DRAKE GRIDDERS LEAVE FOR GAME WITH THE GATORS

Stiff Workouts For Bulldog Eleven Held at St. Augustine Preparing for Clash Tomorrow At Gainesville

ATLANTA, Ga., Nov. 26.—With the best saved for the last in many cases on the Southern football card Thanksgiving brings contests that are elevated from the category of games to the class of institutions. Many annual games played Thursday are so long established that the mind of the football fan runneth not to the contrary, this generation at least.

This year the curtain goes down in the Southern conference in a greater blaze of glory than ever before for in the game at Birmingham between Georgia and Alabama the mythical championship may be decided. Georgia goes into the game with a record of five conference victories, unmarred by defeats or draws while Alabama has won four conference contests and escaped a tie. Each team has lost a game outside the conference, Georgia to Yale, 7 to 6, and Alabama to Centre, 17 to 0. Only two other conference teams are undefeated and but one of these has a chance to acquire five victories.

Three conference teams will not be able to pack up the balls after Thanksgiving. Georgia will leave Birmingham for Danville, Ky., to play Centre Saturday and Washington and Lee is booked for an engagement with Florida in Jacksonville, Dec. 6. The Generals and Alligators are undefeated, Washington and Lee boasting 3 victories and a tie and Florida's standing showing a victory and a tie. Washington and Lee plays North Carolina State in Raleigh Thursday while Florida's opponent, Drake, comes from the Missouri Valley conference, making the long jump from Des Moines to Gainesville for the day.

Georgia Tech and Auburn play in Atlanta in a game that makes or breaks the season for the two teams. Regardless of previous triumphs or reverses this game looms large in the calendar of the Yellow Jackets and Elephants. The same situation prevails in other Southern games.

Two Southern eleven follow the advice to young men to get west by leaving on trips that will find them in the same city. The Mississippi Aggies play Washington University and Centenary next, at St. Louis, both in St. Louis.

Harvard's '25 Grid Card Is Given Out; New Games Appear

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., Nov. 26.—Two new opponents, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute and William and Mary College, appear on the Harvard football schedule for 1925, made public Tuesday by the Harvard Athletic Association subject to the formal approval of the Athletic committee. Another innovation in the 1925 season will be the playing of the Brown game at Providence in connection with the inauguration of the new Brown athletic plant.

The schedule follows, games to be played at the Stadium, unless otherwise indicated: October 3, Rensselaer; 10, Middlebury; 17, Holy Cross; 24, Dartmouth; 31st, William and Mary; November 7, Princeton at Princeton; 14, Brown at Providence; 21, Yale.

ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla., Nov. 26.—The Drake university football team from Des Moines, Iowa, left here at 12:10 o'clock this afternoon for Gainesville, the seat of Thursday's conflict which will offer fans an opportunity for comparison between southern and Missouri Valley football.

The Bulldogs engaged in two rather stiff practice sessions here, arriving late Tuesday afternoon. Coach Oscar Solon's men were immediately taken to a practice field near the bench where they were driven through a strenuous work-out. After a long signal drill, the reserves ran through an assortment of Gator plays which the varsity had trouble in stopping. The practice outfit is a colorful squad, with a fine assortment of formations designed to worry Coach Van Fleet's hard hitting Florida boys.
