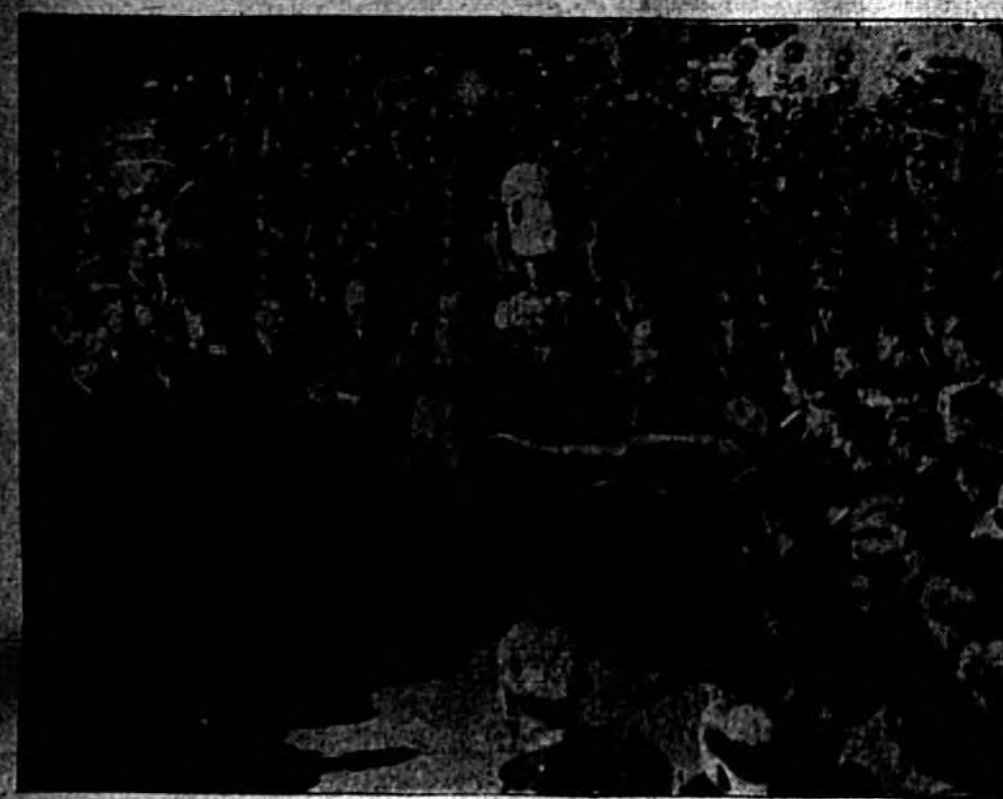


AT DEDICATION OF BONNET CARRE SPILLWAY

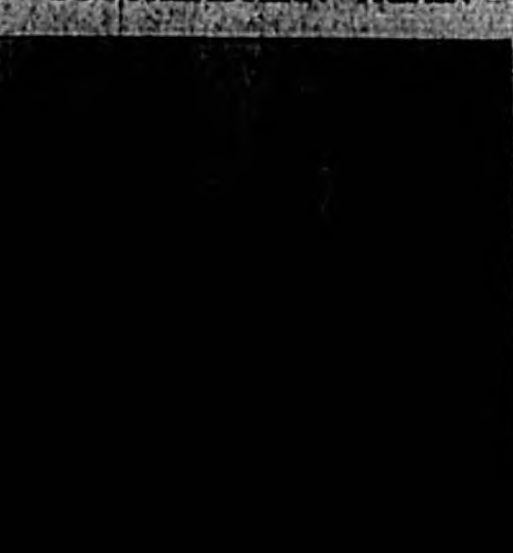

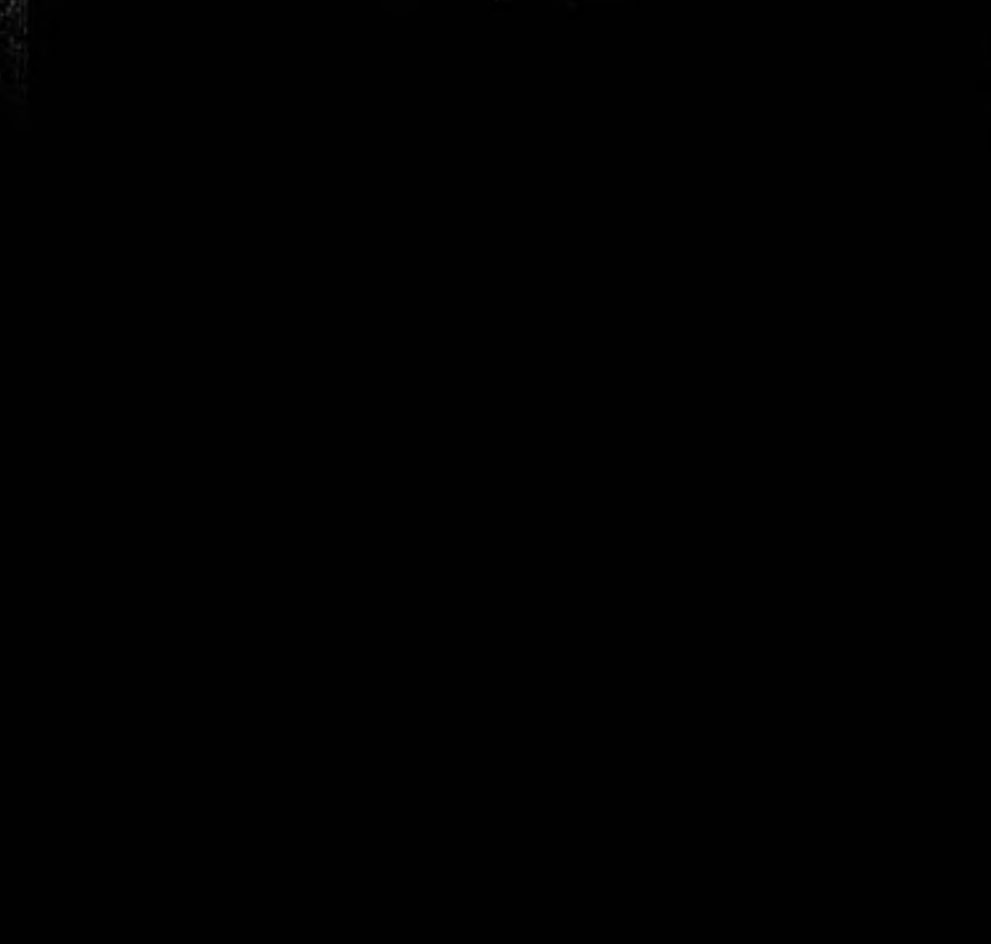
