Homemade Ice Cream Is Good Any Time

According to market research reports, about 80 per cent of the families in the U.S. buy ice cream. But for high quality and money saving, we suggest making it at home. We found we could make a quart of the finest ice cream for less than half the price we paid for it at a store.

If one of the new refrigerator-freezer ice-cream machines was among the gifts you received at holiday time, you're in luck. Once you get the hang of the appliance, it's extremely easy to make a batch of America's favorite dessert. No ice, no salt needed! It's a fascinating and well-functioning device.

The following recipe is for banana ice cream—a popular flavor that's hard to buy in its pure form. We give directions for making it in an ice-cream machine. It can also be made in a metal mixing bowl or in ice-cube trays minus dividers; to do this pour the ice-cream mixture into the container and place in the freezer until partially frozen, then remove, break up, beat and return to the freezer until firm throughout. The texture won't be as perfect as when the ice cream is churned in the machine, but it will be good.

When we offered the banana ice cream we served it with fresh strawberries—a bonus. We also like it with chocolate sauce or with fresh orange sections mixed with preserved ginger and some of the ginger syrup.

BANANA ICE CREAM
(Made in Refrigerator-Freezer Machine)

1 egg
1/4 cup sugar
1-3rd cup light corn syrup
8-ounce container heavy cream
3/4 cup milk
1 teaspoon vanilla
2 ripe bananas
2 teaspoons lemon juice

In a small mixing bowl beat egg until frothy. Gradually beat in sugar; continue to beat until sugar is dissolved. Add corn syrup and beat until blended. Stir in cream, milk and vanilla. Mash enough banana to make 1/2 cup; stir in lemon juice and then stir into milk mixture.

Place dasher in ice-cream machine. Pour in the ice-cream mixture. Position the dasher stem so that it fits through hole in lid. Snap on lid. Place the filled, covered can inside the base of the ice cream machine. Place the power unit over the base, rotating it so the dasher stem enters the drive socket in the power unit; when properly positioned, the locking springs hook into the base. Stand ice cream machine upright in freezer making sure air outlets at the bottom of the machine are not blocked by other items in freezer. Close freezer door with cord outside, making sure door closes completely; if door does not close completely, remove dasher. Cover ice cream with plastic film then place cover on can. Place in freezer for ice cream to ripen at least 1 hour. At serving time remove ice cream with a rubber spatula or unroll and cut in wedges. Makes about 1 1/2 quarts—6 or 8 servings.

Note: If freezing unit has a separate control, it may be necessary to turn up setting when ice cream machine is in use; if freezer is not cold enough, the motor may stop completely. Check firmness in 1 1/2 hours. Ice cream will be soft-set when ready; it will harden during ripening time in freezer.
