Roosevelt Refuses Resignation Of His Treasury Secretary

WASHINGTON, Nov. 15.—(A.P.)—President Roosevelt today announced that Secretary Woodin would begin a "complete leave of absence" at the end of the week and that pending his return Henry Morgenthau, Jr. would be acting secretary of the treasury.

Under Secretary Dean Acheson has resigned and Morgenthau will be appointed to that post. Woodin tendered his resignation to the President several days ago but Mr. Roosevelt declined to accept it, suggesting instead that the Secretary be completely freed from all governmental responsibilities while he takes a complete rest.
