## Reagan leaves Moscow, heads to London

MOSCOW (UPI) — President Reagan and Soviet leader Mikhail Gorbachev ended their fourth summit today with heartfelt farewells stressing hopes for peace, but Gorbachev urged Reagan to speed the expansion of U.S.-Soviet relations.

Reagan headed to London shortly after 11 a.m. (3 a.m. EDT) for an overnight stay and meetings with Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher and other British officials.

A steady drizzle, the first rain since the summit began Sunday, and a band playing American military marches accompanied the presidential departure at the end of a visit that had its difficult and touchy moments.

"Our dialogue has not been

easy, but we mustered enough realism and political will to overcome obstacles and divert the train of U.S.-Soviet relations from a dangerous track to a safer one," Gorbachev said in a farewell in the Kremlin's ornate St. George's Hall.

Gorbachev said since the outset of their relationship, "We've come a long way."

However, the Communist Party boss gently chided the president for the sometimes plodding pace toward normal and more relaxed relations. The dialogue has "so far been moving much more slowly than is required by the real situation both in our two countries and in the whole world," he said.

Reagan — speaking in the hall decorated with a frieze of St.

George slaying a dragon — focused on accomplishments he saw made during the talks, saying: "I would like to think that our efforts during these past few days have slayed a few dragons and advanced the struggle against the evils that threaten mankind."

Gorbachev also asked the Soviet leader to carry a personal message to the Soviet people from him and first lady Nancy Reagan.

"Tell them, too, we will remember all of our days their faces, the faces of hope, hope for a new era in human history, an era of peace between our nations and peoples."

Gorbachev took note of the advances made in four summits telling Reagan, "Over the past

three years our two nations have come to know each other better. They have really taken a better look in each other's eyes and have a keener sense of need to live together on this beautiful planet Earth."

Reagans, before the brief Kremlin farewell, bade goodbye to the staff of the U.S. Embassy. The Gorbachevs waved to the Reagans as their limousine pulled away from the Kremlin for Vnukovo airport.

Before making their remarks the two leaders and their wives chatted amiably with the help of interpreters, gesturing, laughing and touching each other occasionally to stress a point.

"I hope you will have pleasant memories" of the Moscow visit Gorbachev told the Reagans.

Staff sergeant Folole Salanoa of the Sanford Army Recruiting Station presented the awards, bronzed Olympic-style medals.


