This magnificent document was born in times of stress and revolution, has suffered all the pains, tribulations and endured the challenges of maturity for nearly 200 years.

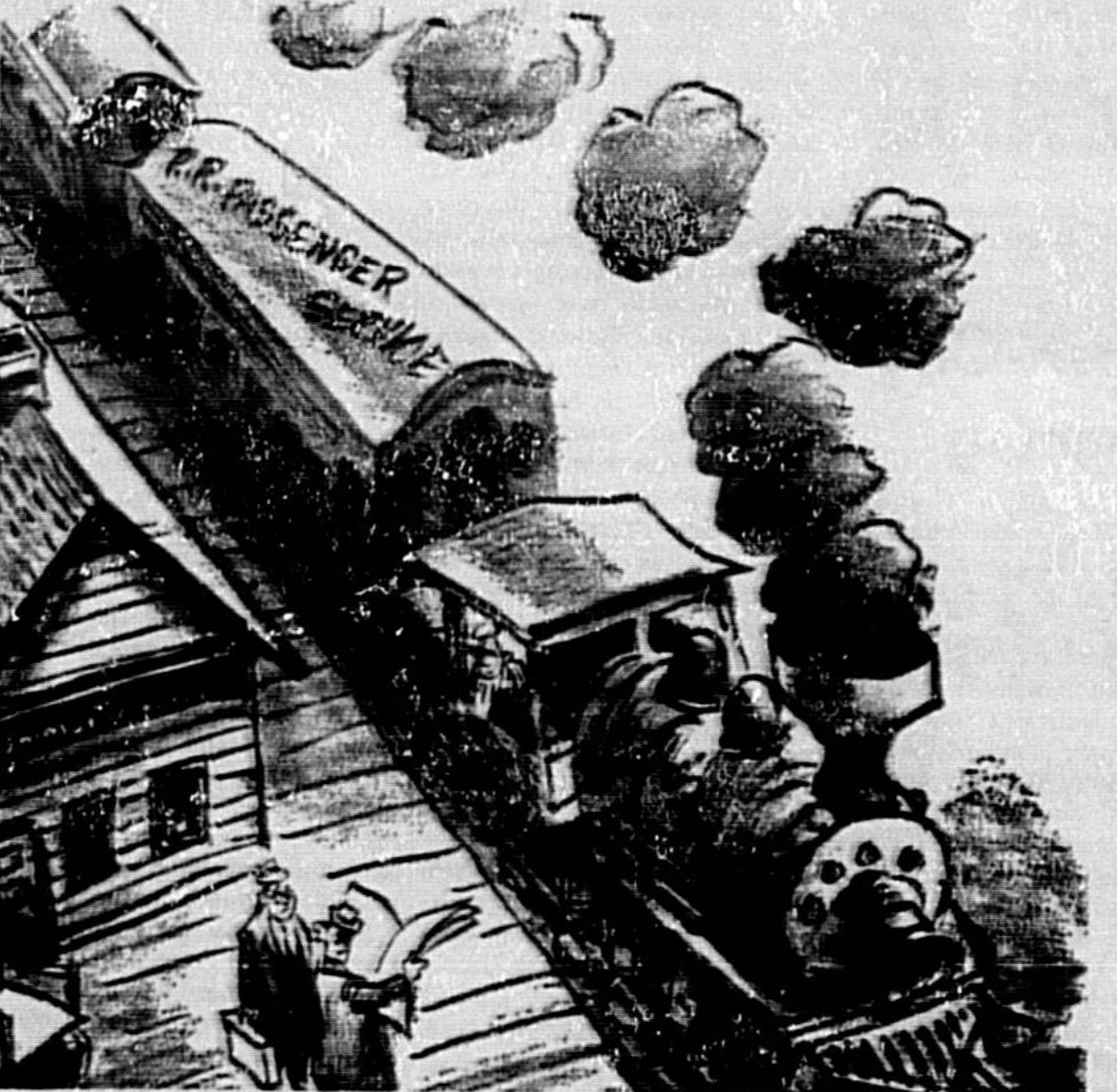

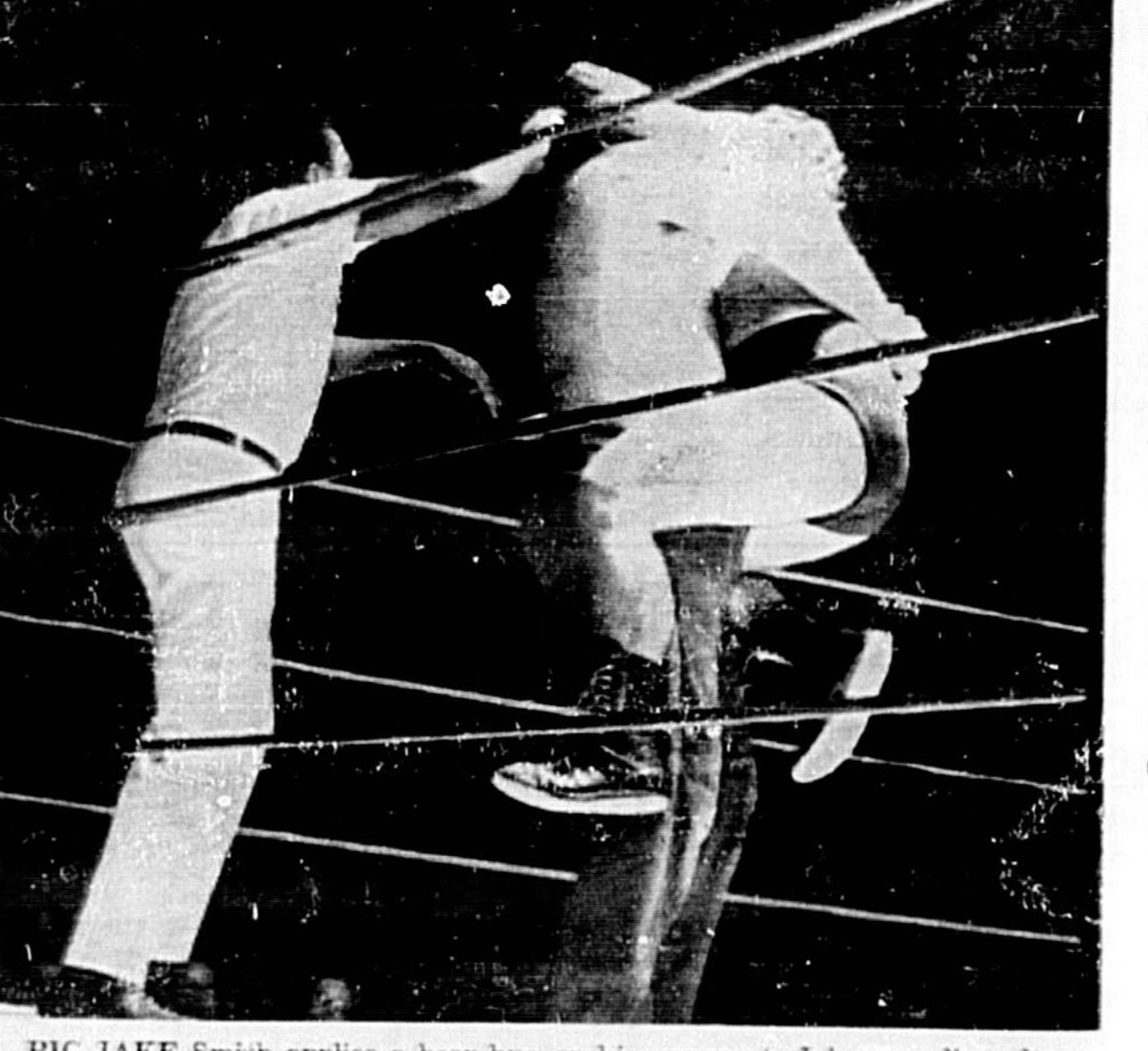
