—Tire rationing rules were revised Sunday to prevent beer, soft drinks and other "unessential" trucks from getting new or recapped tires after July 28.

Also cut from the eligibility list by action of the Office of Price Administration were all privately operated trucks carrying alcholic beverages, tobacco, candy, tlowers, fore, radios, confections musical instruments and other luxury goods—unless the heuling of such items is only incidentalito the main service performed by the truck.






