## President Bush is calling for finspired the 101st Congress? Recently, Ifberal Sen. Constopher Dodd. D.Conn., announced that conservative Sen. Orrin Hiatch, IR-Utah, Is one of the co-sponsors of the Democrats 82.5 billon child-care bill. Sen. Hatch responded several days hiter by llsting Sen. Dodd aq it co-sponsor of the iess-expensive Republican

This newfound splite of bpartisanahip has polttical analystas scratchisu thelr heads in
disbelief because the chlld care issue in the past has prompted blter wrangling between were more than 100 unsuccessful proposals o provide federal assilstance to two-carner familles. Yct, the combatants now appear determined to achleve a compremise that will be acceptable to Prealdent Bush.

Predtetably. the Democrats and Re. publicans approach the problem of child care
from opposite posilions. The Democrats favor from opposite positions. The Democrats favor federal substules for how urd middie-Income health and safety standards for day-car= facillties. For their part. the Republicans support modest tnx credits to help poorer families with ther child-care expenses. They
also oppose the creatfon of an expanding federal bureaucracy to oversee child care centers.
New reports advlse that both aldey havo to spend rederal day greater funds. provlde for employer-sponsored programs, and permit aunts, and uncles who provide such care. But what about those parents who put thelr children In day-care centers operated by churches or synagogues? The Democrats bill
would deny federal assistance to centers with relighous afmilations. thus malniatining the these centers are preferred by same parents.
Another issue is the income celling. The care for familles carning an much as 848,000 per year. The Republican bill is less specific because all of tis funds would be carmarked for any famuly, wealthy or poor. Under order to qualtiy for tax crodits for day care This. in turn. enables the wealthiest 30 percent of the families to recelve 50 percent of
the $\$ 4$ billion m such benclis while the pourest thilrd recedved only three percent.
