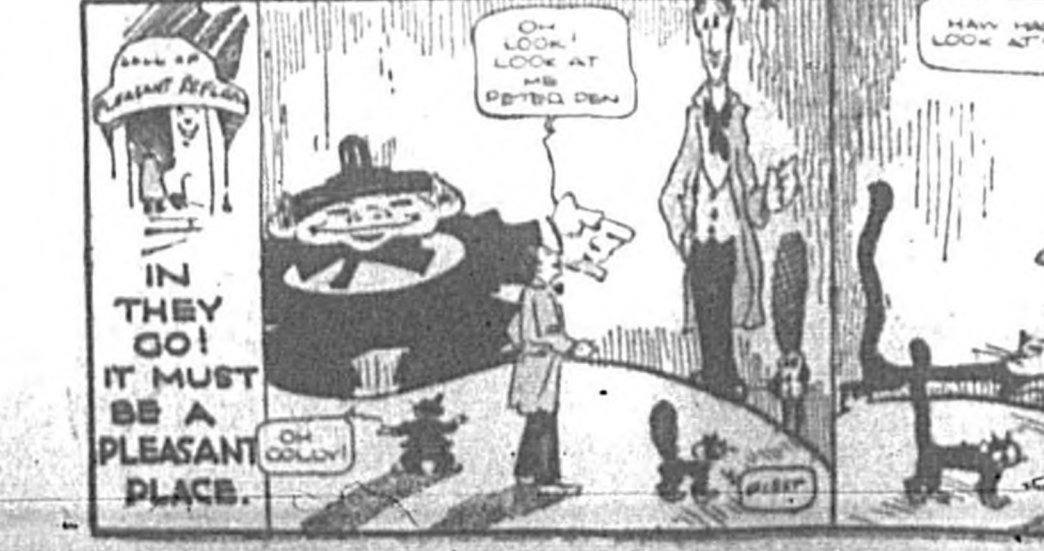
# Italian Spokesman Sees World War If Suez Canal Closed
