The Opium Stockpile

By JACK ANDERSON

WASHINGTON — The federal government, believe it or not, is America's biggest opium trafficker. The authorities are quietly planning to unload hundreds of tons of the addictive drug from the secret hiding places beside the gold at Fort Knox and elsewhere.

Actually, the government opium peddling is all on the up and up. Besides being the source of the killer drug heroin, opium is also refined into the useful pain-killers morphine and codeine. The United States began building an opium stockpile after World War II.

At the beginning of this year, there were 634 tons of opium in the stockpile, mostly refined into opium gum, morphine sulphate and codeine. Simulataneously a bad opium crop in India created a codeine and morphine shor-

Thus, the United States decided a good deal of the federal opium stash could be sold off for medical purposes and Congress is now considering approval of the sale to private Meanwhile according to classified information from the

Justice Department, the opium is under 24-hour guard at Fort Knox (its derivatives are worth more than gold), at West Point (well sway from any curious cadets) and at a naval supp., depot in New Jersey, among other sites. Bebe's Bridge: Charles G. (Bebe) Rebozo, President Nixon's best friend, is planning to develop an island near Key Biscayne that has long been a point of controversy

The teardrop-shaped island, called Fisher's, is located between the southern tip of Miami Beach and Virgina Key, an adjunct to Key Biscayne. For years, Rebozo and other Fisher's Island, Inc., stockholders have sought construction of a causeway to provide access to their property. Each attempt has been blocked by angry citizens. We have now learned, however, that Rebozo and his

fellow investors have commissioned an architectural firm to draw up plans for an urban community on Fisher's. Under the directions given Simonds and Simonds, Pittsburgh architects who specialize in environmental design, the island will have no circulating vehicles other than buses

and golf carts. John Simonds of the firm admitted to us that, at Rebozo's orders, the planning is well under way and a preliminary rendering will be completed by the end of the year. The few people who work on the island were surprised

when we asked them about development of the sandpit, which is largely covered with pine. Since local authorities have been reluctant to build the causeway to the island, the success of the venture thus may depend on whether the Nixon administration lends the Rebozo group a federal helping hand with the causeway construction. "I don't know where the hell they got their information," MacArthur said.

William Howard, Eastern senior vice president, said all departments in the company would be reduced but that most of the employes were cut from management and secretarial ranks.


Eastern announced the firings as part of an economy drive aimed at improving the company's troubled financial position and saving \$35 million by next year.

Take yourself back in time for a moment dear reader, back to the time of the free wheeling, super independent entrepreneur—the man who made America the country that it is today-the first controller of big business.

Unions were against the law—they were too radical for that day and age-probably under the influence of "socialistic" literature that demanded child labor laws. reduced working hours for women-a 60 repeat 60 hour working week and other luxuries like safe factories and enough wages to obtain sanitary living conditions.

The average joe back then had it rough. If you don't think so I will gladly call your attention to several points of reference that will clearly illustrate the point. You know, it probably is a good thing that the average joe doesn't like to read history-he might get mad about it all:

Back to that free wheeling, devil may care, rags-toriches entrepreneur. He was most appropriately called a "robber baron" at the time-wonder why?

Well, hate to smash any pleasant myths, but this fella lived in luxurious surroundings while thousands of his. workers lived in something quite the opposite. He many times used those workers to compete against each other so the lowest bidder would get the job-meaning that the bidder who wasn't lowest wound up in the street. But then that was his place in life because "anybody who wanted to could make it," or something like that. I don't know where the handle "gay 90's" came from, but one thing for sure-they weren't talking about the people who worked in the factories.

The robber barons would still be with us if it hadn't been for a few heads getting busted and several people being "radical" enough to demand some decent human typ working conditions. If the government hadn't passed a few safety laws and child labor laws—a few meat inspection laws and stuff like that. Fortunately, for most of us, these things came to pass and we of today were born into very nice material surroundings-the robber barons seem far, far

There are still some of them around. They are pretty well held in check however, because this is the twentieth century and most people can read and write-at least they can turn on the tube once in a while and check out what is going on. One guy in the sports realm that makes people think of the oldtime robber baron today is a man who has been on the

tube and in the papers quite a bit of late. Charley Finley has been a very, very successful man in anybody's league. He has done a lot for baseball. He has brought changes to the game that would maybe not have come until years later-but his labor relations smell of cobwebs and bring back unhappy days for those who work for

man by the name of Mike Andrews made two mistakes in a baseball game-it wasn't even the seventh game-his club still won the world championship-but Mike Andrews was shamed and sent home because the boss was not pleased with his performance. Cooler heads, namely Bowie Kuhn, prevailed and An-

If you remember the most recent world series a young

drews was reinstated for the moment. I say for the moment because since the series ended Finley has strongly defended his action saying he had a right to do it 'cause he was the

He also feels, obviously, that since he released Dick Williams on National TV, he has the right to change his mind. He can tell several million people that Williams is going, but when it comes down to the nitty gritty of letting him talk to another team-no way-"I want more money."

This is the type of man who will let someone the caliber of Reggie Jackson pop off whenever he wishes. Mainly because Reggie Jackson is the stick that makes the Oakland

This is the same man that leaves Vida Blue out in the cold after a 24-8 rookie year because he had the audacity to ask for some of the money that hundreds of thousands of fans paid to see him pitch.

This is the same man who held Blue back, some think purposely, in the bullpen and never let him get in shape for the following season so he wound up 6-10 after that 24 game

The next year Father Finley let Blue get some starts and won 20 ball games. Thank you Mr. Finley. Finley, in my humble opinion, is a black mark on major league baseball today. He has done some good, but he treats his players as if they were nothing but commodities.

Yes, Virginia, baseball is a business. Players do get a lot more money than those folks in the sweat shops in days gone by. But then again-most athletes only last ten years if they are good, twenty if they are one in a million. For them to demand higher wages, to insure a healthy future, which they insured for the owners by drawing fans is definitely not absurd. An injury in the next season could ruin that money making potential.

Finley wants to keep them all in their "place." Imagine the gall of Henry Aaron asking for \$200,000 for one year. Also magine no Henry Aaron and all those empty seats when the fans don't come to see the management play whiffle ball. Finley will hopefully wise up-it doesn't look like any time soon however-This fan hopes the 1973 robber baron will have to eat some crow sometime soon. At any rate the baseball commissioner will imped his attempts to play lord and master over those who bring him the fans.

We all know baseball is a business. It is very obvious to any observer. But do we really have to be reminded of how labor relations were in the allegedly good ole days? If Charley Finley had his way we would. You could just read the sports pages instead of the history books to see how it was. Fortunately there are other people on the lookout for dollar hungry operators like Charley O. And baseball is better for them-and so, especially, are the players and their

The stocky Weaver was a landslide winner in balloting conducted by The Associated Press before the playoffs and World Series. He earned 170 votes from sports writers and broadcasters in outpolling Jack McKeon of the Kansas City Royals, runnerup with 91 nominations.

Dick Williams, who left Oakland after directing the A's to the American League and World Series championships, finished third with 41 votes. Del Crandall of the Milwaukee Brewers was fourth with 12 votes.

Then came Frank Quilici of the Minnesota Twins, Ralph Houk of the Yankees, Bobby Winkles of the California Angels, Chuck Tanner of the Chicago White Sox, and Billy Martin, who piloted both Detroit and Texas, with one vote each. Tanner was last year's winner.

This is the first Manager of the Year honor for Weaver, although he directed the Orioles to three straight pennants and over 100 victories each year beginning in 1969. After that string, Baltimore slipped to third in the AL East in 1972, but bounced back for its fourth East title in five years field until putting together a 14-game winning streak in late

Their 97-65 record gave Weaver a remarkable 543-337 mark for a .617 percentage since he replaced Hank Bauer as

manager July 11, 1968. The 43-year-old Weaver is convinced the future might be just as good, "I said earlier this year that our farm system has produced enough outstanding players for this team to win six division championships in the next 10 years," he said. 'I see no reason to change my mind now.'

The Orioles' resurgence this year was led by rookie speedsters Al Bumbry and Rich Coggins, both of whom hit over 300 and paced the club in stolen bases. Over-all, the team had a record eight players who stole 10 or more bases. "Earl did an outstanding job this year after a somewhat

disappointing start," said General Manager Frank Cashen after recently rehiring Weaver for the 1974 season at an estimated salary of \$70,000.

"He put together a whole new blend of players and reshaped the club to fit the new talent so quickly," added Cashen. "Half of the players from our championship team of two years ago were gone and we didn't have the power we once did. We outhit every other Orioles' team that played here since 1954 and outran them, too."

# Swofford, Floyd Exchange Charges At Altamonte Meet

ponents Mayor Lawrence Swofford and former Police Lt. Norman Floyd carried a through the city hall into the lobby after the city council meeting Tuesday night, with Floyd threatening to tell "what I know."

"It is common knowledge city funds are misused in Altamonte," Floyd said as the council meeting adjourned.

Floyd was absent from his usual seat in the council chamber when Comptroller Dick Baxter told the council the city stands to lose \$10,000 in federal funding due to "a staff problem" with documents not filed by the proper deadlines.

Under intense questioning from Councilman Dan Dorfman, Baxter said Floyd was project director on two grant programs for the police department when he left the city's employ in May. Baxter said when the city found that documents were not filed by deadline, a time extension was requested but

Baxter said a federal auditor is allowing only \$3,968 of the \$18,543 spent from the \$22,000 federal grant and that the balance


