are made through mental or physical sickness. Statistics are made through mental or physical sickness. Statistics
also show that 70 per cent of our sehool children have either
physical or mental defects and that 60 per physical or mental defects and that 60 per cent of men and
women over forty years of age are suffering from some constitutional disease.
These conditions are millstones around the neck of modern
ivilization; they decrease productiveness and increase th cost of living; and they are blighting the inheritance of the
next generation. Such conditions can be measurably rem-
edied with modern sanitary administration of pulic realth edied with modern sanitary administration of public health
work through the agency of a stabilized health department. Through such measures one-half of the cost of sickness can economic gain would be obtained. Well informed people rea-
lize that public health problems are also economic problems "Because of the very personal nature of health and the
