Farming Expert Gives Reason For Growers' Plight

GAINESVILLE, Jan. 21.—Speaking on the subject, "Why the Agricultural Depression Has Been So Severe," Dr. H. G. Hamilton, professor of agricultural economics of the University of Florida, said Saturday in a radio address over station WRUF that farmers received for their products prices in proportion to those they paid for commodities purchased, they would have received in 1932 approximately four billion dollars more than what they actually received.
