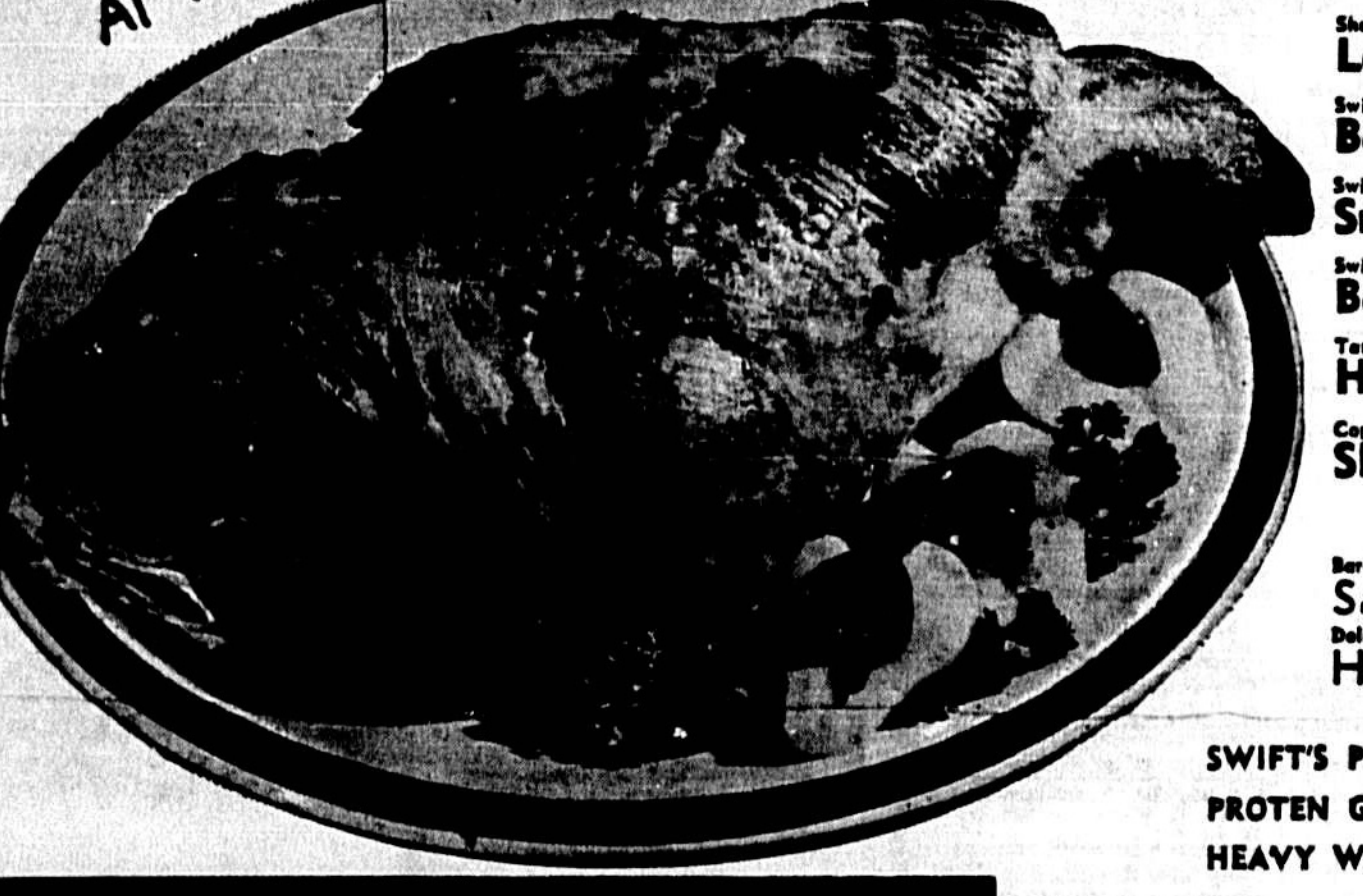

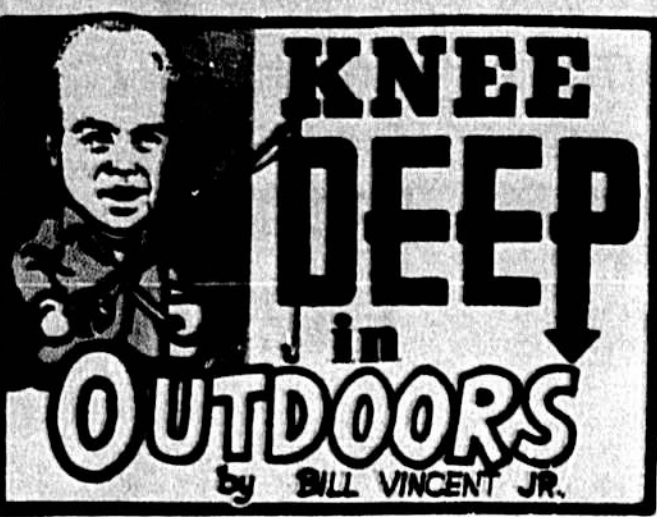

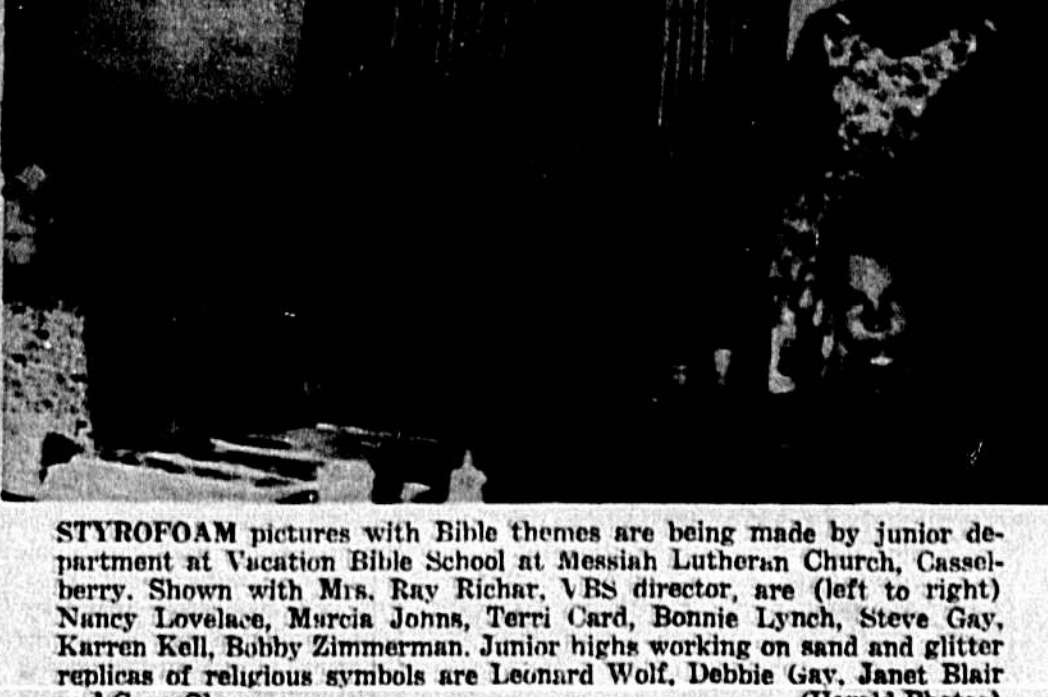

FOUR WALTON BEACH PL. (AP) - An investigation of a mystery surrounding a "mini-mine" being developed by the military went into little bits of smoke Sunday. Thousands of the tiny explosive devices drifted onto a public beach in North Florida. Several hundred servicemen were entered into the area to gather up the bomblets among some 120 miles of beach. A canister loaded with the brownish disks was reported by a passerby to have been dropped accidentally into a hole in the Florida Panhandle. The disks are a size of a quarter with knobs protruding from each side. When exploded or stepped on they squoze with the force of a large firecracker. The secret device, being developed for use in Vietnam as a means of warning, is known as a "mini-mine" because it resembles a small mine.

IN AN official release the Air Force said the objects had been dropped under "emergency conditions," but would not elaborate.
