

Lebanon Cease-Fire Replaced By Fighting

BEIRUT, Lebanon (AP) - The latest cease-fire in the Lebanese civil war appeared all but dead Saturday as fighting flared in scattered locations in Beirut and nearby

"The cease-fire is, for all practical purposes, nonexistent. It amounts to no more than a piece of paper," a security officer said.

Security officials and hospitals Saturday reported the highest casualty figures in eight days - 245 killed and 406
