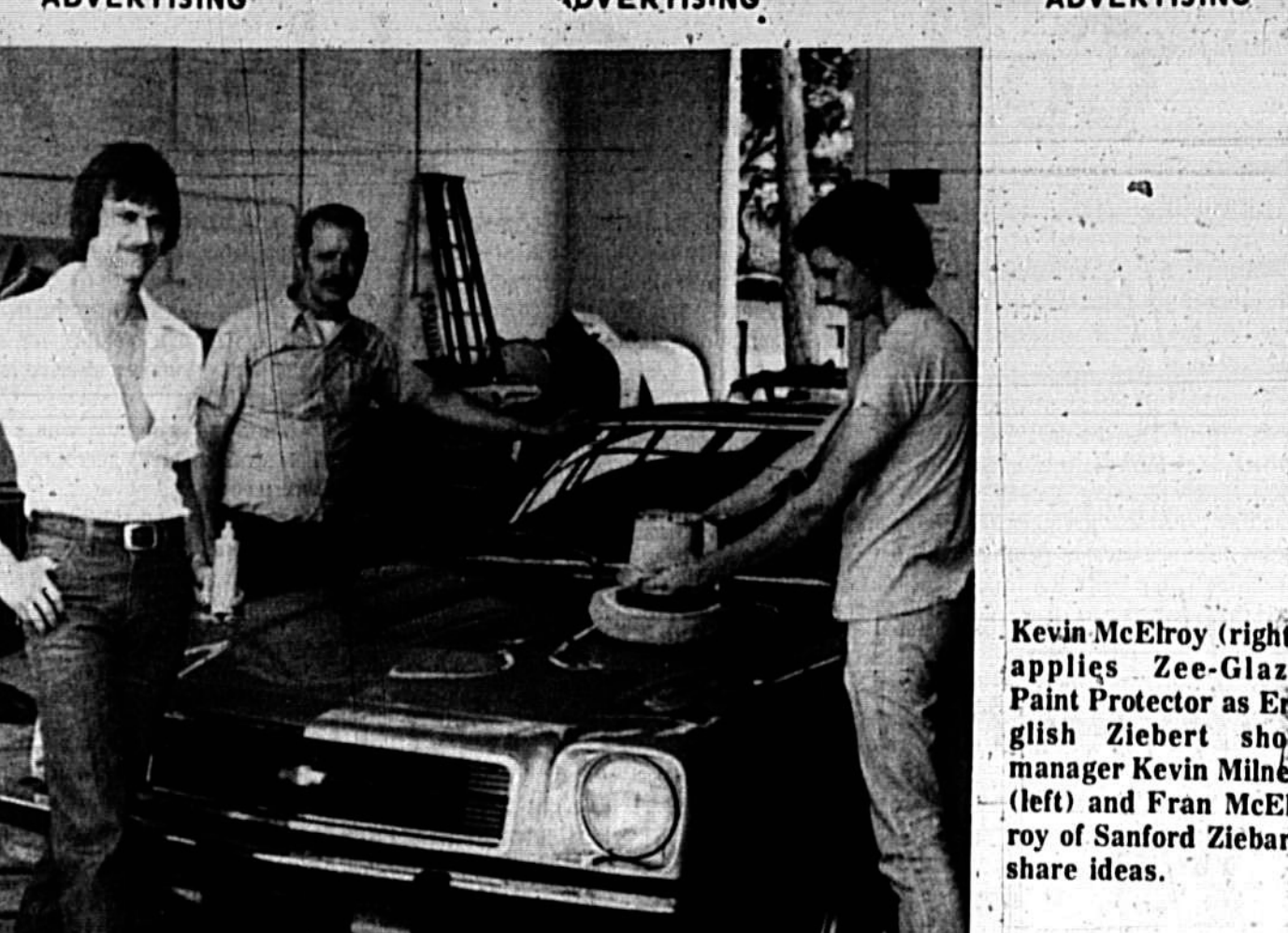

Impotence Caused By Many Factors



DEAR DR. LAMB — My problem may be psychological but I would like to say that I had an injury to my left side and back about eight years ago when I fell from a ladder. My wife was very patient with me after my fall but our sexual activities were far from satisfactory and I had no control over when I would have an erection or when I was able to have an orgasm.

DEAR READER — You should not conclude that your problem is psychological. Even men who are impotent on a psychological basis can still have orgasms and do form semen. The same is true of men who are impotent on the basis of diabetes. Part of the explanation here is that the nerve mechanisms that control erection are somewhat different from the same nerve mechanisms that are responsible for an orgasm.

DEAR READER — No, the baby will not have the problem of drug addiction if the father is a junkie. There may be some drugs that affect the chromosomes in the sperm cells but I don't believe enough studies really have been done on this. If the mother uses drugs or alcohol, the baby may develop an addiction to these drugs and will have withdrawal symptoms and perhaps other problems.

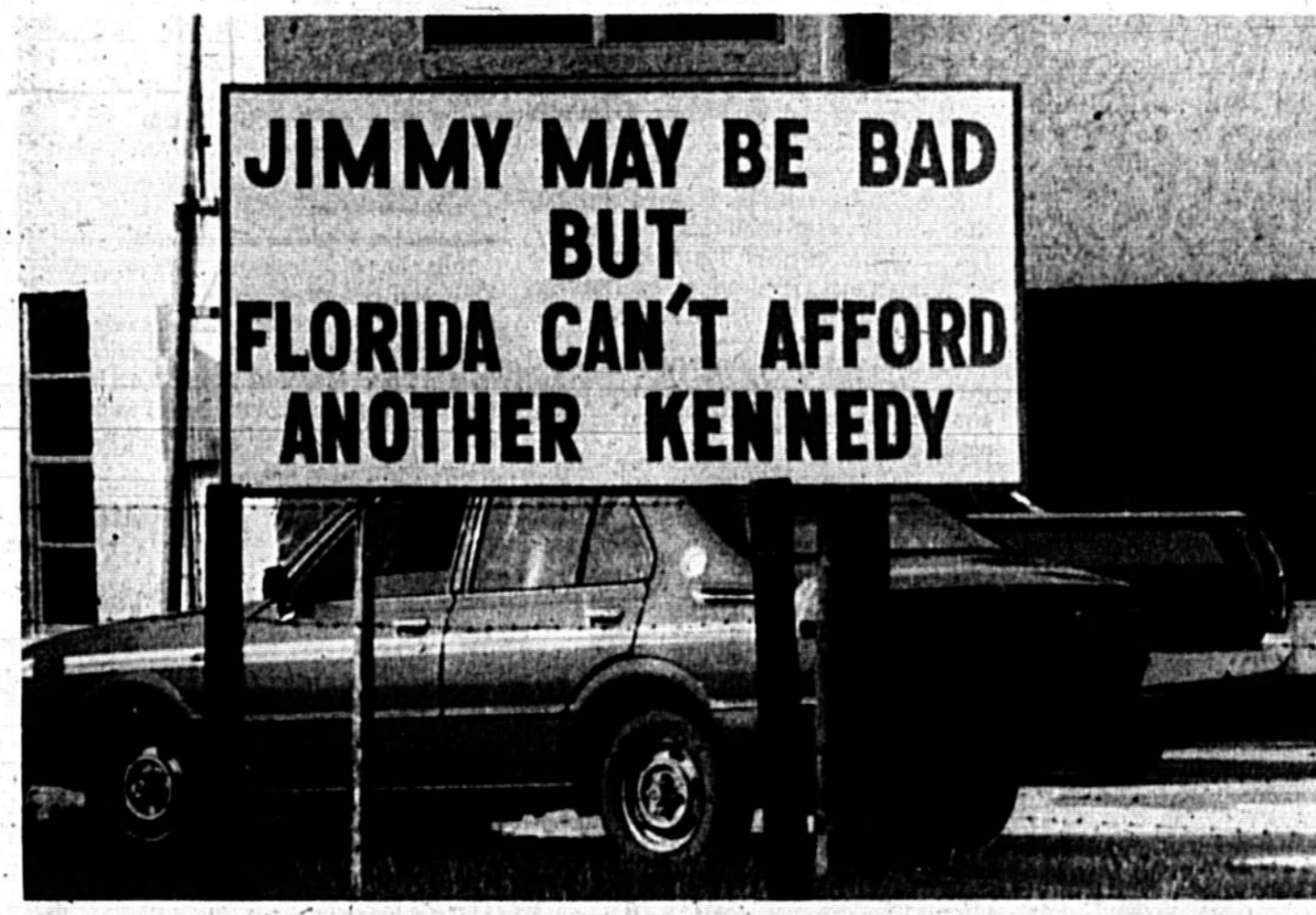

Iranian Embassy In London Held

LONDON (UPI) — Three Iranian gunmen took over the Iranian Embassy today and held about 20 occupants, including a policeman, hostage as they negotiated demands with police. Most of those held were Iranian nationals and there were no reports of any casualties in the takeover, police said.

HCA Wants At Least 200 Beds For Sanford Hospital

By DIANE PETRYK Herald Staff Writer Hospital Corporation of America (HCA) spokesmen said this week HCA will not accept an allocation of less than 200 beds for their planned replacement facility for Seminole Memorial Hospital.

Hospital Architect Emphasizes Lake View

Sanford's new hospital will be built in an H-shape perpendicular to Seminole Boulevard (U.S. Highway 17) and Lake Monroe, project architect Jim Wachel said today.

He said it will be a 3-story structure, 40 feet in height, but it is not yet certain whether construction will be of brick or other materials. All patient rooms, he said, will be on the second and third floors, and there will be two nurses stations per floor.

Wachel said the building will be designed to protect itself against the blind mosquitoes. Entry ways and fresh air intakes will be strategically placed for maximum protection, he said, and filters will be used on air intakes.

Relations Director Kay Bartholomew said the hospital is at 87 percent occupancy in its medical and surgical departments. She said the hospital's overall average occupancy is 79.5 percent, including pediatrics and obstetrical wards, which are typically under-used in area hospitals at this time.

Reflecting on the hospital's high occupancy rate, Wellborn said that a full hospital is usually allowed to be replaced.

"A 300-bed hospital that is half filled in might not be. They don't want to perpetuate over-bedding," he said. Nine regional health systems agencies in the state decide where hospitals may be built and how many beds they may contain. Applicants must justify construction of hospitals and beds by proving need.

According to the HSA-NEF, Volusia County is over-bedded, but the beds may be maldistributed. Political agitation for a hospital in Deltona has been going on since at least late last year. Deltona is in Volusia County, but many of its residents come to Sanford for their medical care.

Fort Walton Beach Honors Dead

FORT WALTON BEACH, Fla. (UPI) — Air Force Secretary Hans Mark leads the military memorial service planned by Harbor Field today for five of the eight men killed in last week's attempt to free the Iranian hostages.

Valdosta, Ga.; Capt. Richard Bakke, 33, a navigator from Long Beach, Calif.; Capt. Charles McMillan, 29, a navigator from Boise, Idaho; and Technical Sgt. Noel Mayo, 34, a flight engineer from Bonifay, Fla.

In Washington President Carter has condemned the "ghoulish action" of Iranian militants in displaying the bodies of American dead and asserted his determination to take "whatever steps are necessary and feasible" to secure safe release of the American hostages.

Carter, speaking at times with anger Tuesday night at his second news conference in 11 days, defended the rescue mission as having been undertaken with honored preparation, at the proper time and with good chances of success.
