Saints To Sign Pitcher To Replace Lefty Schneider With Capitals Sign Leading Hitter Of Their League

TALLAHASSEE, Sept. 12.—The Tallahassee Capitals, champions of the Georgia-Florida "C" League for the past two years, prepared yesterday to meet the championship St. Augustine Saints of the Florida State League here today in the opening of a seven-game series.

Manager Dutch Hoffman, colorful and capable leader of the Capitals, sent his charges through a final workout yesterday afternoon. The team was given an off-day Thursday following their four straight victories over the Cordoba Reds.

Final arrangements for the series were laid at a meeting here this afternoon between Eddie Gilliland of DeLand, president of the Florida State League, and Col. H. H. Fort of American, president of the Georgia-Florida circuit.

Final plans for the cut in receipts, number of players allowed each club were completed and four umpires, two from each league, were selected. The Florida State League will be represented by Archie Campbell and Al Harvin and the Georgia-Florida League will have Bob Vickers and C. C. Hodges on the field.

The Capitals and Saints will play here Sunday afternoon and also after an off-day Monday will resume their warfare in St. Augustine Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. If other games are necessary they will be played here next Saturday and Sunday.

Each team was granted the opportunity to obtain one extra player for the series. Tallahassee selected Dan Amaral of Cordoba, leading hitter of the league to replace Frank Peat who was recalled by the Nashville Volunteers of the Southern Association. The Saints will select a pitcher from their own circuit to replace Lefty Schneider, who obtained his release.

Manager Hoffman announced yesterday afternoon he would send Earl Allen, star right-hander, to the hill against the Saints in the series opener today. Allen won two of the four games from Cordoba in the play-off series, shutting them out with five hits Tuesday night.

Manager Fred Francis of St. Augustine who brought his club to Tallahassee yesterday afternoon could not be reached for his starting mound selection. Perry, apparently in the mood for anything but a tennis match, loafed through the first three sets and finally went to work in the fourth, although at no time was he really going un-der a full head of steam.

Judge, showing at his best form since he returned from England last month, disposed of Frank Parker of Spring Lake, N. J., in straight sets, 6-1, 6-3, 6-3, and if nothing else, assured himself the No. 1 spot in the national ranking list for this year.

Which two are the top ranking tackle just now, well, the old story of your guess being just as good as mine is especially true at this time.

Pierce; Luke Kaelol St. Petersburg; Ben Porek, Orlando, and Paul Whitley, Jacksonville, are juniors on the squad, but in the time they've romped around with the Gators, only Kiefler and Porek have earned an "F" for their bowing over of the opposition. Coming up from the freshman squad of last fall are a couple of lads, John Crabtree, West Palm Beach and Gordon Gardner, Tampa. Then there are three transfers here from junior colleges, George Swartz, Covington, Tenn.; Jim Masters, New Port, Tenn.; and Joe Hardwick, Daytona Beach.

Each of these 10 is clearly the keeper of his own gridiron destiny. No one has made such a profound impression up to this writing as to suggest that he will be on the first lineup which Cody calls out for the Citadel fray here Oct. 5.

Six of these 10 tackles—Yen, Kaelol, Whitley, Owens, Masters and Hardwick, range from 200 up to 215 pounds. The sophomores, Gardner and Crabtree are the lightest, 190 and 185, yet this boy Gardner has side-line critics inclined to believe his unrestrained aggressiveness will make him a top flight contender. None will play, if his work last year continues, more furiously than Kiefler, and he's not in the 200 pound class.

You just can't tell. These boys have a big job ahead of them for tackle play is just as important as ever. That they will hustle, put forth 100 percent, we don't doubt. It will be interesting to watch these big line-men settle their own races before wading into opposing ends and backs a few weeks hence.
