

## Fighting Planes Of U.S. Army Are Active In Europe

### Start Large Scale Movement, Engaging In 31 Sorties In Last 48 Hours

(By Associated Press) United States Army fighting planes have entered the European fray in a large scale for the first time, engaging in 31 operational sorties in the past 48 hours, U. S. European headquarters announced today. Fighter squadrons flying with the RAF made three such flights over the French coast, 20 were missions over the sea and eight were interception sorties off the English coast.

American fighter pilots also have arrived in the Egyptian theater and are ready to pitch into Marshal Rommel's desert forces along with United States tanks and bombers. It was revealed last night.

The U. S. Army Air Force regular and reserve officers recalled from civil pursuits got a more than cordial welcome. A Royal Air Force squadron leader observed after watching them try out their Kittyhawks.

"These boys certainly can fly. They did things with their Kittyhawks which I never knew could be done."

The fighter pilots reached Egypt two months after U. S. Army bombers went into action over the desert and the Mediterranean. American tank units moved up to forward positions late in July after a three month training period behind the lines and were described as waiting impatiently for a "whack at the Germans."

## Red Army Holds At Approaches To Stalingrad

### Germans Punch Hole In Position Near Important Railway

MOSCOW, Aug. 13. (AP)—German troops have punched another hole in Russian positions astride the Rostov-Baku railroad in the Cherkassk area, but the Red Army is holding firmly on the approaches to Stalingrad, the Soviets announced today.

"In the area of Cherkassk our troops have returned to new positions," the statement said.

Cherkassk is 70 miles south of Aermavir and about 200 miles from the rich Grzny oil fields. The Germans thus are pushing their hard drive southward along the northern flank of the Caucasian mountains.

The Red Army was still fighting the heavy defensive battle in the Markop oil fields west of Cherkassk and also at Krasnodar, the Kulan River 60 miles west of Markop.

Nearly 2,000 Germans were reported killed and 22 tanks destroyed during the last 24 hours in Nazi efforts to bridge a gap in the line.

Far to the north on the Lip Don the Russians said their fighting on the west bank of the river in the Voronezh sector killed another 500 Germans in two days.

The plan of the whole German campaign in the Caucasus is to march down the railroad to the west to southeast. This is the communications lifeline of all the land lying north of the Caucasian range.

The fiercest of the battle is raging in the west Caucasian area, where the German army is attacking a city 60 miles from the Black Sea naval station of Novorossiysk and Mankop, chief of the first oil region to be invested by the invader.

Powerful German forces were throwing in waves of reinforcements in an attempt to cross a waterway near Krasnodar, but all have been repulsed. The Germans have lost 12 tanks and more than 1,000 men.

### 8 Percent Sales Tax Proposed By Manufacturers

### Compulsory Savings Plan For Individuals Is Suggested


WASHINGTON, Aug. 13. (AP)—The National Association of Manufacturers today proposed an 8 percent sales tax to supplement heavy corporate and individual income taxes for war purposes. The NAM program called for \$17,200,000,000 revenue in 1943 and also suggested compulsory individual savings.

Meanwhile, yesterday, a five year plan of war financing, including the current fiscal year, was laid before Congress by representatives of the United States Chamber of Commerce.

Strongly endorsing a proposal for a "slight savings" method of collecting individual income taxes, Ellsworth C. Alvord, chairman of the chamber's finance committee, said the "offensive of the fiscal front" is being drastically reduced.

Alvord told the Senate committee that to plan five years ahead for war and post-war financing by arranging to siphon off the amount of revenues through taxation and to channel the surplus into the financing of current income and savings rather than operating through commercial banks.

Alvord proposed that individuals and corporations be permitted to deduct up to 20 percent of their taxable income for purchase of government bearing government bonds.

### Strongly Reinforced U.S. Troops Break Japanese Hold On Harbor At Tulagi

(By Associated Press) American "Devil Dog" Marines appeared to have won the first round of the seven-day-old battle for the Solomons Islands today, beating off furious Japanese counter-thrusts on "Devil Dog" Division beachheads on the 900-mile-long island chain.

An Australian broadcast said that the Japanese had been driven from the harbor at Tulagi in the southwest Pacific. In Japan, the American supply lines to the American forces in the Southwest Pacific were said to be in a "completely unthreatened" position.

## Pepper Urges Gas Tanks On Wooden Barges

WASHINGTON, Aug. 13. (AP)—Only governmental approval is needed to get a program under way for utilizing unused gasoline storage tanks on wooden barges, Senator Pepper said Wednesday.

Under the proposed plan, the idle tanks would be used aboard the barges to transport gasoline from Florida and the Gulf to the eastern seaboard to help ease the shortage caused by tank sinkings.

"There is available more than a hundred of these unused storage tanks in Georgia and Florida," said the senator in a statement, "and I am sure many hundreds more can be found in different parts of the country."

Richard E. Philpott and A. H. Brooks, of Jacksonville, are working with Pepper on the idea.

"We have contacted one of the largest lumber companies in Florida and find that they have available a reserve stock of long-leaf yellow pine lumber to cut and they can supply a large part of the needed lumber for the operations," Pepper said.

Philpott and Brooks are ready to start construction of the barges immediately, the senator said.

Army engineers, he explained, have estimated that 20 of the idle storage tanks could be cut into a single wooden barge, thus making possible the transportation of about 7,000 barrels of oil per barge.






## Javery Pitches Shut-Out In First While Fernandez Gets 4 Blows In Nightcap

BOSTON, Aug. 13. (AP)—The Boston Braves snapped a five-game winning streak for the New York Giants yesterday, shutting them out, 1-0, in the opener of a doubleheader and then burying them, 8-2, under an 18-hit attack in the nightcap.

Nanny Fernandez led the assault against four giant pitchers in the second game with four hits in five times at bat. Bob Carpenter started on the mound for the Giants but gave up two doubles and a single before being replaced by Harry Friedman with nobody out.

The Braves continued the bombardment against Friedman and his successors, Art Adams and Bill Lohman, getting at least one hit in every inning and bunching four of them in the fifth when they scored three times.

During that uprising, the Giants claimed Max West interfered with second baseman Mickey Welch when the latter started after a short fly that moved west to second. The umpires overruled the visitors and the game was finished under protest.

The Giants collected nine hits off Lou Test and Johnny Sain. Test worked eight innings and registered his tenth win.

Al Javery pitched seven-hit ball in the first game.
