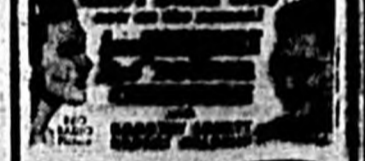

ORLANDO, Feb. 12.—Two high calibre bouts have been announced by promoter Ernie Stephens to complete tomorrow night's big wrestling program, which features the appearance of Jack Dempsey, as referee and the return of Dick Powell to the local mat show. Dory Roche, big 220-pound Illinois farmer, who has been pitted against some of the game's greatest names, heads the troupe of four main-event wrestlers signed to complete the card, which will be presented at the American Legion arena. Roche accepted the opening bout match with Able Coleman, though New York product, as a favor to Stephens for this particular card. The able young Illinois athlete, who wrestled Everett Marshall to draw decision and won a bout of Louis Thesz, one of several outstanding claimants of the world's title. Roche and Coleman meet in a one-fall, 20-minute bout. Pete Manoff and Marvin Jones, well-known as main go performers here, are pitted in the semi-final match. Jones, blond Texan who holds three straight wins over the greasy, bald-pated Nick Bacala, meets the 220-pound Bulgarian in a one-fall, 45-minute burp session. Poppa Dick Powell and Jim Wright top off the program with a three-fall, one-hour battle. Powell, a fast and furious performer with plenty of box-office "oomph," returns to the local grapple pit tomorrow night for the first time since he gave up the ring to umpire in the Florida State League last season. Wright, imported last week from Texas, a 240-pounder who virtually annihilated Pat Conroy in the semi-final event last week, is rated as one of the toughest wrestlers to appear here since the exit of the Golden Terror. Wright, Pacific Coast champion, holds a victory over the Golden Terror. The Powell-Wright set-up promises to be a slam-bang battle and one that Dempsey, the nation's most popular champion, might have to arbitrate with his famous fists.
