to buy more military hardware from European manufacturers.

To do so, of course, would put Mr. Carter in the position of "exporting" American jobs to Europe. There is no sign that the Carter administration

places any less importance on NATO than any of its predecessors. but events have combined to pose difficult choices for the United States as the nation whose support is essential for the integrity of the

We are carrying the ball for the West in highlevel negotiations for arms control at the same time NATO faces a growing disparity between its forces and the strength of the Warsaw Pact on the other side of the Iron Curtain.

It is a time when military strategists who think in terms of tanks, troops and firepower must compete with those whose concern is negotiating strategy or economic strategy.

What are the priorities? For NATO the answer is obvious. Its first order of business is to assure that its combined forces can repel an attack quickly

under any circumstances. If those military considerations are forced to take a back seat to politics and diplomacy, it will become an alliance relying more on plans and paperwork than troops and weapons and that is hardly a formula for security.
