Sanford Shopping Center On 9 Acres?

The Sanford City Commission has taken the first step toward a shopping center on nine acres at Hardy Avenue and West 25th Street near Country Club Manor.

The commission has unanimously voted to instruct City Attorney C. Vernon Man to draw up an ordinance rezoning the property from residential to general commercial development.

Under the proposed ordinance, a section of the property directly across from single-family homes on Hardy Avenue will remain in present R-1 zoning. And, if the shopping center is developed, the property will most likely be used as a parking area, according to city officials.

Philip J. News of Orlando, owner of the property, presented a "schematic diagram" to the city's planning and zoning commission. It depicted a single, crescent-shaped building at the center of the property, according to Bill Braceland, Sanford building official.

The rezoning issue faces two public hearings before the city commission prior to final approval. The city commission also has approved a lease with one license for The Heritage Inn, 300 S. Park Ave. Commissioners told owner Melvin Serio he could begin sales at once as he receives a state liquor license.

The commission also unanimously approved a motion to have the city attorney draw up an ordinance closing an alley at the Wetula Building at North Oak Avenue between

Did Bell Cover Up Probe Of FBI Illegal Works?

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Attorney General Bill Barr today said he is covering up the Carter administration took office 15 months ago.

With his February firing of U.S. Attorney David Marshall still rattling some Senate Republicans, there are now accusing Barr of a cover-up in the investigation of the FBI's alleged past illegal surveillance.

The new controversy was triggered by charges of William Gardner, once head of the investigation, that Bell blocked the prosecution of eight high-level FBI officials on charges of illegal wiretapping and "black bag jobs."

Sen. Lowell Weicker, R-Conn., said Thursday the testimony of Gardner and two assistants before a Senate appropriations subcommittee "rightfully calls into question the suitability of Griffin Bell to continue as attorney general."

Lance Has White House Pass

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Bert Lance's recent record of troubles with federal agencies and courts concerning his financial affairs have not interfered with his easy access to President Carter.

"I know of no particular change" in that close relationship between Carter and Lance, says Rex Graman, deputy White House press secretary.

Graman says Lance still holds a White House staff pass and that he knows of no plans to ask the former budget director to turn it in.

DEAR READER: I know how frightening it is to learn that a loved one has a serious and perhaps fatal disease. But there are things you can do to help your husband live a longer and useful life.

He has fatty-cholesterol deposits in his arteries and there is some evidence that the process can be slowed, stopped or even reversed. The two most important things to do are to not smoke and to get really thin.

Get your husband down to the point that there is no more fat around the waist of his back than you ordinarily find under the skin over the back of the hand. That means no significant fat deposits around the waist anywhere. Anything less than that means you have not done all you can do.

His diet should be low in fat (that helps control the calorie intake too) and low in cholesterol. I am sending you

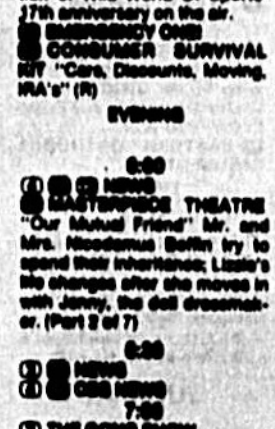

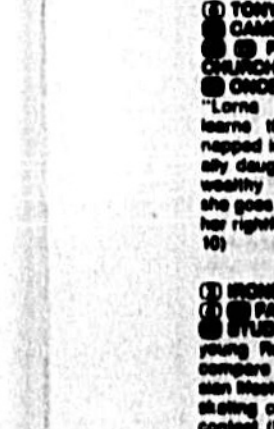

**Boy Crusader Nabbed
 Doing A 'Good Deed'**

Spider-Man, that modern day crusader and feared foe of the dastardly wrongdoer has competition. Right here in Seminole County.

But the tale of the antics perpetrated by his competitive go-guider which led to his arrest by Sheriff's deputies may be sadder than it is funny.

The intrigue began during the early-morning hours Saturday... at 4 a.m. to be exact.

For Seminole Sheriff's deputy Rudy Kramer, everything was going smoothly as he patrolled area businesses at the Butler Plaza shopping center off State Road 408 near the county line. But then deputy Kramer spotted something unusual. As he drove past the buildings in the plaza, still hidden by the dark, he thought he spotted a figure lurking in the shadows... about seven feet from the ground, descending steadily along the side of the building... inch by inch down an antenna to a ledge.

His investigative curiosity fully aroused, deputy Kramer swung his car around and drove it to a halt near the building... the rear of the Radio Shack.

Still unable to make out the eerie-looking figure, deputy Kramer approached the building, carefully.

The figure leaped to the ground. Deputy Kramer pursued. "Stop," cried deputy Kramer.

The order was obeyed.

What officer Kramer found was a 14-year-old South Seminole County boy attired in dark clothing and a motorcycle helmet, as well as a dark mask that covered all of his face except his eyes, nose and mouth.

"The helmet had pointed stripes. It looked like a spider," deputy Kramer related.

The boy was not uncooperative, Kramer said, as the deputy proceeded to look thoroughly into the matter.

"The deputy wondered: What had this boy been doing on the roof of the Radio Shack building?"

There on the ground was the answer. Part of an antenna and... a note.

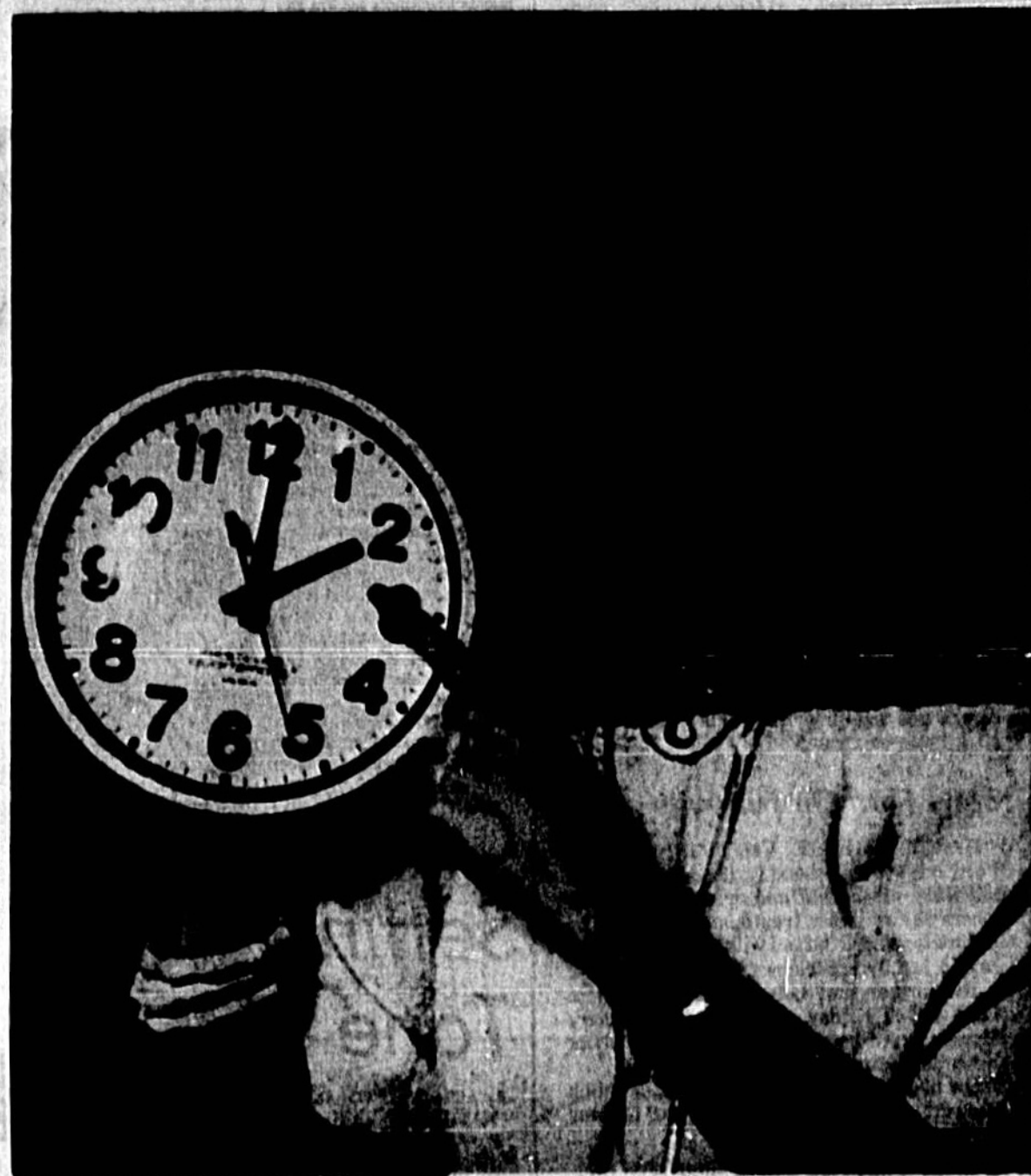
"He had removed an eight-foot, two-way radio antenna and thrown it to the ground," explained Kramer.

The investigator said the boy apparently wanted to perform a good deed because the antenna was broken.

The note? It read in part: "Dear Radio Shack, 'I look down this antenna because it was broken... I'll be back. Be sure to tell the newsmen of this unusual event... signed, 'The Tarantula' (mispronounced)."

The boy was taken to the Division of Youth Services detention center in Seminole County and his mother was called in. The boy has been charged with trespassing, vandalism and proving. He was released to his mother and is scheduled for a court appearance.

Why did the boy do it? One Seminole County investigator said the boy's mother may have provided the answer: "She said the boy has an active imagination. They're always trying to create something... always trying to do something good for somebody. He likes to do good. But his friends at school, they just laugh at him and call him names. County Committed To 'Cost-Saving' Computer System

Seminole County has committed itself to developing a computer system to handle financial and management reports and accounting.

In its initial year of operation, 1979-80, the system will cost the county \$14,000, according to Jeff Eickberger, director of the Office of Management Analysis and Division (OMAD). The system's start-up cost of \$10,000 will be offset by a projected cost saving of \$4,000, noted Eickberger. That cost savings will come from the elimination of jobs and equipment currently used to process financial and management information, he said.

"The benefits we derive in terms of cost and management analysis flexibility is well worth the \$14,000," said Eickberger. By fiscal 1980 (Oct. 1, 1981) the system will have saved the county enough money to result in a cost savings, according to Eickberger.

Once the computer is totally operational, about 18 months from now, Eickberger said the county will be able to cut 100 full-time positions. Two of them, a financial officer in the clerk's office, and an employee in the personnel department, are being eliminated by the county. The other 178 are Computer Operations and Training Job (COTAs) needed to maintain the system and environmental services departments.

"Over the long-term we are looking at what the computer can do for us in terms of cost savings," said Eickberger. "That means money the county can save in the future."

"We're looking at few positions minimum we would avoid adding in the next five years," commented Eickberger.

Based on 1978 dollar values, that would mean the computer would also eliminate the possibility of having more equipment currently used to keep track of payroll.

Some commissioners have criticized the computer proposal as a waste of time and money, the very things the system is designed to save.

"I have never seen the county add anything that cost jobs," commented Commissioner John Alexander, in opposing the computer system.

Commissioner Bill Kretschell agreed with Alexander saying, "I don't think it will do anything people aren't already doing."

Commissioner Dick Williams said Eickberger was right. Kretschell voted to implement the computer program this week. That vote not only approved the program, it also approved the position of data processing manager to supervise the system. That is an \$8,000 a year position. Later a systems analyst and a computer operator will be added at annual salaries of \$9,000 and \$10,000, respectively.
