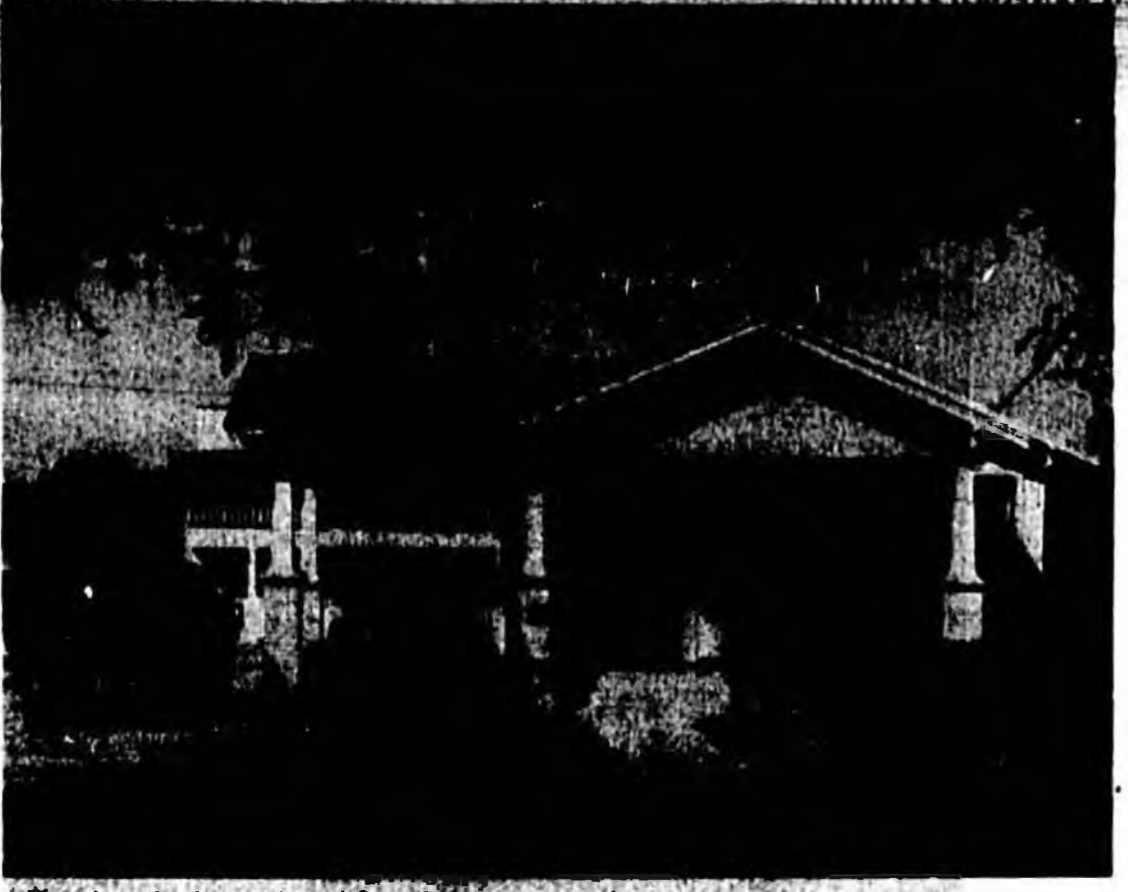

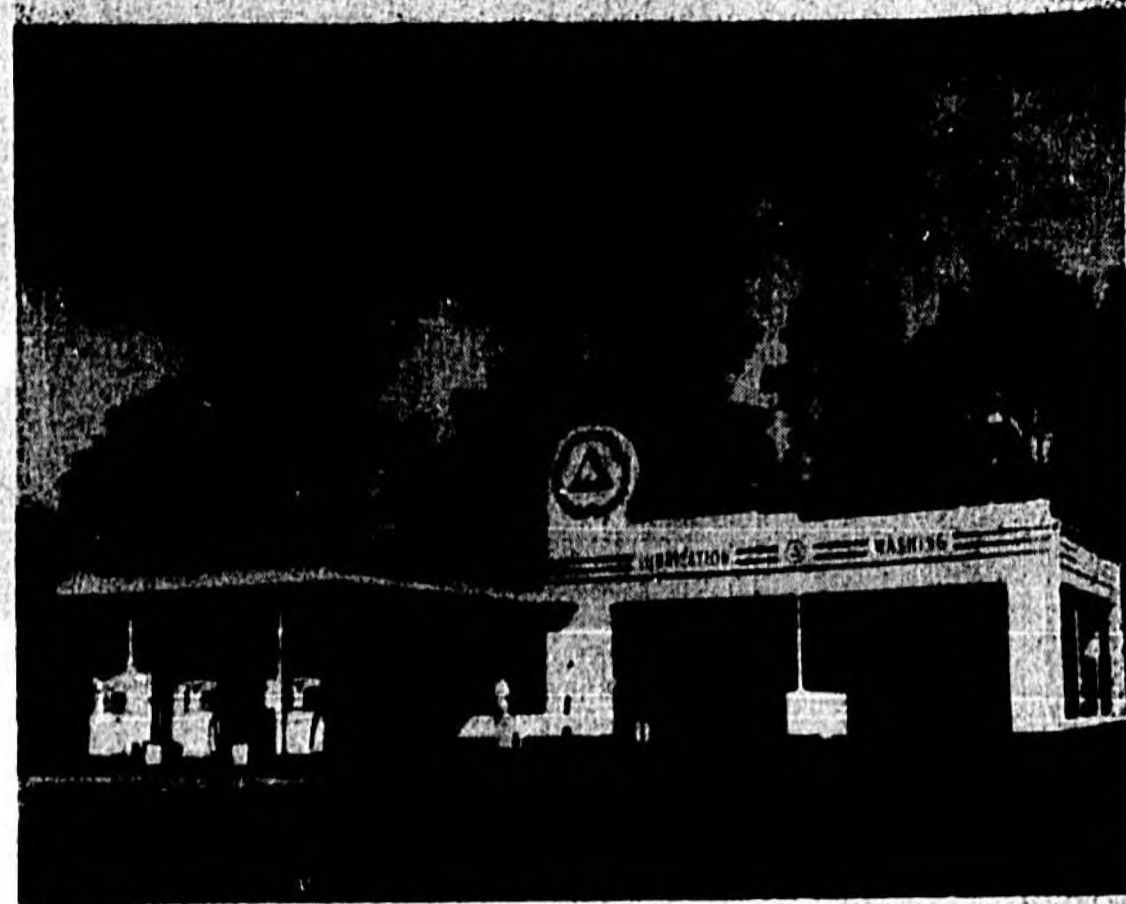

Some people say we don't really have a peace right now, and I'll admit it's hard to get the dove of amity to hold still long enough to count its feathers.

That's why some people subscribe to the theory we are hotly engaged in a cold war that is bound to erupt soon in flaming battle.

My idea is that this theory is wrong. A feeling is that we aren't likely to have another international war in our time. It just doesn't make common sense. By that I mean within 10 or 15 years. And I am stubborn enough of an optimist to hope that if war is started off for that long it will possibly be found to be permanently unnecessary.

Of course, that will demand some adulthood.

The main problem is still, as it has ever been, to develop the untapped resources of a fruitful world so that all men can live better — and hand down like a shining baton, to their children.

My way has been shown for all people to live better.

That is the avenue of atomic power. But it is a power that can do many men as well as cure their ills.

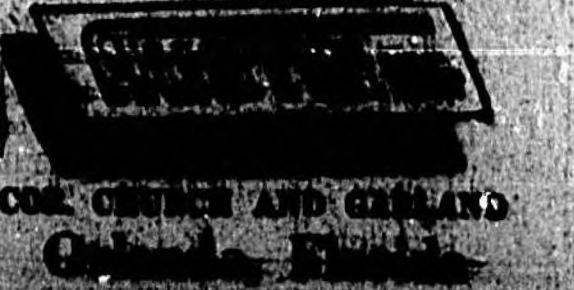
