Twenty-Five Lose Lives In Storm On Atlantic Seaboard

Claimed at least a dozen lives and some millions of dollars property damage.

Borne in on the crest of the highest tide registered on this coast for 50 years, the high wind whirled up mountains of sea and splintered and flooded seaside resorts. In these latter places many houses were smashed or undermined and carried away by the high waters. The New Jersey coast, Staten Island, Long Island were particularly hard hit.

The beaches of these and other places were littered with the debris of wrecked houses and the battered hulls of barges and small ships.

Tight coast guardmen lost their lives near Provincetown, Mass., when their vessel, patrol boat No. 225, was grounded and smashed to pieces by the pounding surf. The party on board held together, but the vessel, which stood by in the hope of saving the crew of the stricken vessel, was wrecked along the shore with the plain sight of the wreck.

Many families living in the vicinity of the beaches were marooned on the upper floors and roofs of their dwellings. Others who were reported to have been rescued after their retreat, found themselves homeless.

The storm claimed five victims in Pittsburgh and one in Philadelphia.

Ranging in depth from four inches to the eastern part of the state to twenty-four inches in the western part, the snow was steady fall, which the weather bureau said would continue throughout the day.

BOSTON, Feb. 21.—(INS)—Twenty dead and thousands of dollars worth of property destroyed was the toll by a northwest reach of snow storm that still whirled along the Atlantic seaboard today.

Eight coast guardmen, fought a losing fight against the raging sea and 70-mile-an-hour gale off Cape Cod, as the 70-foot patrol boat CG-222 went to pieces. Two bodies were washed ashore and search was underway along the sandy shore of the cape today for more bodies.

The shore line was strewn with wreckage of craft, large and small. Coastguard patrol boat CG-221 was high and dry at Vineyard Haven.

The 67-foot schooner Nancy, of Philadelphia, was beside the surf at the railroad station at Nantuxet Beach. Her crew of nine were rescued by a volunteer crew in a dory.
