Declaration Of War Is Possible

British Ships Shell Genoa Naval Base; Much Damage Done

BERN, Switzerland, Feb. 10.—(AP)—Diplomatic advisers reaching here today said Spanish Generalissimo Francisco Franco and Foreign Minister Ramon Serrano Suñer were enroute to Yugoslavia on the French-Italian frontiers to confer with Mussolini on Spolia position in the Mediterranean war.

Neutral diplomatic quarters speculated whether Britain soon might follow the break with a declaration of war, especially since the rich Rumanian oil fields which are completely in German hands supplying fuel for the Nazi Luftwaffe's raids on Britain would constitute a legitimate target for British bombing planes.

Mussolini's High Command reported 72 persons killed and 220 wounded and "enormous damage" inflicted by a powerful squadron of British warships which boldly steamed into northern Italian coastal waters and rained 200 tons of shells into the naval base of Genoa.

Here is some timely advice for drivers who wish to avoid being included among the thousands who will be hurt or killed on wintry roads before spring returns...

1) Drive slowly. This means to drive at a speed which will give you time to stop if you are suddenly faced with a dangerous situation.

2) Avoid the lead in your car as evenly as possible. An uneven lead makes control of your car far more difficult on slippery surfaces.

3) Allow more time for covering your usual trips than when road surfaces are safer. By assuming in advance that you may have to drive very slowly than usual you can avoid having to take chances.

4) Whenever possible, alter routes to avoid slippery hills and grades. In winter the longest way round is frequently the shortest way home.

5) Resist any urge to speed up when driving in snowy ruts. Although the ruts may seem to control the direction of your car a slight irregularity may throw your vehicle into the path of approaching cars or into a dangerous ditch.

6) Remember that the road surface over which you are driving may be wet, icy or dry, all within a few feet. Dark colored road surfaces absorb more of the sun's heat than lighter colored surfaces. Be on the alert for constantly changing conditions.
