Using The Herald as your textbook, a story or release should contain answers to the five W's in the first paragraph, which answers the questions, WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE and WHY. Following para-

WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE and WHY. Following paragraphs should add supporting details. A basic rule for copy is: Put in all that is necessary to tell the story in the right order, in the most direct and single language possible — that, and no more.

Be ABSOLUTELY sure that all facts, names and initials, titles and figures are correct. In the event that it is not possible to submit typewritten copy, PRINT all names boldly.

People don't like to have their names misspelled!

If a particular release date is desired, get your notices into The Herald office at least two days in advance of date.
