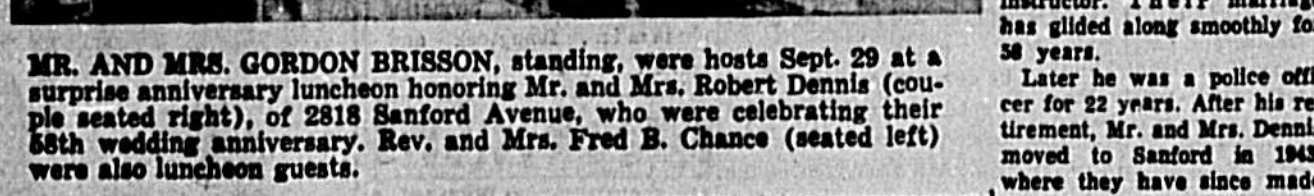

Mele maintained he isn't overly worried about the Dodgers' all-edges pitching. "Don't forget, we have speed and hitting along with our power. I have to figure that's a better bet than only speed pitching because that's all the Dodgers have. We all know they have no power."

Mele is right so far as Dodgers power is concerned, but in winning the series he is not expected to be the main ingredient. The Dodgers did it by speed and hitting along with their power.

WASHINGTON (NEA) — At the rear of a man's property, Negroes exercising some of their basic rights for the first time are being constantly told they must exhibit a counterbalancing sense of responsibility.

Unhappily for them — and for the country — the example of the majority white population in this regard is not good these days.

To an alarming degree, many white Americans seem to confuse liberty with license. They talk and act as if any important restraint upon them is "un-American," since it is "anti-individual."

It is common to throw harsh crime statistics in the Negro's face. But crime is rising steeply among the white juveniles in the nation's white-dominated suburbs.

The public behavior of many whites today is appalling. It goes beyond mere discourtesy and offensive antics. It tramples on the rights of others.

The invasion of privacy, undertaken, of course, in the name of the individual's freedom to do as he pleases, has become a major assault. For some people, trespass is now almost a way of life.

In a recent hamlet, a woman accompanied by two children and a dog suddenly emerged from a private woods

at the rear of a man's property. A cook standing nearby explained the land was private and asked the woman what she was doing there.

"Wouldn't you like to know?" the woman replied, as she continued her way across the man's lawn to his front gate.

Many appear to believe that the liberties democracy assures to the individual include freedom from all criticism. How "right" a driver who has nearly run you down by going through a stop light is to be judged is not a matter of opinion. It is a matter of fact. The only question then is: "What are you doing to my son?"

To explain, if not to justify some serious youthful misbehavior, there is further nonsense about the "idleness" which engulfs the young in this affluent age. In the old days, the argument runs, the young folk were busy doing something for their children to perform. Families with "suburban spread" today ought, in fact, have more for the young to do.

The truth is that many, far from being deprived are spoiled with material goods and rich possessions. They find excitement only in tearing up the turf. To penalize these wild possessions is to be accused of abridging freedom.

Let's be direct about this. Among America's dominant white population are far, far too many who simply do not believe in self-control. They do not accept the notion that man is a social animal. They are in countless ways truly antisocial. "Society" has no right to demand that they can impose but few legitimate burdens. Their view of democracy is a system which biases individual anarchy.

To fall back on the tired alibi that "only a minority are involved" is to call up the soft vocabulary so fondly regarded in this age of the Negro. In a country with 170 million more whites, any kind of minority can be — and usually is — very substantial in terms of sheer numbers.

The numbers who think that liberty is license are growing every day and they are an example to anyone.

WASHINGTON (UPI) — The Smithsonian Institution currently is celebrating the 200th anniversary of the birth of the man for whom it was named, James Smithson.

Some people think the place was named for James Smithson, but that is wrong. Smithson was a very interesting fellow in several ways. Far one, he was an Englishman, the son of the Duke of Northumberland. For another, his mother and father neglected to get married.

Because of this parental oversight, Smithson was unable to inherit his father's title. He resented that and resolved to make good on his own. What he did.

He not only became a distinguished scientist but also an important man in the process. When he died he left his entire fortune to the United States.

As far as I can determine, this was the last time the United States has gotten anything from an Englishman. Smithson stipulated that the money be used "for the increase and diffusion of knowledge among men." This was founded the Smithsonian Institution, which has since become the largest museum complex in the world.

One reason the Smithsonian has done so well is because a lot of other people, in the tradition of Smithson, have given things to it.

I personally have been on hand when the Smithsonian received such treasures as the first silk purse made from a son's ear and one of the last of the Borneo rhino signs.

This week, in keeping with the anniversary ceremonies, I had a talk with another Smithsonian donor, Sidney Krandall of Detroit. Krandall, like Smithson, is interesting, but in a different way.

A gem collector known in some quarters as "Mr. Diamond," he owns a diamond mine in Brazil, a sapphire mine in Thailand, a pearl mine in Japan and an emerald mine in Colombia. That would make anybody interesting.

A year or so ago he gave the Smithsonian what is believed to be the only four-star sapphire ever found. Another nine girls have just gone on display and Krandall said that eventually his entire collection of more than 10,000 precious stones will wind up in the Smithsonian.

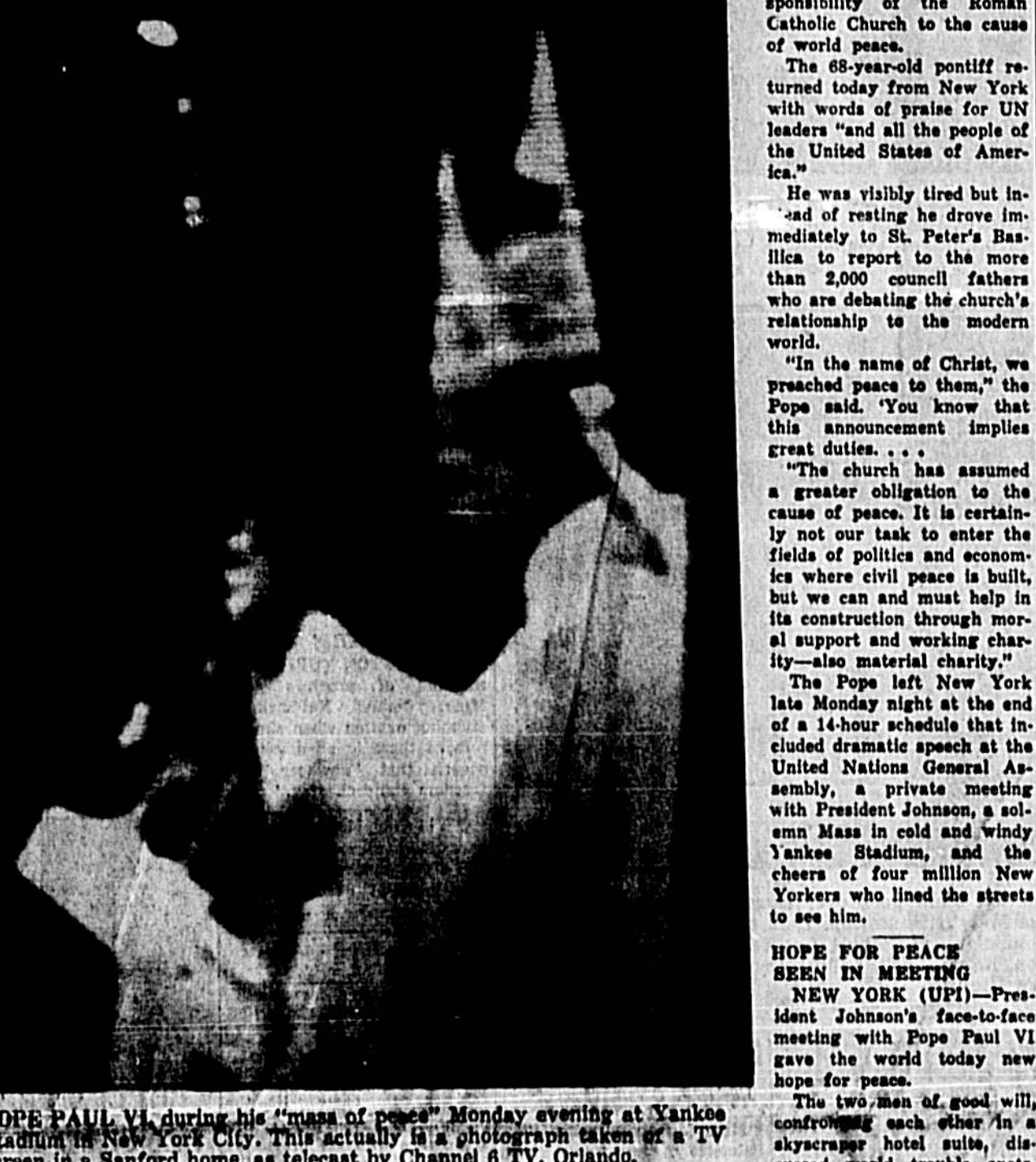

Church Duty Emphasized By Pontiff

ROME (UPI)—Pope Paul VI told the Ecumenical Council today his historic pilgrimage to the United Nations had increased the responsibility of the Roman Catholic Church to the cause of world peace.

The 68-year-old pontiff returned today from New York with words of praise for UN leaders "and all the people of the United States of America."

He was visibly tired but instead of resting he drove immediately to St. Peter's Basilica to report to the more than 2,000 council fathers who are debating the church's relationship to the modern world.

"In the name of Christ, we preached peace to them," the Pope said. "You know that this announcement implies great duties"

"The church has assumed a greater obligation to the cause of peace. It is certain that our task is to enter the fields of politics and economics where civil peace is built, and to help in the construction through moral support and working charity—also material charity."

The Pope left New York late Monday night at the end of a 14-hour schedule that included dramatic speeches at the Commission, and in the United Nations General Assembly, a private meeting with the Rev. Martin Luther King Jr. and the Rev. James Bevel, and a mass in St. Peter's Basilica.

81 Africans Die In Train Wreck

DURBAN, South Africa (UPI)—Rescue workers toiled through the night to free survivors from the twisted wreckage of a derailed world train in which at least 81 Africans were killed and 150 injured.

Frantic survivors killed one white railroadman and wounded another in confusion of rescue operations.

The deralement was described as the worst railroad disaster in South African history. Three cars of the packed train left the rails at 6 p.m. Monday but the accident went unreported for more than three hours.

Another American patrol in the area heard the sound of gunfire and tried to work its way through jungle to help rescue the attacking guerrillas.

But the Viet Cong snuck into the thick underbrush and escaped by the time the second patrol arrived.

American casualties were officially described as "heavy."
