

Sinister Reports Of Unrest Continue To Spread In Near East

Observers See Disorders As Merely One Phase Of General Revolt Of Moslems

JERUSALEM, Sept. 3.—(INS)—With the tumultuous news of the Arab uprising in Palestine, sinister reports of unrest continued to be heard throughout the Near East today.

Following the Arab attack upon the Greek orthodox settlement in the Jewish territory, according to the Jewish telegraph, rumors in 20 Christian districts, returned to new uprisings in which separated sections of the country flamed in Jerusalem.

With each recurring report, observers in the Holy City became more certain that the present disorders in Palestine are merely one phase of a general revolt of Moslems throughout the Near East. 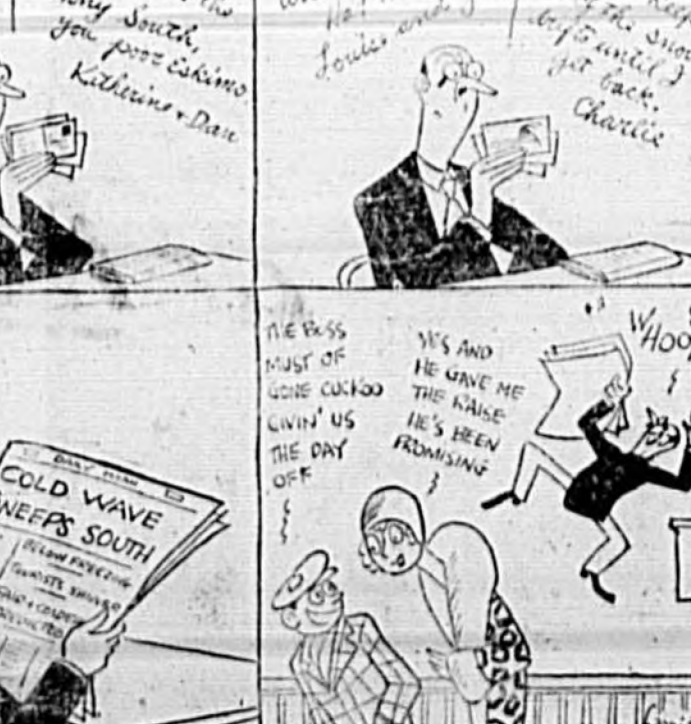
