Beirut Fighting Escalates

BEIRUT, Lebanon (AP) — Fighting escalated along the front line separating the Christians in eastern Beirut and the Moslems on the west, and security officials reported 52 persons killed and 120 wounded.

Altamonte Rejects Rezoning

ALTAMONTE SPRINGS — City commissioners Tuesday night turned down an annexation and rezoning request that would have permitted construction of more professional offices off Palm Springs Road after adjacent property owners in county territory protested.

Asked if he would accept a different zoning designation, the owner of the lots surrounded by city territory on Palm Springs Road said if he couldn't have professional office zoning he did not want his property annexed.

The city wanted to annex the parcels to square up city boundaries to give police better control of the road. In other action, the commission set a public hearing for May 11 on the requested change in zoning from apartment district to professional office for two lots at Ipswich, north of Lake and near Mattland Avenue.

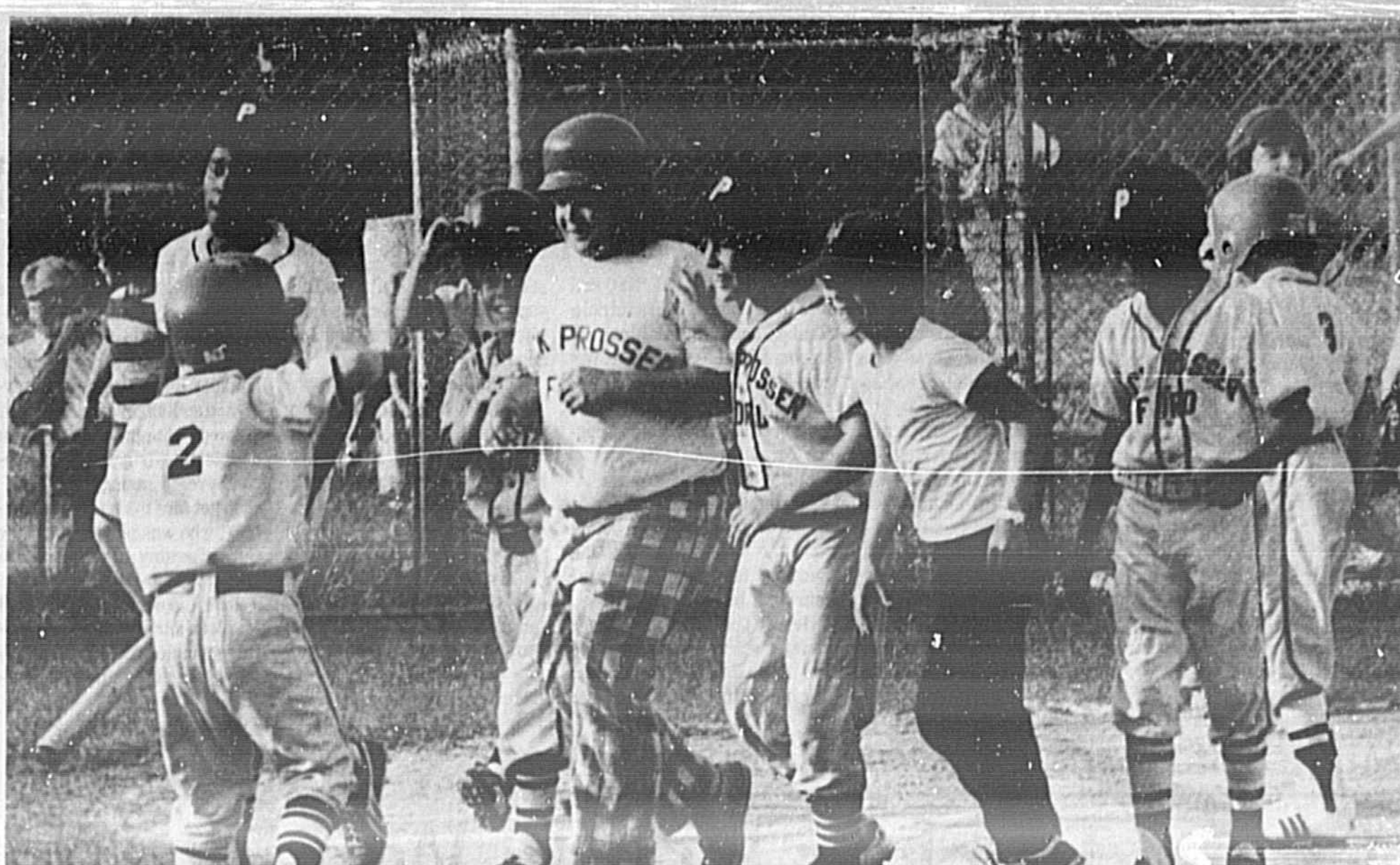

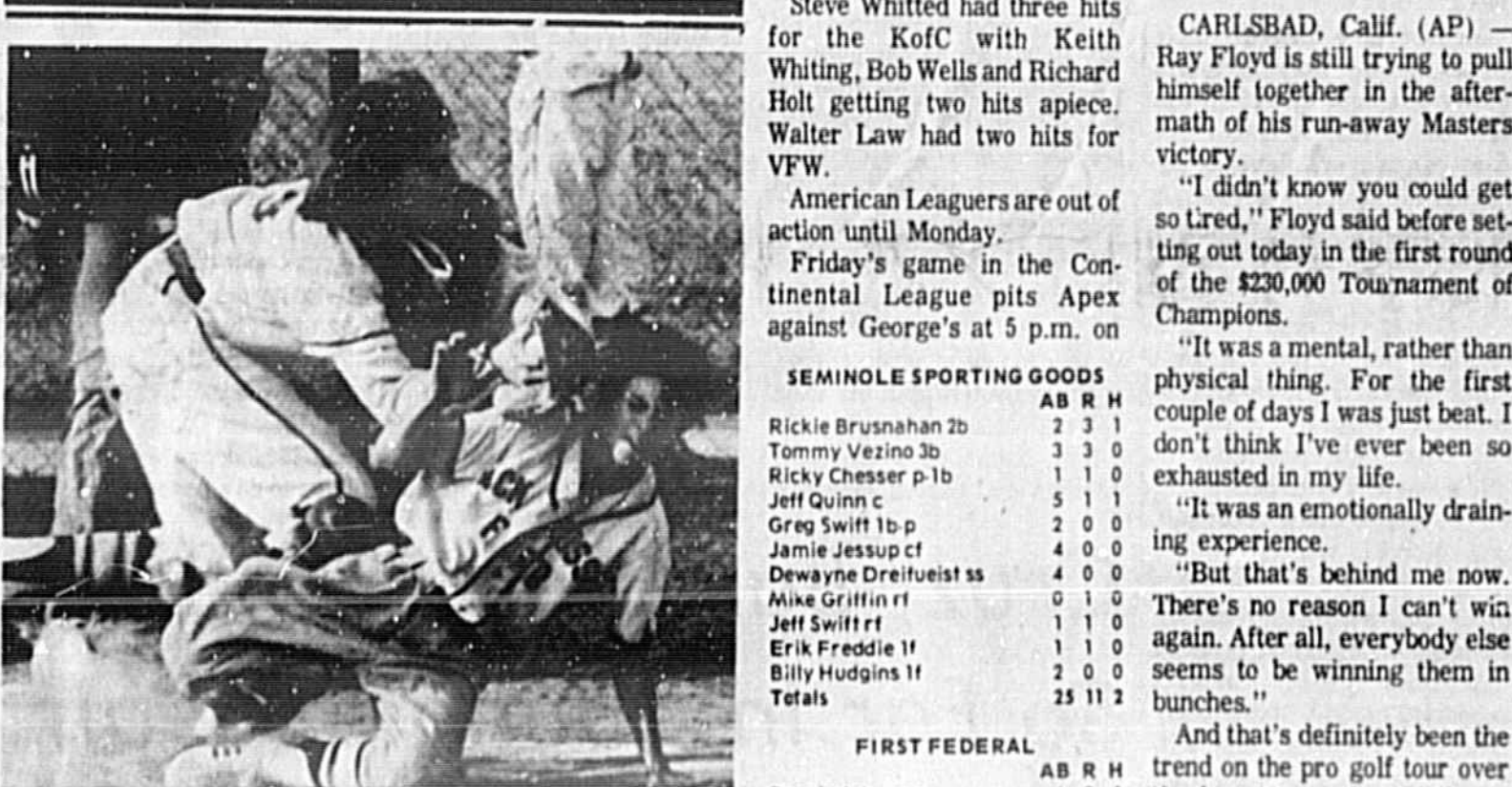

Roger Maltbie won two in a row as the 1975 Rookie of the Year. Johnny Miller collected two titles in his first four starts this year.

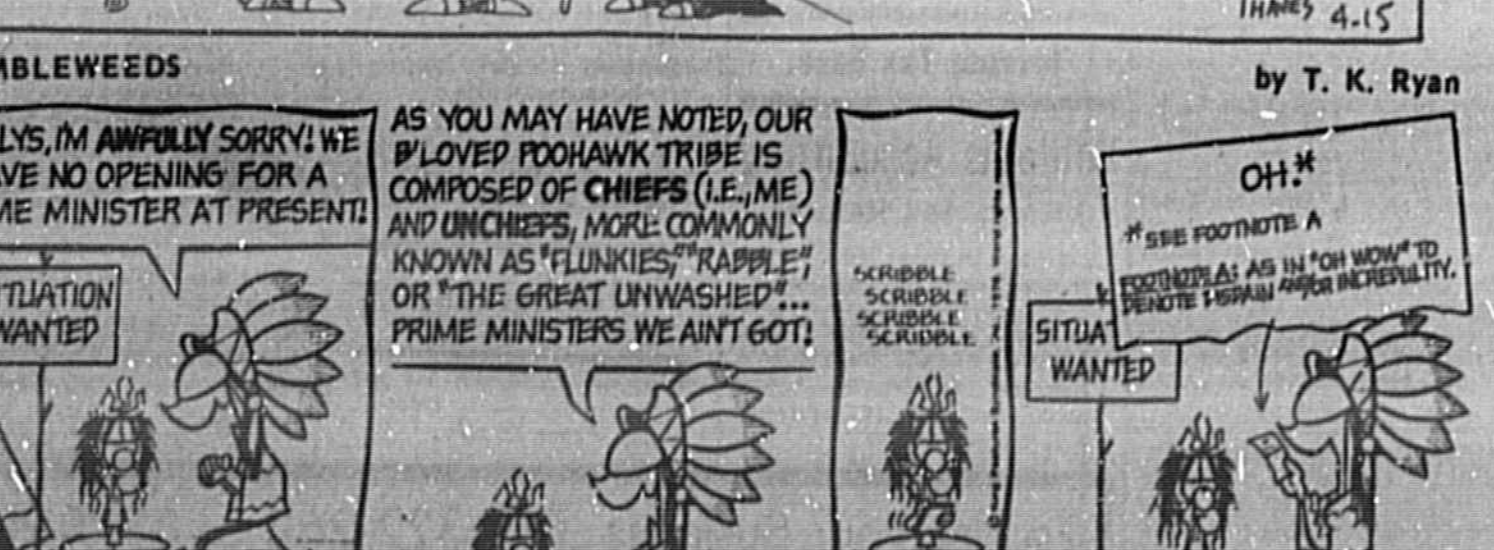
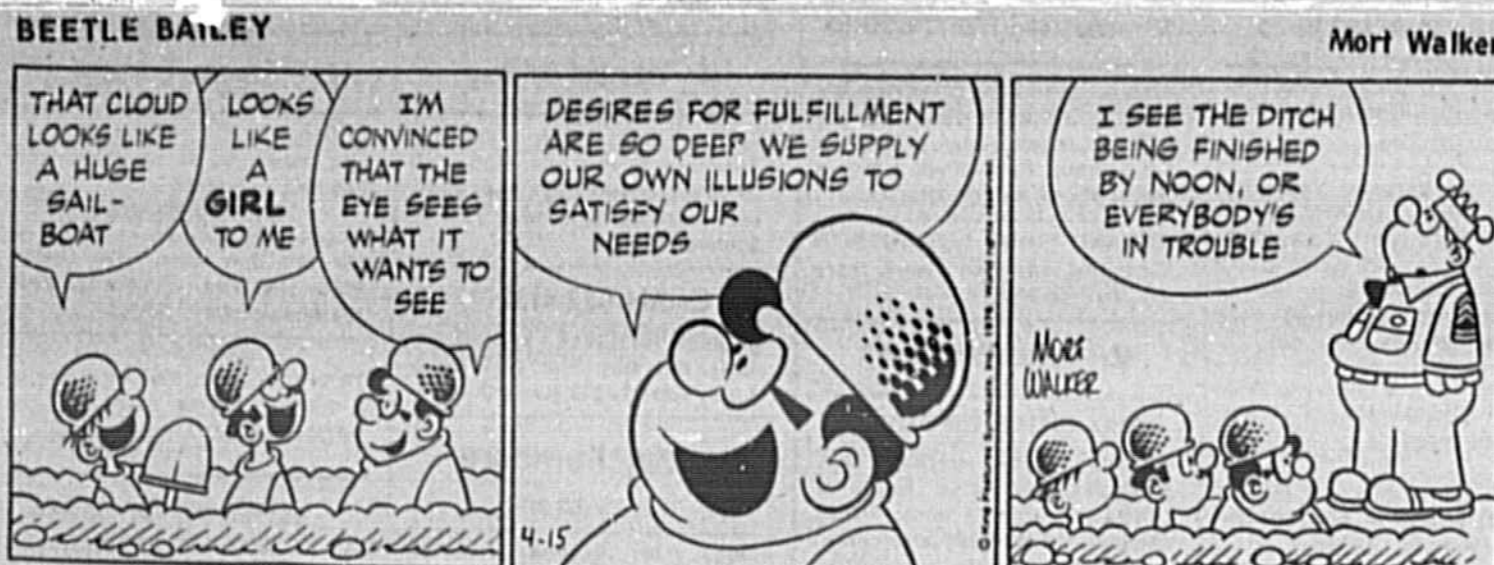

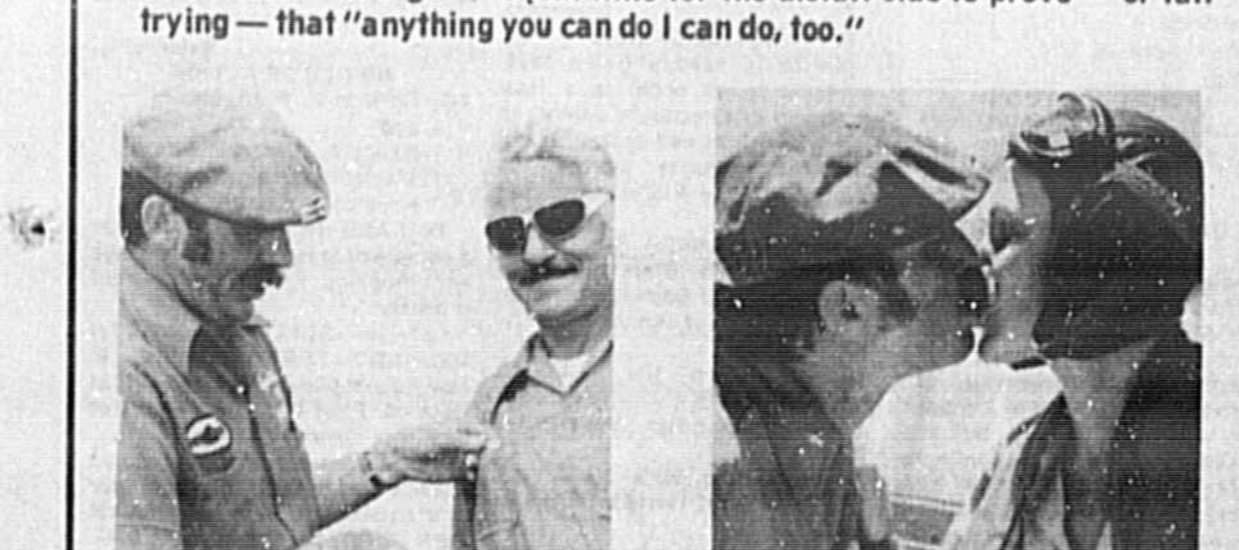

## Cancer Tests Not Required Of Female Public Employees

By DONNA ESTES Herald Staff Writer The "Pap test," a common laboratory procedure credited with cutting the death rate from uterine cancer by 90 per cent over the past 10 years because of early detection, is not among the physical examination requirements for persons employed by municipal or county government in Seminole.

Only two cities in Seminole County — Sanford and Casselberry — require physicals for general employees and the forms sent to physicians conducting the physicals do not include a requirement for a Pap smear.

Spokesmen for the various police departments in the county said they send their officers to physicians for the physicals required and forward the forms to the Tallahassee Police Standards Council.
