## Expertence

 For years. parochial schools. with larger cources. have been able to tret more from their atudents than has the average pubilc school.This is largely because parochial echools inslat upon a more orderly learning
environument that emphasizes bate suilto hirg expectations. homework and individual attention to student.
Critice frequently contend that private choola have an unfalr advantage over public achools because they cater to highly dievout Catholic familles.
To the contrary. the student body at many of poor, minortly students, many of whom are Protestant.
In fact. some students are public school ejects who thrive in a more structured achool setting.
Those sludents who function better in a private school environment should be ac
corded that opportunily. Corded that opportunity.
Conely. It's irrational for unmotivated students to be confined to public schools atudents is is litile likelthood then
when thation, much less graduate.
If this country is truly serious about reaching students who are on the bottom rung of the educational ladder. It must promote the private school alterna
is more appropriate to their needs. more appropriate to their needs. That is all Bill Bennett. a product of He makes a lot of sense.
