WASHINGTON, Apr. 20.—(AP)—The opening of an intense Japanese effort to latter Corregidor into helplessness by bombs and fire was reported today. The Department today. Dine Lomblin raids were made on the fortress and defending gunners are said to have silenced at least three batteries and broken up other concentrations.

A successful raid by a small mobile force of Americans and Filipinos on enemy outposts in northern Luzon was reported yesterday by the War Department, which said "large" military stores were destroyed and heavy casualties inflicted on the Japs.

The fortress island of Corregidor continued, meanwhile, under heavy air and artillery bombardment, a communique said, and suffering forces were reported to be holding out.

At least four and possibly five enemy batteries have been silenced, it is reported, by a patrol of American and Filipino soldiers.

The American flag over Corregidor was shot down Saturday, the War Department said, but it was replaced by a few minutes by three stars and men who were officially commended by General Wainwright.

Boards Are Ready for Registration of Men, 45 to 64

ST. AUGUSTINE, Apr. 20.—(Special)—With local boards throughout the State of Florida ready to receive registrants for the registration on Apr. 27 of men between the ages of 45 and 64, the State Director of Selective Service, today pointed out that there are only three main requirements for this registration.

The general summarized these major requirements thus: (1) Every male citizen and every male alien residing in Florida, other than persons exempted by the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940, as amended, who had attained the forty-fifth anniversary of the day of his birth on or before Feb. 16, 1942, is required to present himself for and submit to registration on Apr. 27, 1942.

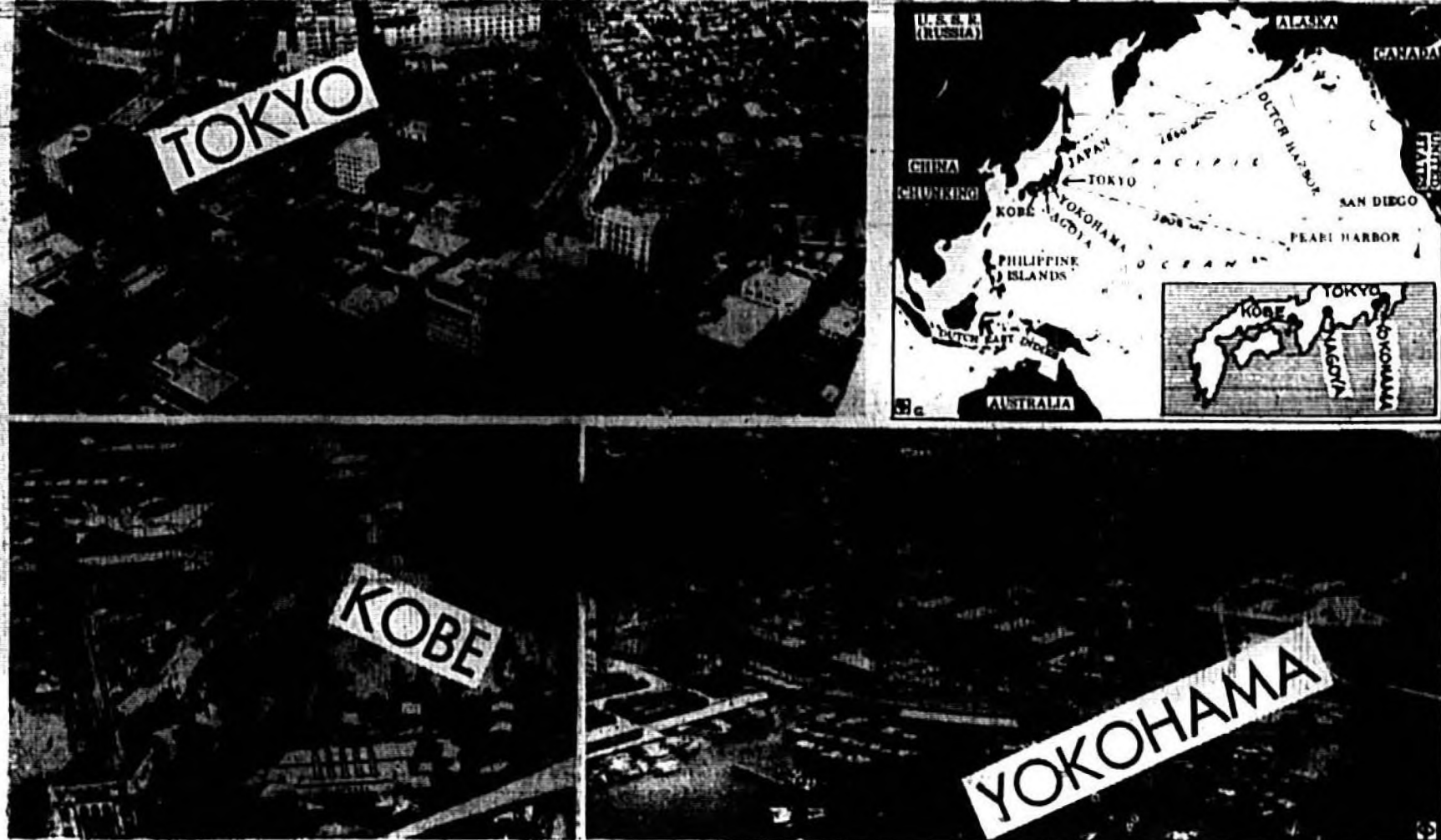
(2) Registration should be made at a designated registration place of the local board area in which the registrant has his permanent home, or in which he may be absent to be between the hours of 7:00 A. M. and 9:00 P. M. on Apr. 27. This registration place may be the office of the local board having jurisdiction in the area, or other place properly designated by that local board.

(3) Registrants must answer all questions asked by the registrars in a designated registration card. It is important that the registrant describe his place of residence in detail as well as give full particulars as to the address at which he will be sure to receive mail or other communications. Anyone who is untruthfully away from his home on Apr. 27 may register at the registration place most convenient on the day, the general said, but all registrants are urged to make every effort to appear at their own local board in a true and honest manner.

Reinforced British Hold Burma Lines

Chinese Recapture Town And Release English Soldiers From Encirclement

The reinforced British, defending the right wing of the Burma line near Taunggying-wei, maintained their positions under repeated Japanese assaults as heavy fighting continued in all sectors of the front.

Australian leaders met with Gen. Douglas MacArthur and other Allied commanders to map plans for the swift re-occupation of manpower and resources in Australia. United Nations leaders struck at enemy shipping in Rabaul Harbor, New Britain on Sunday inflicting some damage.

A total of 40 Japanese planes is claimed by the Allied planes in attacks on Hsanku. The Japs are reported to have been destroyed on the ground.

Chungking reported Chinese troops recaptured Yenangyung, the Burma line center today and in two days of bitter fighting released a British force of several thousand from encirclement. American volunteers and U. S. Army fliers fighting with Lieutenant General Stilwell's Chinese forces on the Rangoon Mandalay road were reported going out on their sector and they were able to establish local air superiority at times although they were hampered by lack of reinforcements.

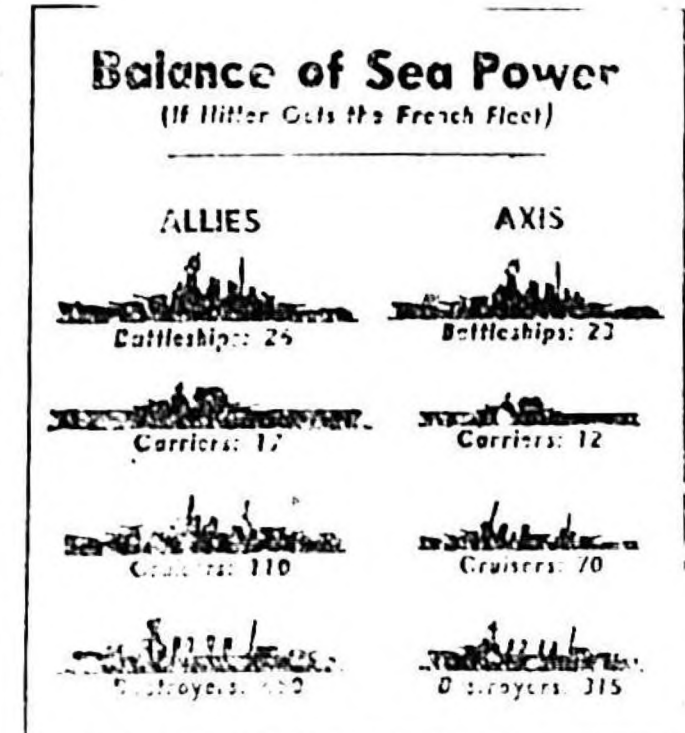
