Jackson Testifies Regarding Evidence On Katyn Massacre

Justice Declares He Didn't Receive Any Documents Blaming Russia For Crime

WASHINGTON (AP) — Supreme Court Justice Robert H. Jackson told congressional investigators today as chief prosecutor at the Nuremberg trials he never received American documents blaming Russia for the Katyn Forest massacre. Jackson testified before a special House committee trying to decide whether American officials, in an effort to avoid disrupting wartime relations with Moscow, suppressed information that Russians were responsible for Katyn. Jackson said despite a lack of evidence he was reluctant to agree to a Soviet demand that the Nuremberg War Crimes Court charge Germans with the slaughter of 15,000 Polish officers and intellectuals at Katyn Forest in Western Russia.

Chinese Drive Koreans From Sniper Ridge

SEOUL (AP) — A smashing Chinese infantry and artillery attack drove South Korean defenders from the main Allied command position on Sniper Ridge tonight. It was the 13th time United Nations forces have been driven off Sniper Hill since the battle for the Sniper ridge began Oct. 14. The South Koreans fell back at 9 p. m. after a five-hour battle with 1,500 Chinese. It began with one of the heaviest Communist artillery barrages of the war. An American military adviser called it the heaviest artillery concentration he had ever seen.
