



An answer to the mystery was suggested today in a dispatch from Nucriberg by one of the eight Allied correspondents who was in on those last futal hours. The newsmen had been taken on tour of the death row in Nuernberg prison shortly before the executions were to start and there was considerable commotion, with the correspondents-peeking into the small tron-barred portholes of each of the condemned men's cells.


