The populist tide that rolled through China
ast spring was not uulike that which wished away totalitarian reglmes in Eastern Europe later in the year. Terrified of that tide. Beljing resorted to brute force to rout the deto prevent their regrouping
No one. save for the knows the extent of the Thananmen Squar Chinese were klled by June 3 and 4 . whille more than a 1.000 were subsequently executed throughout the country. According to a State Departmen ers were being detalned in Beijing as recently as two months ago. Although the government relcased 211 detalnees as a "goodwill gesture." Amnesty International says that
tens of thousands of dissidents are stild behind bars.
Most recenty, dissident Peng Rong was arrested after calling for an end to economic sanctions against China. The Beijing Unlver-
stty student's crime was to speak at a campus demonstretlon that had not been approved by the government. So paranoid are Chlna's retrograde leaders. they caniot distinguish
between pollitical discourse and sedilion between political diseourse and sedition the rute throughout Chtna at a time when most communist nations are experimenting with democratic reforms. The government's
security apparatus ls so pervisive as to deter organized opposition. And the elimate of fear hais had a chilling effect on econome reform as well. Centralized planntug has been
reimposed on virtually every sector of the ecomosny and a strict austertity progrimm to combat inflation has causerd Chinese living standards to plummet.
