A burglary at the Dewdrop Cove in Casselberry left the Baho Construction Co. minus \$1,750 worth of copper pipe, deputies said today.

The burglary was reported Monday but company officials and police are not sure when the incident occurred, deputies said. A spokesman for the company said the pipe was installed in seven houses and "The thief that ripped it out must have known what he was doing." The spokesman said the pipe was first seen on Friday.
