British Unions Urge Restraints On Wage Demands

LONDON, Nov. 24—(AP)—The British Trades Union Congress (TUC) today urged "restraints on wage demands" as a way to help the government hold down the cost of living.

The TUC, which speaks for 8,000,000 organized British workers, said the wage freeze must be counteracted by "long-run" inflationary tendencies made worse by devaluation of the pound.

The TUC general council has been working feverishly since the outbreak of the war to keep the economy from getting out of control. The TUC recommended that its members agree to hold wages at their present level as long as the cost of living index remains below 100 percent of the 1947 level.
