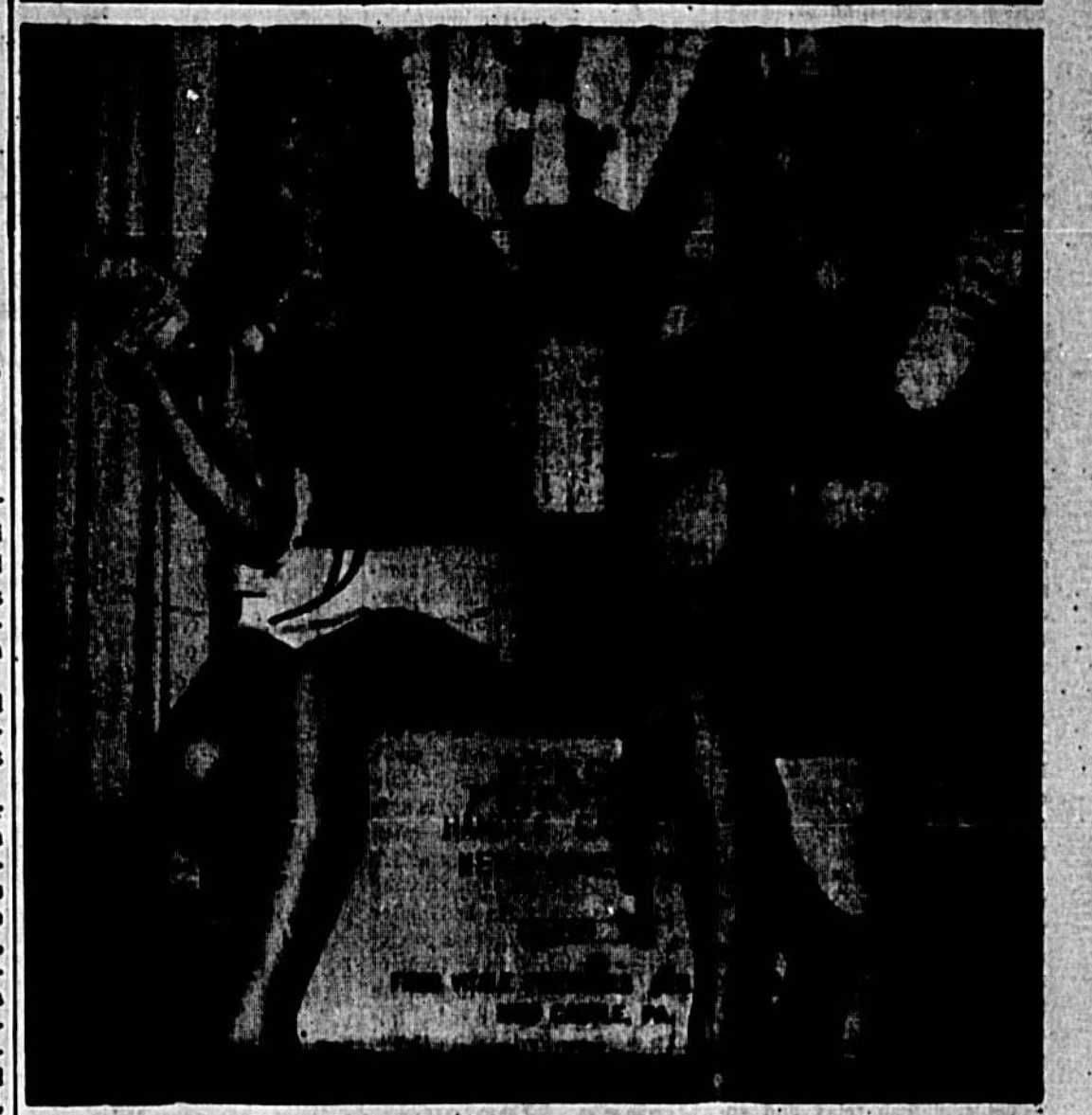

## Jets Hit Red Oil Dump Air Drive Continues In 3rd Day

SAIGON (UPI) — U.S. warplanes returned to North Vietnam's industrial heartland for the third straight day today and blasted a major petroleum dump 15 miles northwest of the key port of Haiphong. U.S. Navy jets hit the Dong Nham oil dump which intelligence officers said contained about eight per cent of the Communist nation's oil storage capacity. Pilots reported "all bombs on target" and streaked away leaving thick black smoke streaming from the oil depot. The raid was a continuation of the systematic destruction of North Vietnam's petroleum and oil supplies. The biggest raid came Wednesday when Air Force and Navy jets knocked out about 60 per cent of the country's oil storage capacity in raids on the fringes of Hanoi and Haiphong. This was followed up with attacks on three smaller facilities north of Hanoi Thursday. U.S. officials disclosed, today that three Air Force jet fighters accidentally dumped their bomb loads on a South Vietnamese village while returning from a combat mission today, killing five civilians and wounding 48 others. The spokesman said the tragic accident occurred as the three F106s were attempting to jettison their unused bomb loads over a designated jettison area about 15 miles north of Bin Hoa air base. The bombs failed to release properly as the pilots pulled out of their runs and the deadly canisters fell on the village of Tu Nham. Trucks and helicopters carrying medical air rushed to the area. In ground action, remnants of a Viet Cong regiment fled through the jungles north of Saigon today toward the Cambodian border leaving the bodies of 320 comrades behind. They were hotly pursued by units of the U.S. 1st Infantry Division which tangled with the Reds in a fierce, close-quarters fight Thursday. Helicopter patrols whirled over the rolling hill country 60 miles north of Saigon in efforts to spot and block the battered force which numbered about 1,200 men before the "Big Red One" troops cut them up. U.S. Marines reported they added 39 to the death toll in air and ground action in the northern provinces around Da

## Altamonte Springs Eyes New Hospital

Altamonte Springs zoning and planning board unanimously adopted a motion at meeting Thursday evening recommending the town council appoint a committee to investigate the feasibility of establishing a hospital under provision of title VI of public law 88-443 in South Seminole County. The board also recommended the county commission, various chambers of commerce, municipalities and communities and civic organizations in the South Seminole area be invited to participate on the project. The need for a hospital in South Seminole was stressed by Mayor W. Lawrence Swoford, who advised that 4,000 to 50,000 people reside within a six-mile radius of Altamonte Springs. It was further reported with neither Seminole Memorial nor Winter Park Memorial participating in the Medicare program, a nearby facility would be needed for retirees wishing to take advantage of Medicare. Swoford stated federal grants and loans are available for up to 80 per cent of the cost of constructing a new equipment medical and health facilities. MEDICARE IS FACT OF LIFE United Press International. Medicare became a fact of life today. Hospital administrators said they were ready for it. The federal health insurance program that could open hospital doors to about 19 million Americans over 65 went into effect at midnight. Critics had predicted darkly it could result in a flood tide of elderly patients seeking admission to the hospitals. But nearly all hospital administrators questioned by United Press International in a spot check across the country thought they were equal to the task. The nearly universal feeling was that somehow, some way the country's hospitals could cope with this as they had with short staffs, lack of facilities and other problems. Basically, Medicare provides up to 80 days of hospital care with the patient paying the first \$40 and, if additional hospital treatment is required, Medicare will cover the costs over \$10 a day for another 30 days. The second part of Medicare, which is optional, costs the patient \$3 a month and provides, after a \$50 initial payment by the patient, the bulk of the money for doctor bills. Civil rights also was an issue, principally in the South. The Department of Health, Education and Welfare said more than 600 hospitals had failed to comply with desegregation requirements in time to qualify for participation in Medicare on opening day. "The hospital will be cleared for participation in Medicare unless the department has convincing evidence that the hospital is in fact in compliance," HEW Secretary John Gardner said, emphasizing that token pledges would not be enough.

## U. S. Aide To Study Base's Future

A Department of Defense engineer considered to be the foremost consultant in the United States will be coming to Sanford this month to do a complete analysis of civilian utilization of the Sanford Naval Air Station. It was announced at a meeting of representatives of the school board, the county commission and the county board of realtors with Sen. Mack Cleveland, chairman of the Chamber of Commerce armed services committee Thursday afternoon. The consultant will prepare a report which will be submitted to the Defense Department and finally will be made available to the committee. Senator Cleveland reported the committee had been in contact with an appraiser who is the General Services Administration approved list to discuss satisfactory fee arrangements for his services. The appraiser would determine the cost of acquiring the base property and how to finance the purchase, if deemed feasible. Use of part of the facility for an airport was discussed and John Krider advised 33 packages containing pictures and statistics on the area had been sent to air space companies with eight interesting replies received. However, no commitments have been received. ## LBJ Alone Decides On Targets

WASHINGTON (UPI) — President Johnson personally approved all targets for air attack in Communist North Vietnam, Air Force Chief of Staff Gen. John P. McConnell disclosed in testimony made public today. General McConnell gave the testimony in early May, well before this week's oil depot raids near Hanoi and Haiphong. But he said the final decision on North Vietnamese targets for a month in advance "has to be made by the President." The President's role in target selection, of particular interest now, was a highlight of testimony which centered on what McConnell called a "severely strained" situation in the Tactical Air Command because of operations in Vietnam. Heavily censored testimony by Gen. Gabriel Disway, TAC commander, on shortages of planes, parts, and particularly personnel impressed Sen. Everett Sallstonall (R-Mass.) as "very disturbing." The "general said that Vietnam needs were being met, however, and that there was no plan to call up National Guard units unless there is another "convergence." Chairman John C. Stennis (D-Miss.), of the preparedness subcommittee, and Sen. Strom Thurmond (R-S.C.), questioned McConnell at some length about target selection in North Vietnam. The general said targets selected by the Joint Chief of Staff, after coordination by the commander in the Pacific, were sent to Defense Secretary Robert S. McNamara and then to Johnson. In a partly deleted question, Stennis asked McConnell why permission had-up to then—been withheld for attack on a (censored) target in North Vietnam. "I do not know, sir. We submit them and the President either approves or disapproves them. He takes the advice of, I suppose, the State Department and other cabinet people in coming to his conclusions," McConnell said.

## Rains Soak Florida; 4.29 Inches in City

Tropical rains continued to soak Florida today, while generally clear skies were reported over most of the nation. The Sanford area was soggy today after 4.29 inches rain fell between 8:30 p. m. Thursday and 9:30 p. m. Thursday. The area was under torando warning this morning. A weak tropical depression hovered just west of Tampa today and dumped heavy rain across Central and North Florida. More than two inches fell in one 35-minute period at Jacksonville. The Weather Bureau warned that up to six inches of rain could be expected in some areas of North Florida and South Georgia today and the threat of a torado or two existed from Central Florida north into southeast Georgia. A small torado was reported at Vero Beach Thursday but did no damage. The center of the weak depression, which sent winds gusting to 40 miles per hour tonight east and northeast, was located just west of Tampa at latitude 27.7 north and longitude 83.0 west. Forecasters said there had been little movement since midnight. "The depression is forecast to remain weak and to drift northward at five to 10 mph today and tonight," the Weather Bureau said. Rainfall for the tourist mecca of Miami was about 21 and a half inches, a full inch more than the old record of 20.56 set there in June of 1959. Much of it came Thursday when rainfall passed the three-inch mark at Miami International Airport.

## Herald Tax Expert Is Honored

WASHINGTON (AP) — Ray De Crase, income tax expert for The Sanford Herald and Newspaper Enterprise Association, has been presented the Meritorious Public Service Award of the Internal Revenue Service—IRS's highest recognition.

"As an editor and writer with creativity and insight, your articles on the many aspects of taxes have contributed substantially to more effective tax administration by raising the level of public understanding," IRS Commissioner Sheldon S. Cohen said as he made the presentation.

De Crase was honored for his series and book, "Cut Your Own Taxes," a guide to better understanding of the Federal Income Tax Laws published by NEA and made available as a public service to readers of The Sanford Herald.

"Your communication of tax information to millions of American taxpayers in a form they can comprehend, in an admittedly complex area, is in the highest tradition of this country's free press," Cohen told De Crase.

The youthful looking 38-year-old Cohen in his year and a half as commissioner has constantly stressed IRS's duty to assist and inform taxpayers.

Cohen is the first to agree IRS cannot do this job alone: "Efficient operation of our tax system, based on voluntary compliance, depends very heavily on a public sufficiently informed of its rights, its responsibilities and the details of how it can comply."

"This is why the newspapers are so vitally important to the American citizen in his exercise of his rights and recognition of his duties. They carry the truth in detail to America."

De Crase, an assistant city editor of the Cleveland Press, has been specializing in tax advice for 26 years. Both Cohen and De Crase find it amazing that Americans overpaid their taxes in 1965 by nearly \$260 million. These errors occurred because people failed to read the instructions, misinterpreted the law, or "hadn't had the new math or the old math, either" as Cohen puts it.

These mistakes are not a one-way street, by any means. In 1965, IRS also discovered about \$2.7 billion in additional taxes due from the government from taxpayers who misinterpreted the law.

De Crase already is at work on a completely new revision of his booklet which will be made available to readers of The Herald early next year—in time to help them "Cut Their Own Taxes" by not overpaying.

## Lynda Bird Irks Spanish Press

MADRID (UPI) — The Spanish press today criticized Lynda Bird Johnson for "behaving like a movie star rather than the daughter of a President" during her vacation in Spain.

Impatient U. S. Embassy aides, police escorts and reporters meanwhile waited for Miss Johnson to make up her mind on the remainder of her holiday itinerary.

The unapproachable eldest daughter of President Johnson was back in Madrid today after a two-day marathon tour of northern Spain. She apparently planned to improve the rest of her vacation in Spain.

"We do not have any idea of what she is going to do next," a U. S. Embassy spokesman said.

After eight days in Spain, Lynda has smiled, scowled and stuck out her tongue in alternating displays of amoyance at photographers.

A report in the Spanish newspaper Pueblo said, "Lynda Johnson continues to comport herself like a movie star rather than the daughter of a President."
