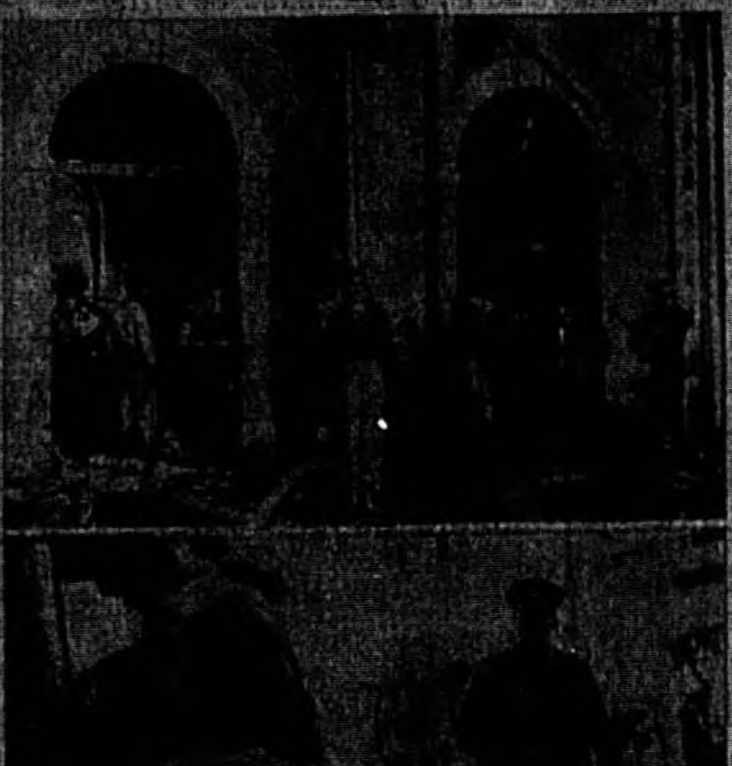

Leader Hints British Plan Would Aid US Parliamentary System

LONDON, Nov. 7 (AP)—Although he made no specific mention of the general election in the United States held last Tuesday, Herbert Morrison, British leader in the House of Commons, recommended today the British parliamentary system as a means of protecting the national will against "extremists within the government."

Morrison, was apparently referring to a possible deadlock between the legislative and executive branches of the United States government. The British constitution, said Morrison, depends upon trust in the majority. It contains safeguards against a deadlock, as pointed out, and it always works on the basis of the confidence of the House of Commons. In England, a prime minister who cannot get a vote of confidence must resign and let the majority party elect a new leader. "This simple, straightforward system," said Morrison, "makes it unnecessary to base government on elaborate and shifting compromises between parties or warring allies outside the nature of government."

Robson Says Talk Of More Clothing Pure Propaganda

J. N. Robson, Jr., who returned yesterday from a buying trip to New York, Philadelphia and Baltimore to secure display fixtures for the new E. L. Perkins store, reported that he was successful in securing the fixtures, but declared that talk of cheaper or more plentiful clothing was pure propaganda.

Marshal Also Reported Willing To Re-Open Whole Query

ROME, Nov. 7 (AP)—The Communist foreign vice minister of Italy, Palmiro Togliatti, said today in an interview published in the Communist newspaper "Unita" that Marshal Tito of Yugoslavia is ready to reopen the whole question of disputed Venetian islands. Togliatti declared this is prepared also to see the strategic Adriatic port city of Trieste returned to Italian sovereignty, but under two conditions. The conditions are that Trieste receive an autonomous status under the aegis of the United Nations and that Germany be given to Yugoslavia.

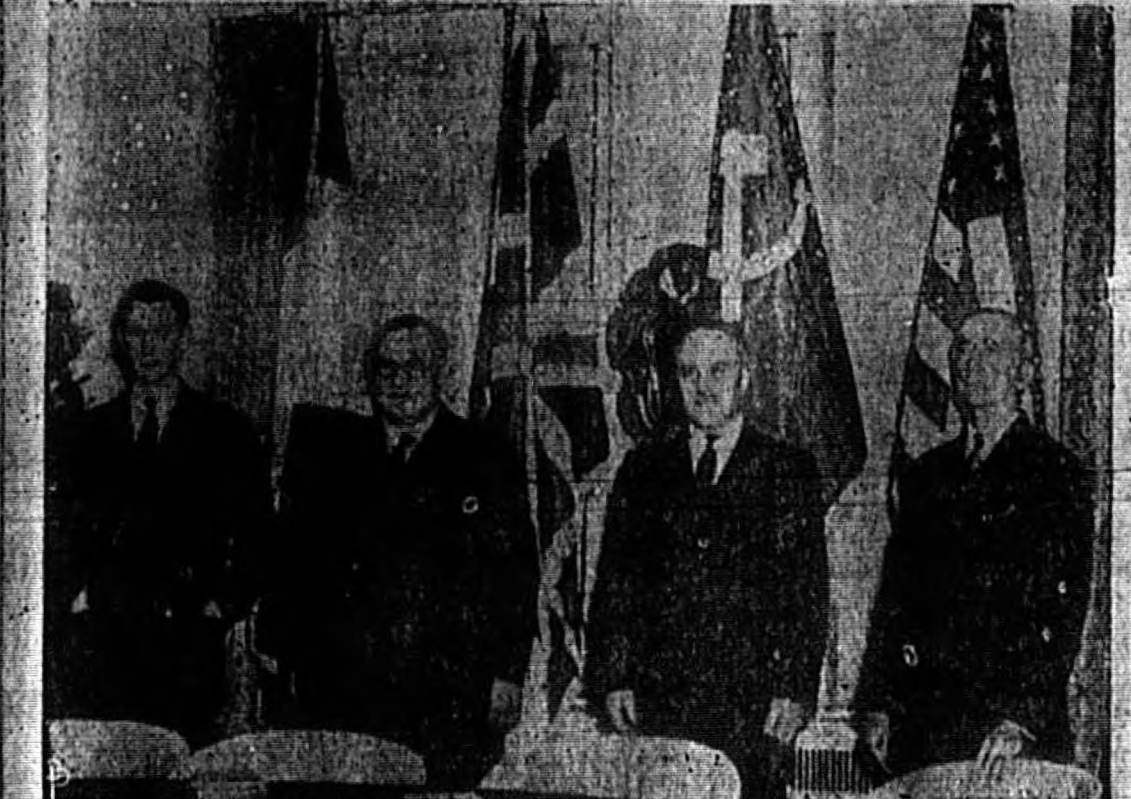
